

**GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(7.5 TONNE WEIGHT RESTRICTION) (VARIOUS ROADS, CHELTENHAM**  
**TRANSPORT PLAN PHASE 4) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2019**

Notice is hereby given that Gloucestershire County Council has made an Experimental Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to prohibit any goods vehicle having or exceeding a maximum gross weight of 7.5 tonnes to proceed along those lengths of roads as shown in the Schedule below with exemptions.

**THE SCHEDULE**  
**7.5 Tonne Weight Restriction**

<b>Road name/number</b>	<b>Extent</b>
Clarence Street C9012/A46	East and West bound between the east side of its junction with St Georges Place to the east side of its junction with Clarence Parade
Clarence Parade A46	North and South bound for its entire length
Crescent Place 490493	North and South bound for its entire length
St Georges Place C9009	Northbound from its junction with St James' Square to its junction with Clarence Street

The lengths of roads fall within the Borough of Cheltenham in the County of Gloucestershire.

A copy of the Experimental Order which comes into effect on the 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2019 together with the relevant plan, statement of reasons and other documents may be inspected during normal office hours at the Gloucestershire County Council, Map Room, Shire Hall, Westgate Street, Gloucester. The Experimental Order is Experimental and may continue in force for a period of up to 18 months expiring on 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2020. In due course the Council will consider whether or not the provisions of the Experimental Order should continue in force indefinitely.

Within 6 months of coming into force of the Experimental Order any person may object to its indefinite continuation. Any such representation should be sent in writing to the Head of Legal Services, Shire Hall, Westgate Street, Gloucester, GL1 2TG or via the Portal found at [www.gloucestershire.gov.uk/ctp-phase4](http://www.gloucestershire.gov.uk/ctp-phase4) not later than 3rd December 2019 stating the grounds on which it is made (please quote reference HBL/64805).
