



**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PART OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH EUL 20
(UPTON ST LEONARDS PARISH)
STROUD DISTRICT**

Gloucestershire County Council has by this notice closed temporarily under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) part of public footpath EUL 20 from its junction with Public Footpath EUL 24 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 85439/14282 and then extends in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 100 metres to a point at (OSGR) SO 85490/14213 and shown on the Map by a bold solid black line marked A to B.

The footpath falls in Upton St Leonards Parish in the Stroud District and in the County of Gloucestershire;

The closure is necessary to safeguard the health and safety of the public due to the unsafe M5 footbridge.

The Public Footpath was originally closed for 21 days, by Emergency Notice from 9th March 2026. The works are still ongoing, and it is therefore now necessary to make a closure Order.

The said Order shall come into operation on 30th March 2026 and authorises the closure of Public Footpath EUL 20 for up to six months from the date of the original Notice which was 9th March 2026. If the problem continues after this time, then it will be necessary to make an application to the Secretary of State for an extension.

Alternative Routes – Not available

Emergency and Pedestrian access to adjoining premises is to be maintained.
