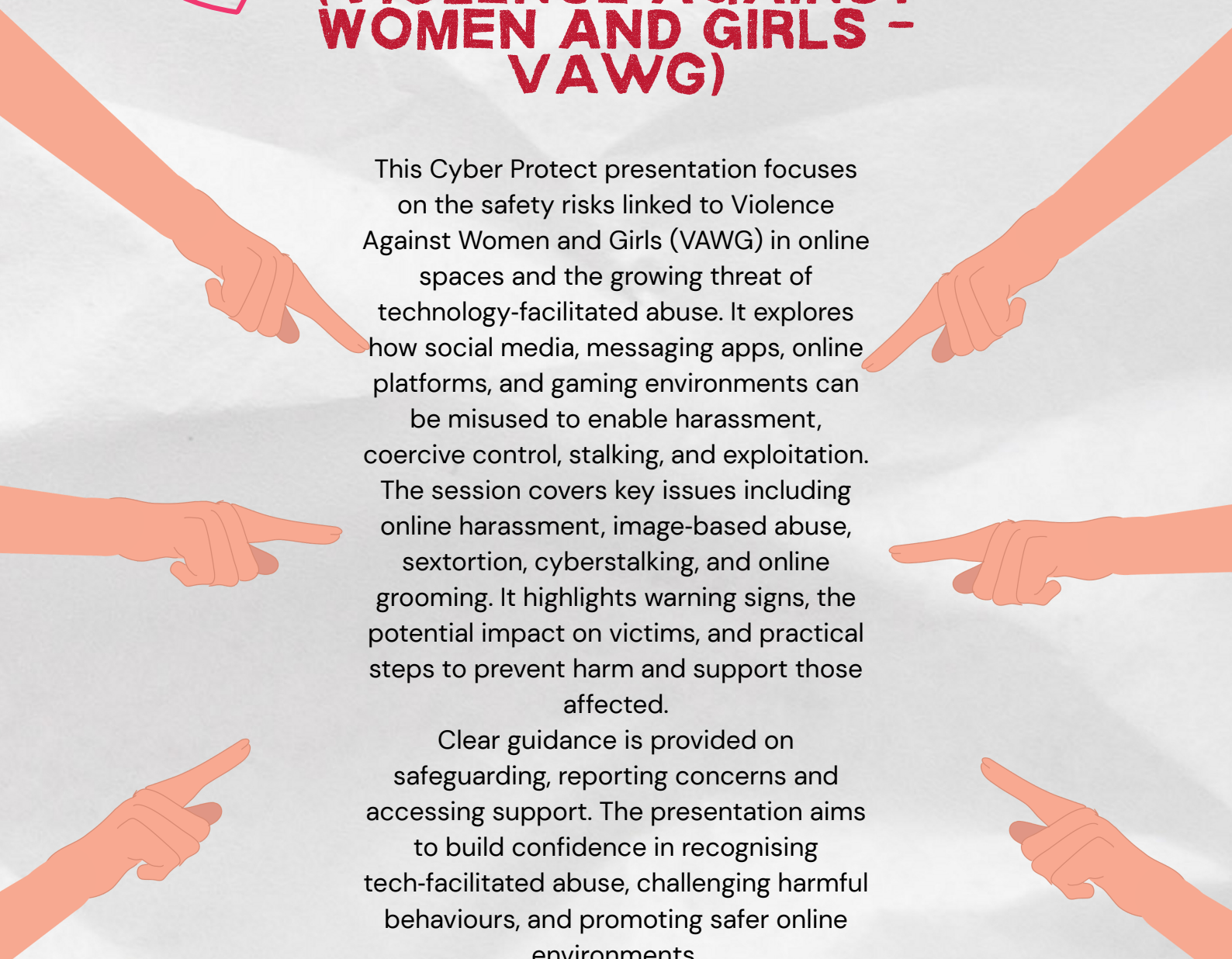




TECH FACILITATED ABUSE

(VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN AND GIRLS - VAWG)



This Cyber Protect presentation focuses on the safety risks linked to Violence Against Women and Girls (VAWG) in online spaces and the growing threat of technology-facilitated abuse. It explores how social media, messaging apps, online platforms, and gaming environments can be misused to enable harassment, coercive control, stalking, and exploitation. The session covers key issues including online harassment, image-based abuse, sextortion, cyberstalking, and online grooming. It highlights warning signs, the potential impact on victims, and practical steps to prevent harm and support those affected.

Clear guidance is provided on safeguarding, reporting concerns and accessing support. The presentation aims to build confidence in recognising tech-facilitated abuse, challenging harmful behaviours, and promoting safer online environments.
