







3rd highest % of 0-15 year olds (out of Gloucestershire's 6 districts)







Country of birth





Religion




Sexual orientation and gender identity

2.7% of the population gave a sexual orientation other than straight or heterosexual


0.4% of the population do not have the same gender identity as at birth










Disability

16.9% of the population are disabled under the Equality Act (2010)


8.3% not disabled but do have a long term physical or mental health condition(s)





















