

**GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (NORTHGATE STREET, WORCESTER STREET &  
SPREAD EAGLE ROAD) (WESTGATE WARD) (GLOUCESTER CITY) ORDER 2026**

The Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of that Schedule hereby make the following Order:-

1. (i) This Order shall come into operation on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of March 2026 and may be cited as the "GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (NORTHGATE STREET, WORCESTER STREET & SPREAD EAGLE ROAD) (WESTGATE WARD) (GLOUCESTER CITY) ORDER 2026".  
  
(ii) This Order affects roads within the Westgate Ward in the City of Gloucester in the County of Gloucestershire.
2. In this Order –  
  
"Motor Vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on the roads as defined in Section 185 of the Road Traffic Act 1988.
3. No person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed along those lengths of roads described in the Schedule at a speed exceeding 20 MPH.
4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those regulations.

**Schedule – 20mph Speed Limit**

Road Name & Number	Description
Northgate Street (48009) and (C8014)	From its junction with Black Dog Way (A430) for a distance of approximately 138m in a south-westerly direction
Worcester Street (C8014)	From its junction with Northgate Street (48009) for a distance of approximately 26m in a north-westerly direction
Spread Eagle Road (48010)	From its junction with Northgate Street (48009) for a distance of approximately 8m in a south-easterly direction
