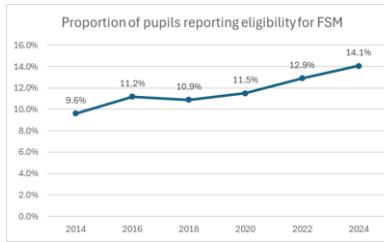


Free School Meal eligibility



1 in 6 pupils reported FSM eligibility

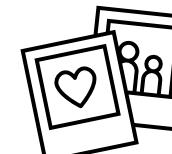


Higher in Black (18.3%) & Mixed ethnicity (16.9%)

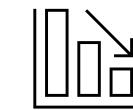


1 in 3

Young carers reported FSM eligibility



Twice as likely to be accessing mental health support



Eligibility is linked to deprivation

Higher in pupils at special schools

1 in 3 Report self-harm

At home...

Less likely to have a trusted adult



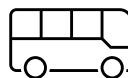
Less likely to feel safe at home & less supported at home



Less likely to form strong friendships



More likely to live away from family



3X Report living with only 1 parent

1 in 4 Victim of domestic abuse



Less likely to have healthy food at home

Regularly skipped a meal due to lack of food

1 in 20 expected to be NEET*
as many had applied to university



Less likely to have positive future plans

More likely to report behaviour regulation issues

2X Report aggression and violence

2X Report being often in trouble

More likely to be isolated, suspended or excluded



At school...

More likely to disengage from education
