

Child Exploitation - Raising Awareness - VIRTUAL SESSION

Aims and Objectives

The purpose of this course is for participants to:-

- To know how exploitation works
- To know and be able to recognise warning signs and risk factors that could indicate exploitation
- To know when and how to complete the Child Exploitation Screening Tool
- To understand about why children and young people go missing
- To understand the barriers in reporting abuse
- To know what to do if you are worried
- To begin to understand what we are doing to tackle exploitation both nationally and locally

Course information
