

**GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(ONE WAY) (VARIOUS ROADS, CHELTENHAM TRANSPORT PLAN PHASE 4)**  
**EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2018**

NOTICE is hereby given that Gloucestershire County Council made an Experimental Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to experimentally prohibit any Vehicle from proceeding along part or parts of the lengths of roads described in the Schedule below other than in the direction specified.

**THE SCHEDULE**  
**One Way Traffic Flow**

Road Name / Number	Extent	Direction
Clarence Street C9012	From its junction with St George's Place to its junction with Crescent Place. From its junction with the east side of Cheltenham House underground car park access to its junction with Clarence Parade.	West to East
Clarence Parade A46	From its junction with Crescent Terrace to its junction with Clarence Street.	Southwest to Northeast
Crescent Place 490493	From its junction with Clarence Street to its junction with Crescent Terrace.	North to South

The lengths of roads fall within the Lansdown & Park Ward in the Borough of Cheltenham in the County of Gloucestershire.



The Experimental Order is Experimental and may continue in force for a period of up to 18 months expiring on 28<sup>th</sup> December 2019. In due course the Council will consider whether or not the provisions of the Experimental Order should continue in force indefinitely.

Within 6 months of coming into force of the Experimental Order any person may object to its indefinite continuation. Any such representation should be sent in writing to the Head of Legal Services, Shire Hall, Westgate Street, Gloucester, GL1 2TG or via the Portal found at [www.goucestershire.gov.uk/ctp-phase4](http://www.goucestershire.gov.uk/ctp-phase4) not later than 7th January 2019 stating the grounds on which it is made (please quote reference HBL/64805).
