

**GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF
VARIOUS PUBLIC FOOTPATHS (BODDINGTON AND UCKINGTON PARISHES)
(TEWKESBURY BOROUGH) ORDER 2026**

WHEREAS the Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") being the Traffic Authority for the various Public Footpaths as described in the schedule below; ("the Public Footpaths") is satisfied that use of the Public Footpaths should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near them.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its power under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, hereby makes the following Order:

CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 9th day of April Two Thousand and Twenty Six and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding six months.

This Order may be cited as "Gloucestershire County Council Temporary Closure of Various Public Footpaths (Boddington and Uckington Parishes) (Tewkesbury Borough) Order 2026".

GENERAL

1. Except for emergency and pedestrian access to premises no person shall proceed on foot nor cause or permit any person to proceed along the Public Footpaths;
2. The Public Footpaths fall in Boddington and Uckington Parishes in the Tewkesbury Borough in the County of Gloucestershire;

SCHEDULE

Public Footpath ABO 14 from its junction with the A4019 Road at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 90235/25768 extending in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 635 metres then turning in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 290 metres to its junction with public footpath ABO 13 at OSGR SO 89667/25314.

Public Footpath ABO 24 from its junction with Withybridge Lane at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 90470/24657 extending in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 1025 metres to its junction with public footpath ABO 25 at OSGR SO 91425/24365.

Public Footpath ABO 26 from its junction with the B4634 Road at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 90472/23895 extending in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 270 metres to its junction with Hayden Lane at OSGR SO 90404/23636.

Public Footpath AUC 8 at its junction with The Green at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 91883/25353 extending in a generally south easterly

direction for approximately 600 metres to its junction with the A4019 at OSGR SO 91981/24766.

Public Footpath AUC 11 from its junction with Withybridge Lane at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 90496/24713 extending in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 1040 metres to its junction with Cooks Lane at OSGR SO 91359/24919.

Public Footpath AUC 12 from its junction with Cooks Lane at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 91370/24928 extending in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 130 metres to its junction with Moat Lane at OSGR SO 91468/24837.

Part of Public Footpath ABO 13 from its junction with public footpath ABO 14 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 89667/25314 extending in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 560 metres to its junction with public footpath ABO 16 at OSGR SO 89965/24835.

Part of Public Footpath ABO 16 from its junction with public footpath ABO 15 at OSGR SO 89759/24958 extending in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 780 metres to its junction with Withybridge Lane at OSGR SO 90448/24677.


Part of Public Bridleway AUC 1 from its junction with A4019 at OSGR SO 90864/25370 extending in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 120 metres to a point on AUC 1 at OSGR SO 90929/25471.

The Public Footpaths are expected to be closed on a rolling programme where the presence of approved signage will indicate whether they are in force. Further advance warnings of dates/times will be displayed on site prior to the said closures taking effect.

This Order permits the said closures in any order, or simultaneously as required. If the closures are still required after six months then it will be necessary for an application to be made to the Secretary of State to request an extension of time to this Order
