Hasfield Court Glos 22 July 1810

Dear Sir,

I have heard from W. Bathurst and have written by this post to say I will call upon him on Wednesday morning next and get him to administer the oath to me there, which I see by the General Inclosure Act may be done and I will get the form of the oath upon parchment & stamped and ready cut and dried and bring it with me so that you need not prepare one - I am in great haste.
