

**PUBLIC NOTICE**  
**GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**ON STREET PARKING ORDER 2017 (VARIOUS ROADS) (TOWN OF LECHLADE-ON-THAMES)**  
**(COTSWOLD DISTRICT) (VARIATION) ORDER 2026**

NOTICE is hereby given that Gloucestershire County Council has made a Variation Order under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 32, 35, 36, 39, 45 and 46 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers, the effect of which will vary the Gloucestershire County Council On Street Parking Order 2017 (the 2017 Order) by introducing/revoking the restrictions detailed in the Schedule below on Various Roads in the Town of Lechlade-on-Thames, Gloucestershire.

**THE SCHEDULE**

***No Waiting at Any Time (Double Yellow Lines)***

Burford Street (A361)	Along sections on both sides of its carriageway between its junctions with St John's Street (A417) and Sherborne Street (C167)
St John's Street (A417)	Along sections on both sides of its carriageway east of its junctions with Burford Street (A361) & Market Place (A417)
Sherborne Street (C167)	Along a section on the southern side of its carriageway at its junction with Burford Street (A361)
Oak Street (A361)	Along a section of the north-western side of its carriageway north-east of its junction with Sherborne Street (C167)
Market Place (A417)	Along a section on the south-eastern side of its carriageway between its south-western and north-eastern junctions with Market Place (43411)
Market Place (43411)	Along a section on the north-western side of its carriageway at its south-western junction with Market Place (A417)  Along a section on the south-western side of its carriageway at its north-eastern junction with Market Place (A417)

***Permit Holders Zone 1 Lechlade/Limited Waiting 2 Hours No Return 2 Hours Mon-Sat 8am-6pm***

<b>Road Name &amp; Number</b>	<b>Extent</b>
Burford Street (A361)	Along sections on the south-western side of its carriageway between its junctions with St John's Street (A417) and Sherborne Street (C167)
Oak Street (A361)	Along sections on the north-western side of its carriageway north-east of its junction with Sherborne Street (C167)

***Loading Only***

<b>Road Name &amp; Number</b>	<b>Extent</b>
Burford Street (A361)	Along a section of the south-western side of its carriageway outside of the Swan.

***Disabled Badge Holders Only 3 Hours No Return 1 Hour 8am-6pm***

<b>Road Name &amp; Number</b>	<b>Extent</b>
Market Place (43411)	Along a section at the north of the on-street car park at the location of the existing advisory disabled bays (2x Bays) south of its north-eastern junction with Market Place (A417)

***Limited Waiting 2 Hours No Return 2 Hours 8am-6pm***

<b>Road Name &amp; Number</b>	<b>Extent</b>
Market Place (43411)	Within the on-street car park area between its south-western and north-eastern junctions with Market Place (A417) south of the location of the existing advisory disabled bays leaving a clearway for pedestrians at the west of the car park area

Restrictions to be Revoked

**Limited Waiting 2 Hours No Return 2 Hours 8am-6pm**

Market Place (A361)	Within the on-street car park area between its south-western and north-eastern junctions with Market Place (A417)

**Limited Waiting 2 Hours No Return 2 Hours Mon-Sat 8am-6pm Except Permit Holders**

Road Name & Number	Extent
Burford Street (A361)	Along sections on the south-western side of its carriageway between its junctions with St John's Street (A417) and Sherborne Street (C167)
Oak Street (A361)	Along sections on the north-western side of its carriageway north-east of its junction with Sherborne Street (C167)

The 2017 Order will be varied by the attachment of plans similar to those used in this consultation and which identify the roads or sides of road to which the prohibitions and restrictions affect.

This Variation Order shall come into operation on 15<sup>th</sup> May 2026.

The lengths of roads fall within the Town of Lechlade-on-Thames within the Cotswold District in the County of Gloucestershire. The usual exemptions will apply to Statutory Undertakers and Local Authority vehicles carrying out duties in exercise of their statutory powers, and also in the case of emergency services vehicles and disabled person's vehicles.

A copy of the Variation Order, the plans to be revoked, the new Sealed Plans to be inserted into the Schedule of Plans together with a copy of the Statement of Reasons and 2017 Order may be viewed at The Map Room, Shire Hall, Westgate Street, Gloucester, GL1 2TG and Lechlade Library, 2 Market Place, Lechlade, GL7 3AB during their normal working hours or online at <http://www.gloucestershire.gov.uk/tros>. Any person wishing to question the validity of the Variation Order or any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the ground that any requirement to that Act or any Statutory Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Variation Order may within six weeks of the date on which the Variation Order is made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
