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






Around 43% of LSOAs saw declining populations

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

2nd highest % of 16-64 year olds (out of Gloucestershire's 6 districts)




Proportion of population by broad age group Cheltenham, Gloucestershire and England and Wales

Distribution of Cheltenham's population by broad age group, 2001, 2011 and 2021



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


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

Top 10 languages that are not English (English or Welsh in Wales, 2021- Cheltenham



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



Religion


Sexual orientation and gender identity

0.5% of the population do not have the same gender identity as at birth


Around 1 in 20 people chose not to answer the sexual orientation and gender identity questions

*Excluding gender identity the same as sex registered at birth (94.3% of Cheltenham's population) and the not answered category

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






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Disability


15.9% of the population are disabled under the Equality Act (2010)

8.1% not disabled but do have a long term physical or mental health condition(s)




In a few LSOAs **1 in 4** people are classed as disabled





Most carers provide less than 9 hours or more than 50 hours care

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

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












