Information regarding funding

Following the publication of the new LA EY entitlements statutory guidance, which includes revised guidance in relation to provider charging policies, we have received a number of phone and email

queries from childminders and group providers, seeking clarification about its implementation. We acknowledge the challenges you are facing in respect of the revised guidance, but given the number of queries, it is proving difficult to respond to them all individually, however there are some emerging themes that reflect concerns across the sector. We have therefore, set up 2 webinars, taking place on 20th March 7-8pm for childminders (this is the pre-planned CM monthly networking event) [book here](#) and 24th March 12.30-1.30pm for all providers [book here](#). We will use this time to provide responses to the most common queries and talk through some examples of how you might revise your operating models and set out your charging policies to ensure compliance with the statutory guidance. Following the webinars we will circulate FAQs to further assist with your planning.

Credit Card Payment System Going Live!!

Hooray!! We are delighted to confirm that GCCPlus will accept credit card payments with effect from Monday 25th March 2025. This means that you can now make payment for all training at the time of booking, rather than waiting for an invoice.

If you are unable to pay by debit/credit card, you can follow the existing process of payment and receive an invoice.

Please note that refunds will be processed as follows for all payments made by credit card:

- Cancellation at least 2 weeks before the training course – full refund
- Cancellation less than 2 weeks before the training course – no refund but a place will be offered on a subsequent/alternative course
- Cancellation of course by GCC – either refund or offer of alternative course

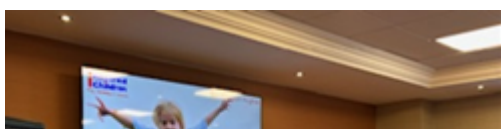

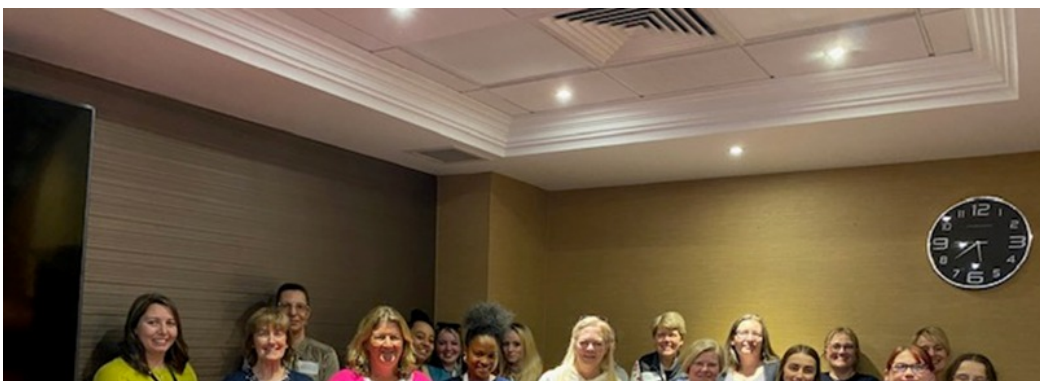
Cohort 1 – February 2023 – October 2023

Total Communication Training in the Early Years

Exciting news to all providers! You can now book Total Communication in the Early Years through GCC+. To do this you will need to log into your setting's GCC+ account. Go to the **search bar** on the **home page**, and type in Total Communications and **press the search key**. You will then see the link for the Total Communications for you to book. ***(Please note – if you search in the ‘training section’ or the ‘services’ section, you won’t find it. It must be searched for in the home page search and the search key pressed). NB - If you just press enter, it won’t find it.***

The training will help your staff to develop their skills by exploring:

- How children develop their communication skills
- How to provide good quality adult:child interactions
- How to provide a communication friendly environment, using a range of communication methods including signs
- Why and how to use visuals

This session will also enable you to add resources to your practitioner communication tool kit and each delegate will receive a certificate for their CPD.

Once you have booked and checked out your training, you will be contacted by an EY Inclusion Advisor to arrange the date and time for the delivery of your course. If you have not heard from us within 2 weeks, please contact the EY Admin Team: eyservice@gloucestershire.gov.uk.
