PROGRESS TO DATE...

Construction work at Chipmans Platt is ongoing. We have successfully installed new street lighting, ducting, and cabling to the area. Works have also begun on the re- construction of the splitter islands, and improved drainage installed.

The current traffic management at Chipmans Platt will remain in place for the next 4 to 6 weeks. We are still awaiting for utilities companies to divert water and gas lines. Once these works are completed we will initiate the final carriageway re- construction and surfacing works on the Chipmans Platt section.

To ensure our programme remains on schedule and to mitigate any delays, we have begun enabling works at Old Ends Lane. These preparatory works will allow us to ensure that work progresses efficiently with minimal delays. The enabling works at Old Ends Lane will be undertaken as day work and will continue until October. There will be a requirement to undertake some night works which will require us to implement traffic lights. We will ensure prior notification is given before these works commence.
