## December 2014

### January 21<sup>th</sup> 2015 Release



**Unemployment in the County has decreased by 64 persons to 4,614 a rate of 1.2%.**

Unemployment in Great Britain **decreased** by 23,250 persons to **774,816** a rate of **1.9%**.

The County rate of unemployment remained the **same** as last month at **1.2%**.

Cheltenham and Tewkesbury saw an increase in the number of unemployed claimants, while the remaining districts saw a decrease.

The number of males unemployed in the County increased to **3,033 (1.6%)**. The number of females unemployed stands at **1,581 (0.8%)** representing a decrease on last month.

The figures quoted above cannot be compared with:

- 1) the UK figure of **1.91 million** unemployed at a rate of **5.8%**. This is based on the International Labour Organisation (ILO) definition of unemployment. It is obtained from an ongoing national household survey and updated on a quarterly basis.
- 2) the seasonally adjusted unemployment claimant count for the UK of **0.87 million** at a rate of **2.1%**.
