School Based Nurseries

School Based Nursery Phase 2 – updates from the EY and CC Business Team

Key dates:

- Applications open 22 September 2025 and close on 11 December 2025 (5pm)
- Decisions announced April 2026
- Funding released June 2026
- Projects need to be operational by September 2026
- Final deadline for spend September 2027

Schools must confirm the following:

- They did not receive funding in phase 1
- The project will deliver a net increase in childcare places
- The nursery will be operational before September 2027
- Local Authority approval has been formally obtained, and the approval form has been submitted.

All applicants for the SBN must receive approval from GCC before submitting their application. If you are interested in applying, please get in contact with us. We will need time to review your projects before we can approve your application.

We will send written approval to support your application as required, as long as, all details of your SBN project are submitted to ourselves by **5pm 28th November** to eybusinesssupport@gloucestershire.gov.uk.

Success stories – EY and Wraparound creation/expansion

We are excited to share with you some of the success stories about the creation and expansion of Early Years and Wraparound childcare that has happened across the county over the past 12 months.

Wraparound Funding Case Studies

Case Study 1 – £65,040 awarded

A Forest of Dean based Trust received funding to create a new afterschool hub supporting four schools. Each had previously tried to run their own clubs but couldn't sustain them due to low demand. The funding covered:

- Staffing costs
- Vehicle running costs for transport between sites

- Consumables
- Capital funding for a minibus

Case Study 2 – £25,975 awarded

A school near Cheltenham found that the lack of wraparound care was affecting their reception intake. They partnered with a sports club to deliver breakfast and afterschool provision. The funding supported staff costs while numbers grew, helping the school achieve a full reception intake for the first time.

Case Study 3 – £56,539 awarded

An infant school's afterschool club was at full capacity. To expand provision, they collaborated with two Early Years settings to host younger children. The joint application funded:

- Staffing costs
- Resources to support collaboration (e.g. staff laptops for safeguarding)
- Resources for children
- Consumables

Wraparound updates

We still have revenue funding for wraparound providers. **Our next Grant Panel is 18 December 2025 and the application window is now open until 21 November 2025.**

Early Years Funded Entitlements updates

The amendment task for the Autumn term opens on 3rd November and closes on 28th November. Payments will leave GCC on 12th December.

Starters and Leavers in the Autumn term

As part of the amendment task, please ensure that you enter start dates or leaving dates, where necessary, and adjust the number of funded weeks you are claiming of any children that join your setting or leave during the Autumn term. The task does not automatically recalculate the number of weeks funding to claim based on the dates you enter. To support this, please consider the following information:

Number of funded weeks in the Autumn term = 14 weeks

Week 1 = w/c 1st September

Week 14 = w/c 8th December

Half term = w/c 27th October (non-funded week)

With the amendment task currently open until 28th November, please

can we take this opportunity to ask you to review children's home addresses before you submit your tasks. Primary school place invitation letters are sent to families in November and the contact details used reflect those for their early years' placement. Your support with ensuring accurate data submissions would be much appreciated.

Let's talk business: A space for your questions

1. What are the termly deadlines dates for parents to apply for their Working Parents Entitlement eligibility codes?

Parents MUST apply before the following deadline dates and the code must have a start date on or before:

- *31st August for the Autumn term,*
- *31st December for the Spring term*
- *31st March for the Summer term.*

2. Why can't I enter extended/expanded hours on the headcount task?

If the eligibility code is not valid in the right term, you will not be able to add extended/expanded hours into the funding task. Please visit "Review previous checks" in the Portal and ensure the "Eligible from" date meets the correct range discussed in Section 5.5 of the Provider Agreement.

If you have added a new child to the headcount task before checking their eligibility code, you will not have access to the extended hours field until the code has been checked correctly and is valid in the term.

Always "Run a new check" for a WPE code for a new child, before you add them to the headcount task.

3. Do I have to provide an invoice if the child only claims their

funded entitlement?

Yes, it is advised that all families receive an invoice, even if their child is only accessing funded hours. The invoice should clearly highlight the number of hours being claimed on behalf of the child. This can be issued monthly, termly, or yearly, depending on your usual invoicing schedule.

Total Communication Training in the Early Years - This training is provided in house at your setting.

You can now book Total Communication in the Early Years through GCC+. To do this you will need to log into your setting's GCC+ account. Go to the **search bar** on the **home page**, and type in Total Communications and **press the search key**.

You will then see the link for the Total Communications for you to book.

(Please note – if you search in the ‘training section’ or the ‘services’ section, you won’t find it. It must be searched for in the home page search and the search key pressed). NB - If you just press enter, it

won't find it.

Once you have booked and checked out your training, you will be contacted by an EY Inclusion Advisor to arrange the date and time for the delivery of your course. If you have not heard from us within 2 weeks, please contact the EY Admin Team: eyservice@gloucestershire.gov.uk.
