

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(VARIOUS SPEED LIMITS)
(VARIOUS PARISHES WITHIN CHELTENHAM BOROUGH, TEWKESBURY
BOROUGH AND THE STROUD DISTRICT)
ORDER 2004

The Gloucestershire County Council (the Council) in exercise of its powers under Section 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act) and Parts II and IV of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of that Schedule hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on *21st December* 2004 and may be cited as the Gloucestershire County Council (Various Speed Limits) (Various Parishes within Cheltenham Borough, Tewkesbury Borough and the Stroud District) Order 2004.
2. The roads fall within the Parishes of Badgeworth, Brockworth, Shurdington, Staverton, Churchdown, Pitchcombe, Cranham, Upton St Leonards, Leckhampton and Great Witcombe in the Cheltenham Borough, Tewkesbury Borough and Stroud District in the County of Gloucestershire.
3. In this Order:

"Motor Vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on the roads as defined in section 185 of the Road Traffic Act 1988.
4. No person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed along those lengths of road described in Part I of the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 30mph.
5. No person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed along those lengths of road described in Part II of the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 40mph.
6. No person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed along those lengths of road described in Part III of the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 50mph
7. Those Orders or parts of Orders referred to in Part IV of the Schedule are hereby revoked.
