

GLoucestershire County Council  
(UP HATHERLEY WAY, UP HATHERLEY)  
(40 m.p.h. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER, 1988

The Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 ("the Act") and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Gloucestershire County Council (Up Hatherley Way, Up Hatherley) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order, 1988 and will come into operation on the 25th day of November One thousand nine hundred and eighty-eight.
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road described in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h.

S C H E D U L E

That length of road known as Up Hatherley Way, in the Parishes of Leckhampton and Up Hatherley in the Borough of Tewkesbury, which extends from its junction with the Stroud to Cheltenham Road (A46) to its junctions with Cold Pool Lane (3/220) and Sunnyfield Lane (41106). A distance of approximately 1,950 metres.

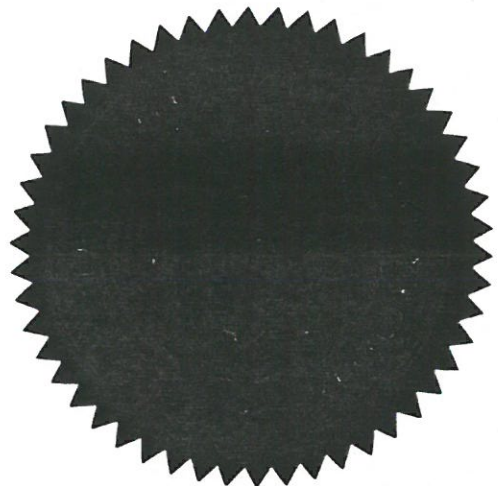
