

**GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT)
(C87 ROAD FROM NATTON TO HOMEDOWNS)
(ASHCHURCH RURAL PARISH) (TEWKESBURY BOROUGH)
ORDER 2025**

The Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of that Schedule hereby make the following Order:-

1. (i) This Order shall come into operation on **the 2025** and may be cited as the "GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (C87 ROAD FROM NATTON TO HOMEDOWNS) (ASHCHURCH RURAL PARISH) (TEWKESBURY BOROUGH) ORDER 2025".

(ii) This Order affects roads within the Ashchurch Rural Parish within the Tewkesbury Borough in the County of Gloucestershire.
2. In this Order –

"Motor Vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on the roads as defined in Section 185 of the Road Traffic Act 1988.
3. No person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed along that length of road described in Schedule 1 to this Order at a speed exceeding 40 MPH.
4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
5. In accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act, the following parts of Orders are to be revoked as specified in the sub-Articles that follow:
 - (i) GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (30, 40 & 50 MPH SPEED LIMITS) (VARIOUS ROADS) (FIDDINGTON AND WALTON CARDIFF) (TEWKESBURY BOROUGH) ORDER 2024
