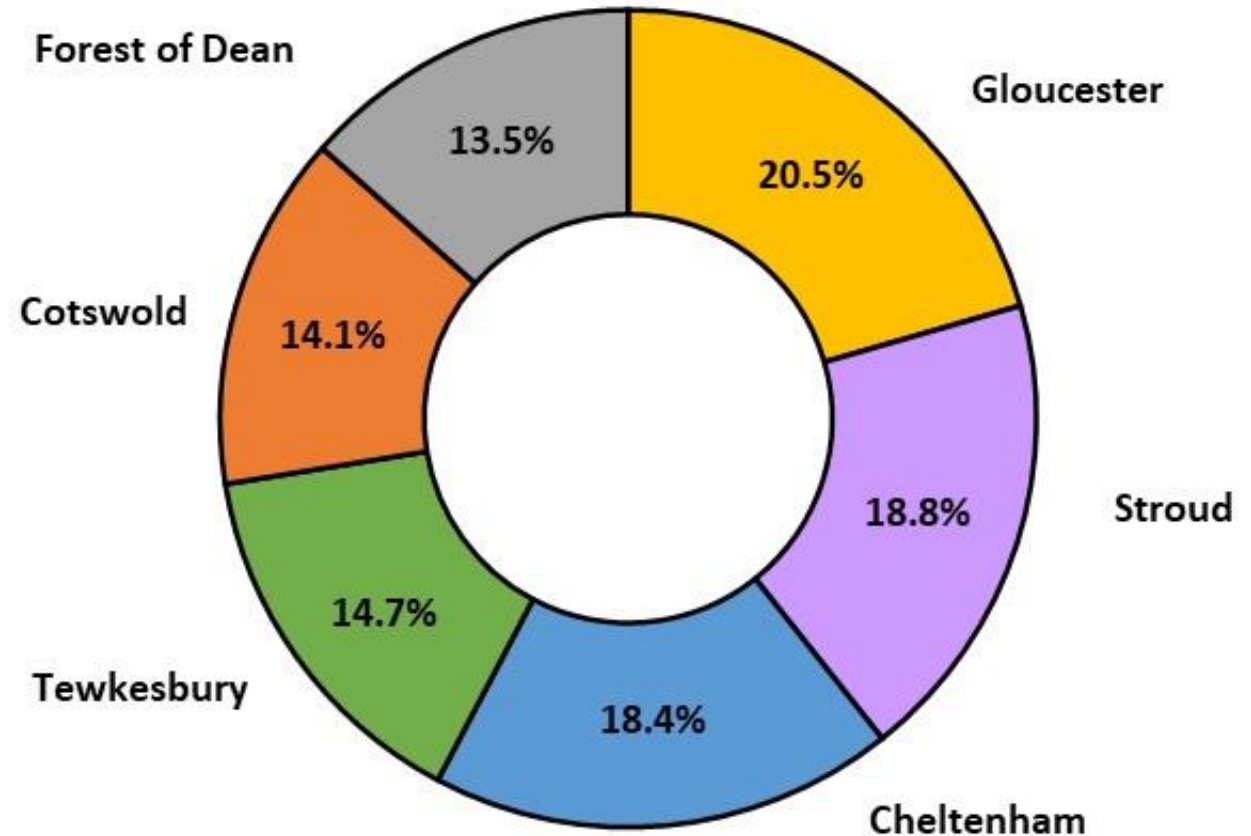

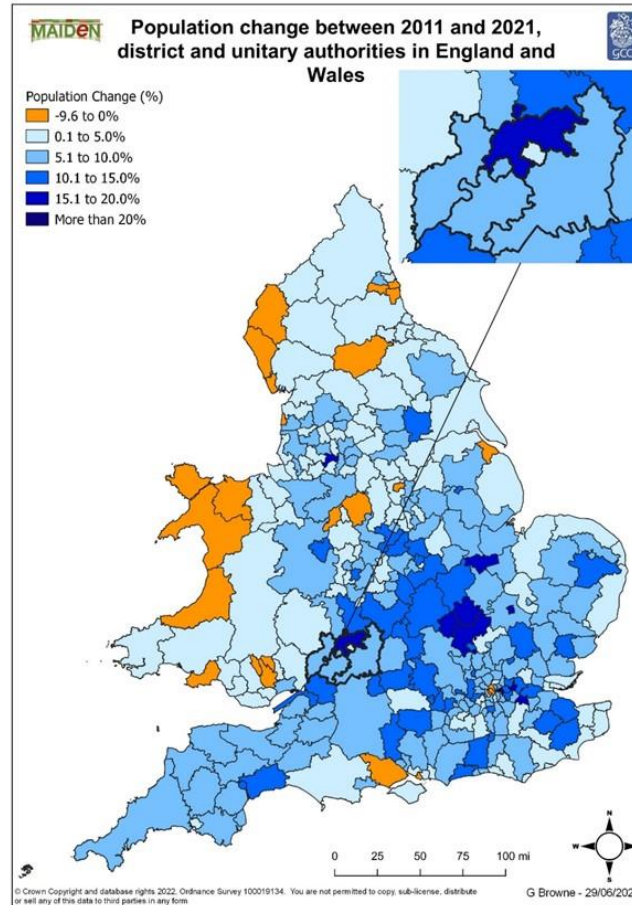

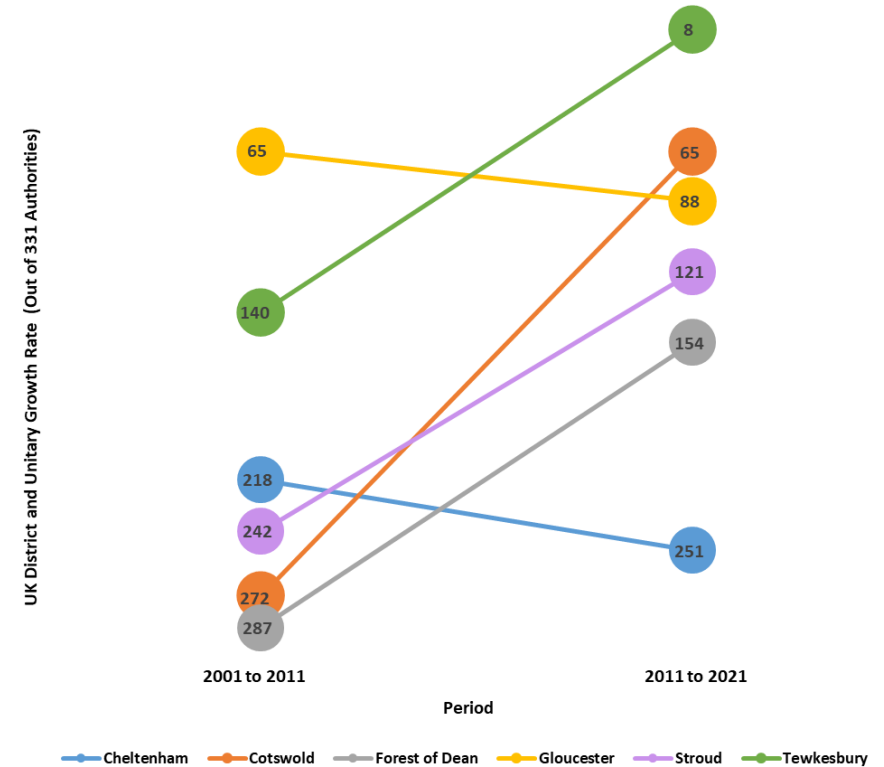

# Population change

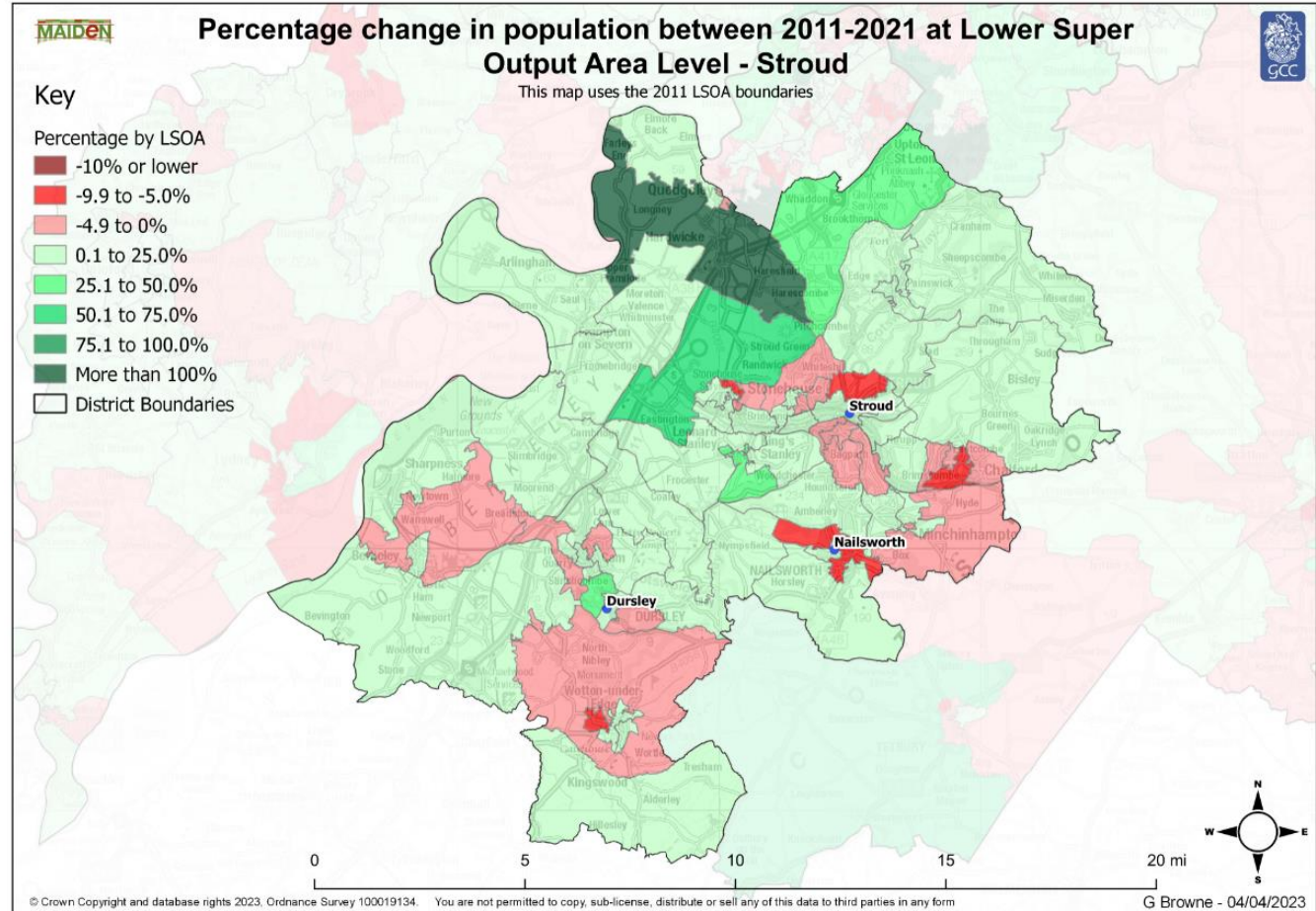
**34.8%** of LSOAs saw declining populations

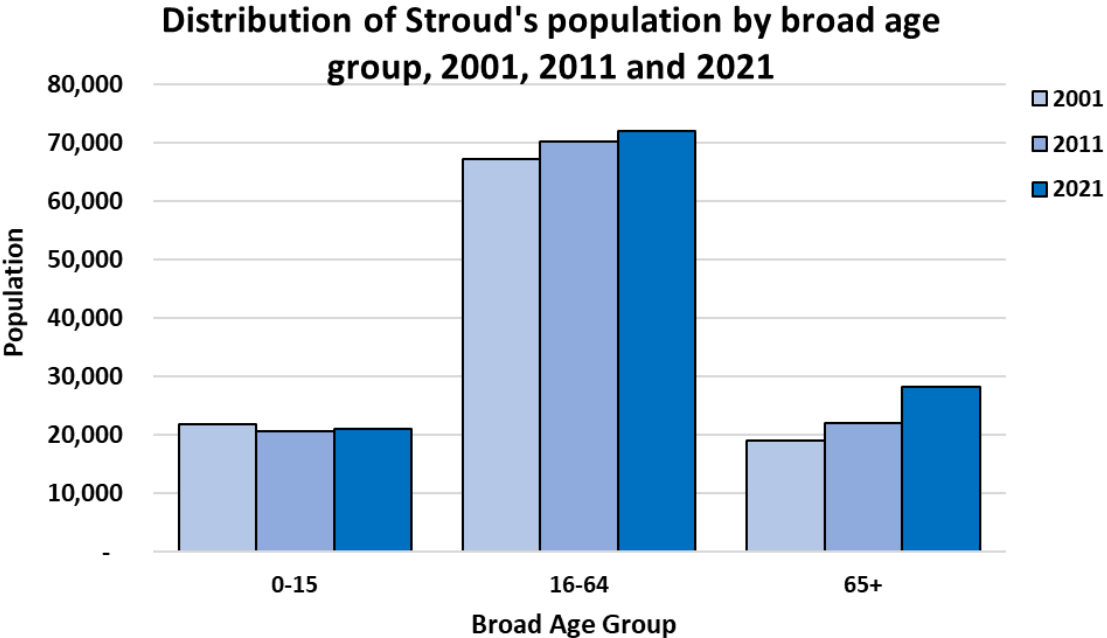

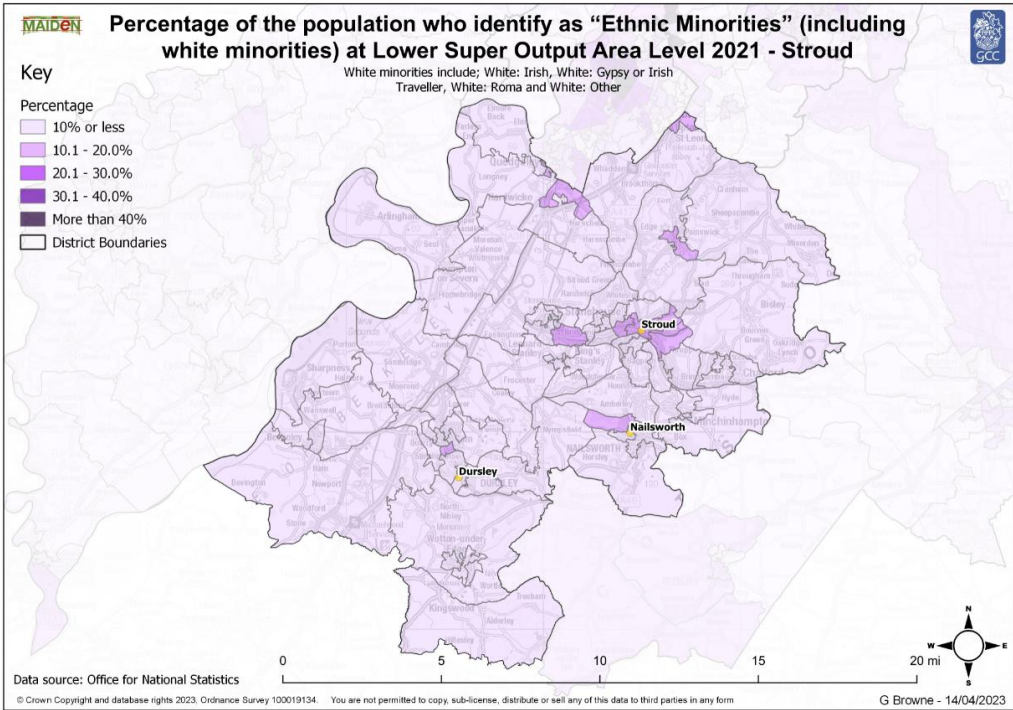
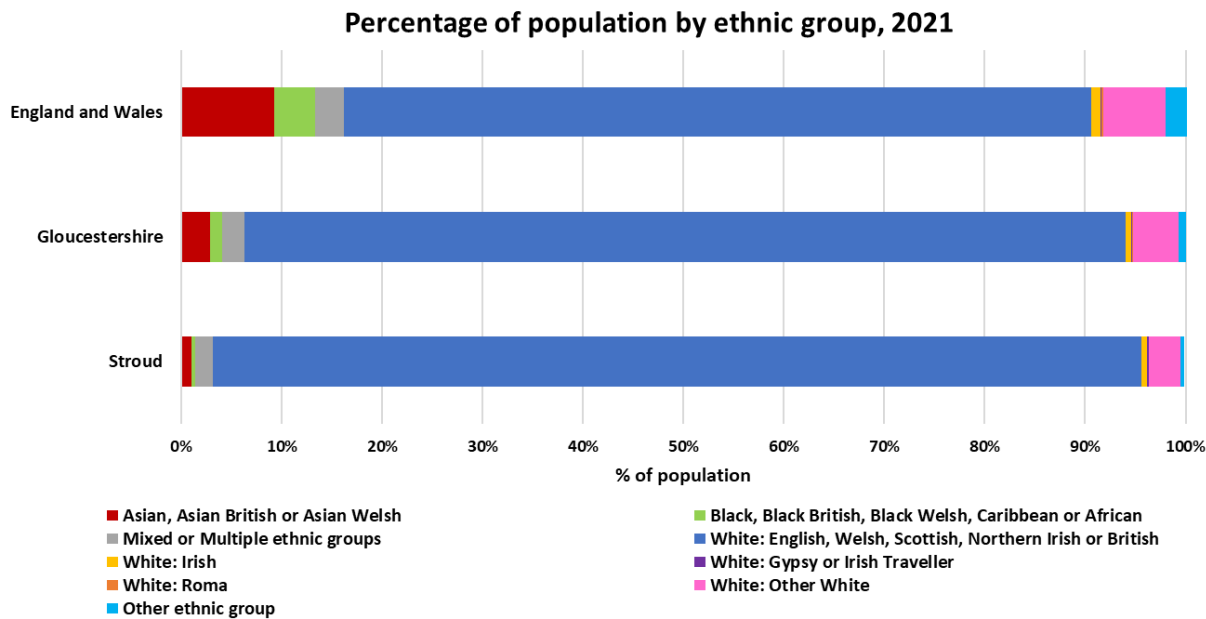


# Ethnic groups

61.7% increase in proportion of people from ethnic minority backgrounds 2011-21



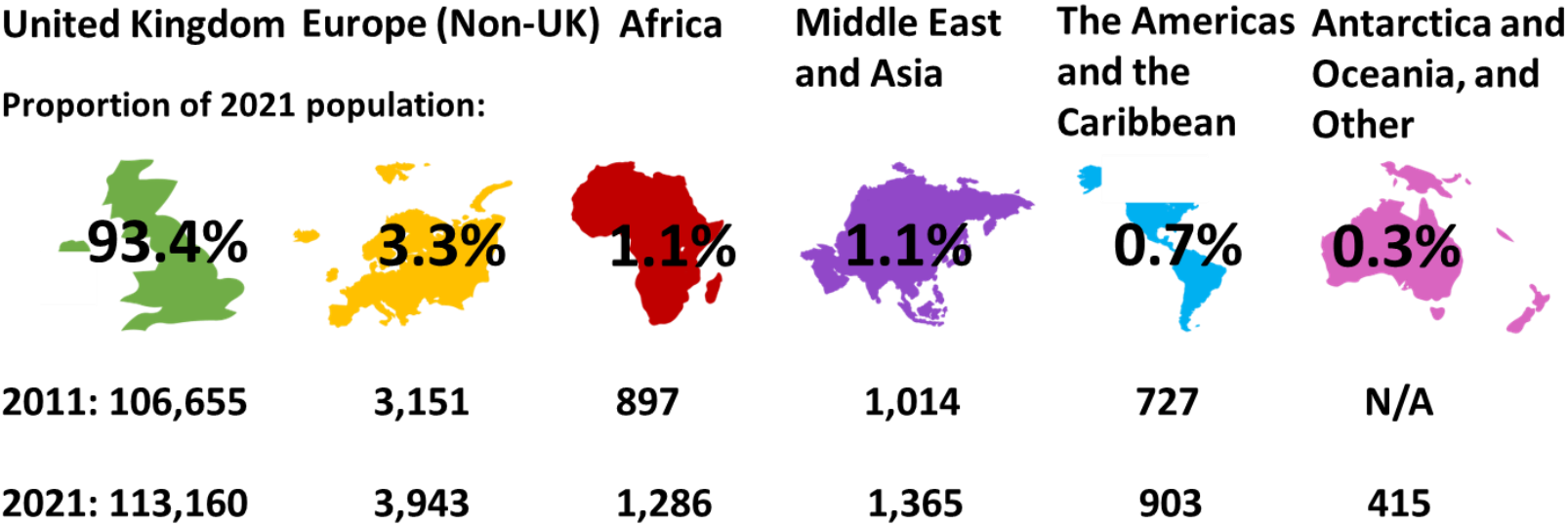


# Country of birth

**37%** increase in the non-UK born population between 2011-21

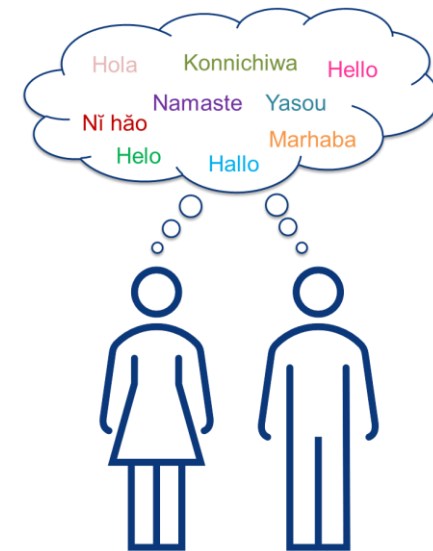
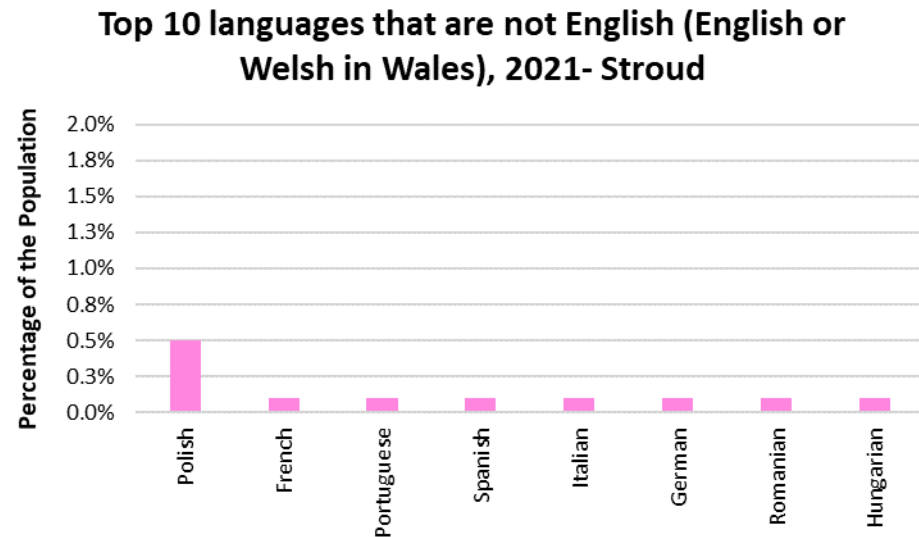
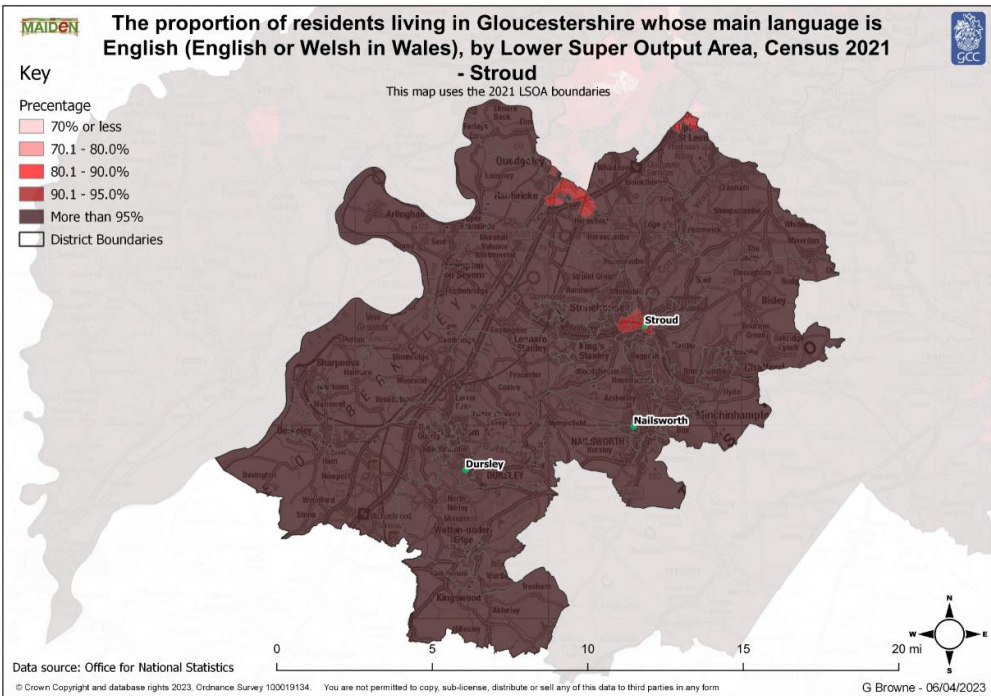


# Language

0.2% cannot speak English well or at all



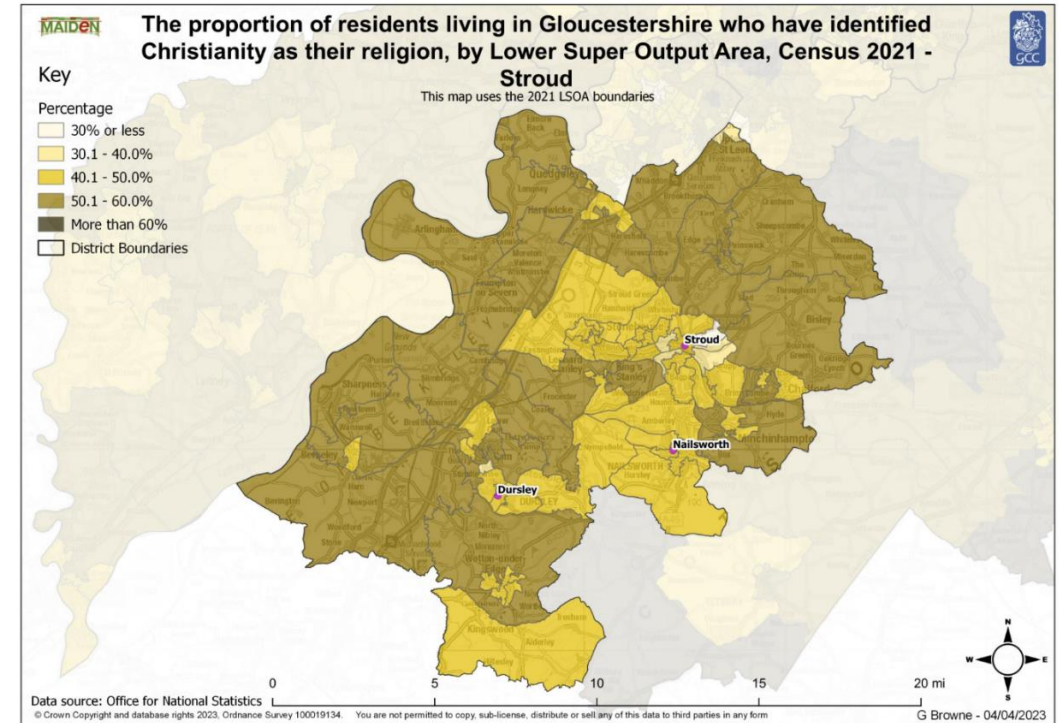
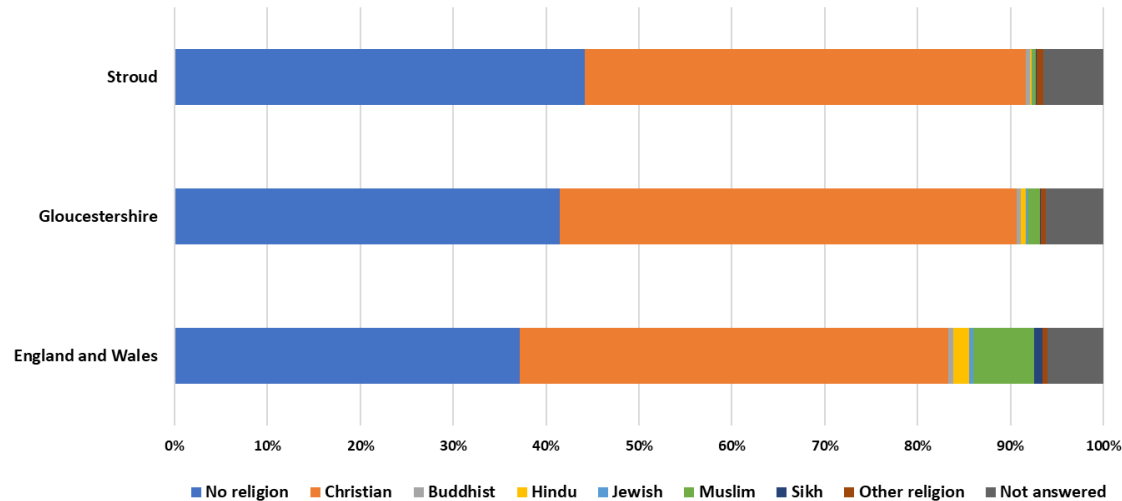
# Religion

Proportion of Gloucestershire's population by religion



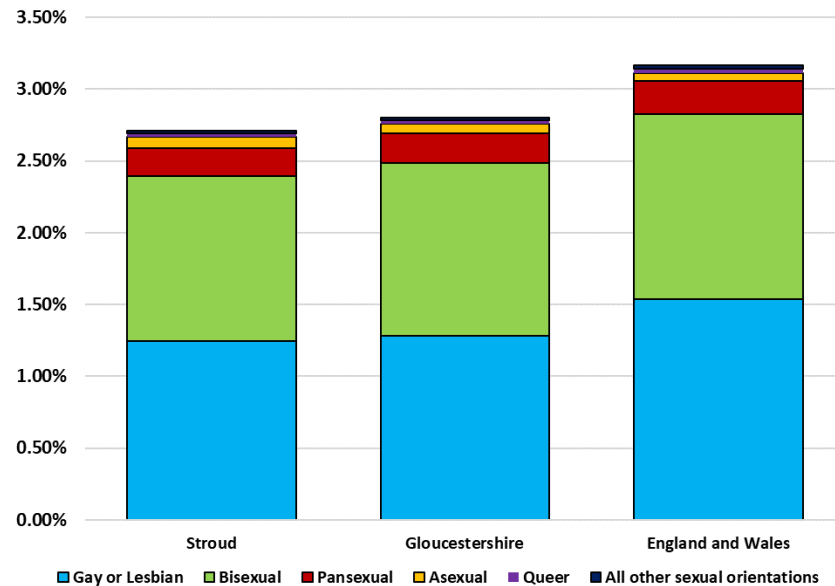
# Sexual orientation and gender identity

**0.4%** of the population do not have the same gender identity as at birth

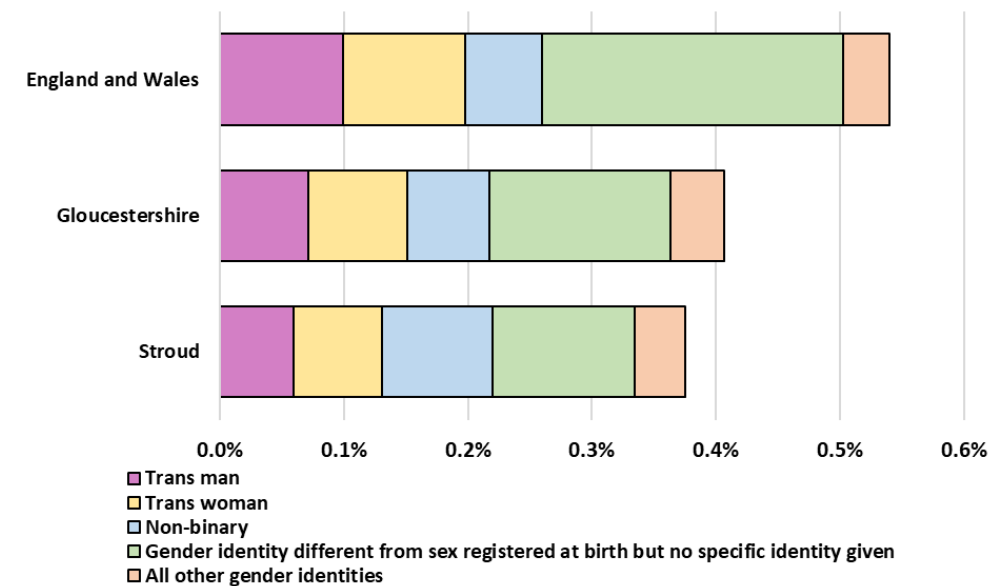
Around **1 in 20** people chose not to answer the sexual orientation and gender identity questions

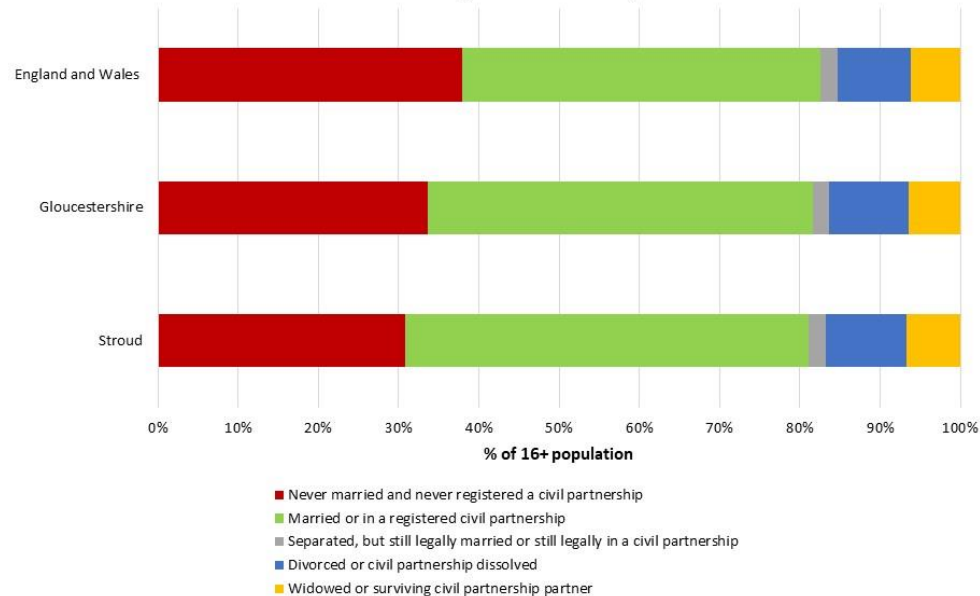

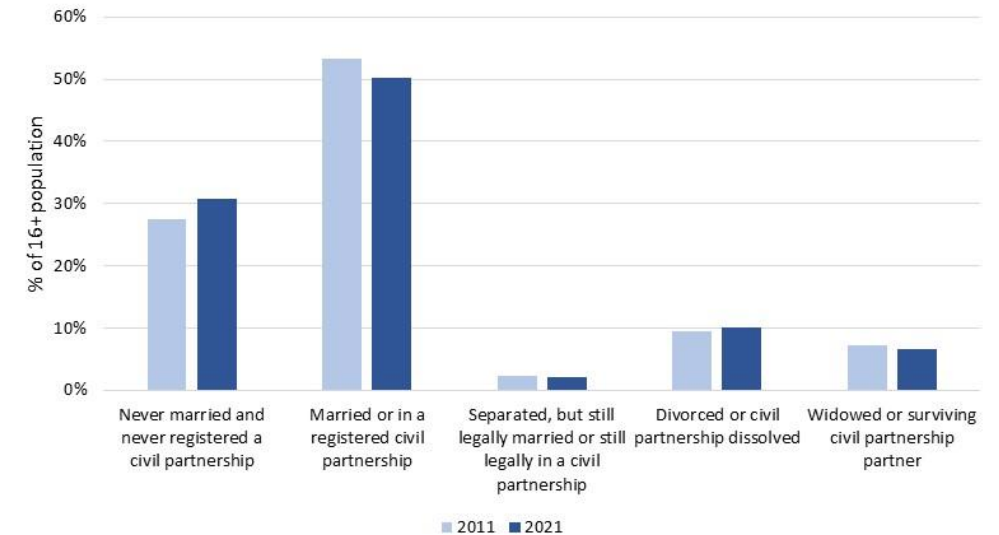

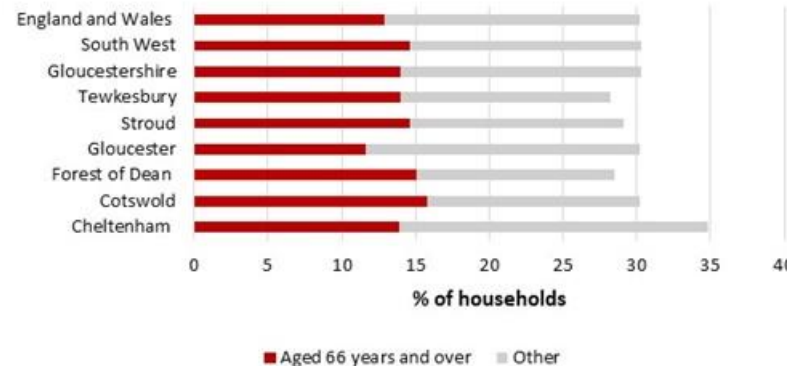

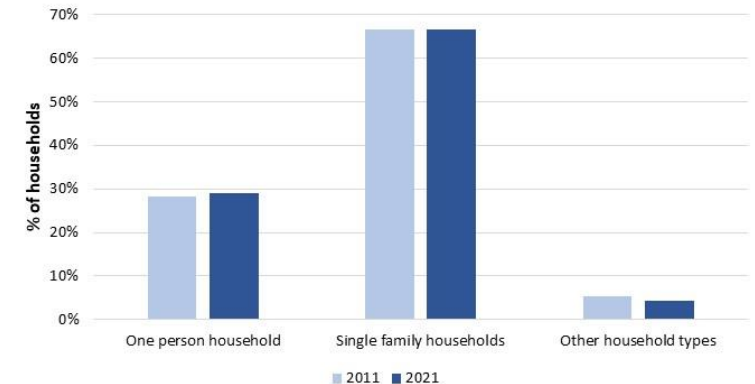

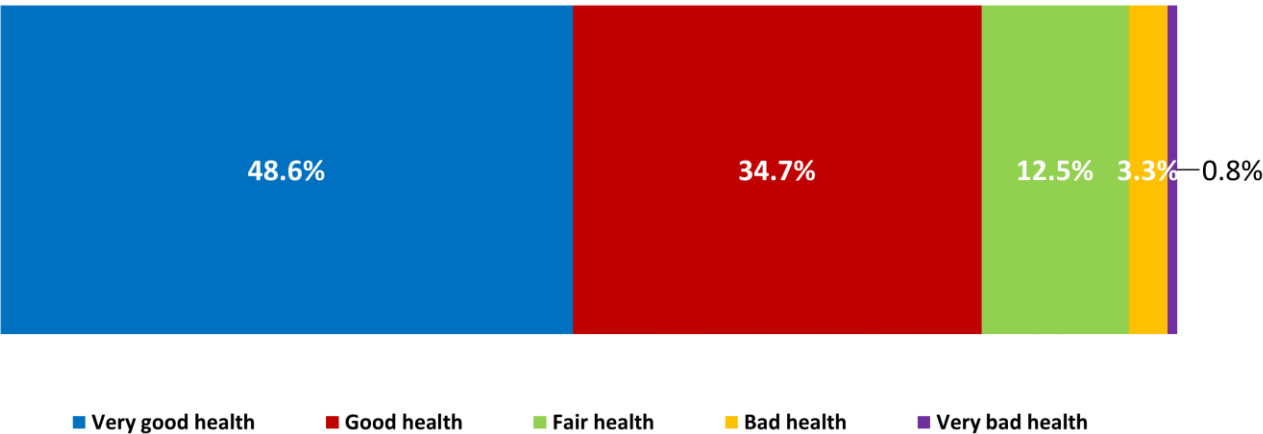

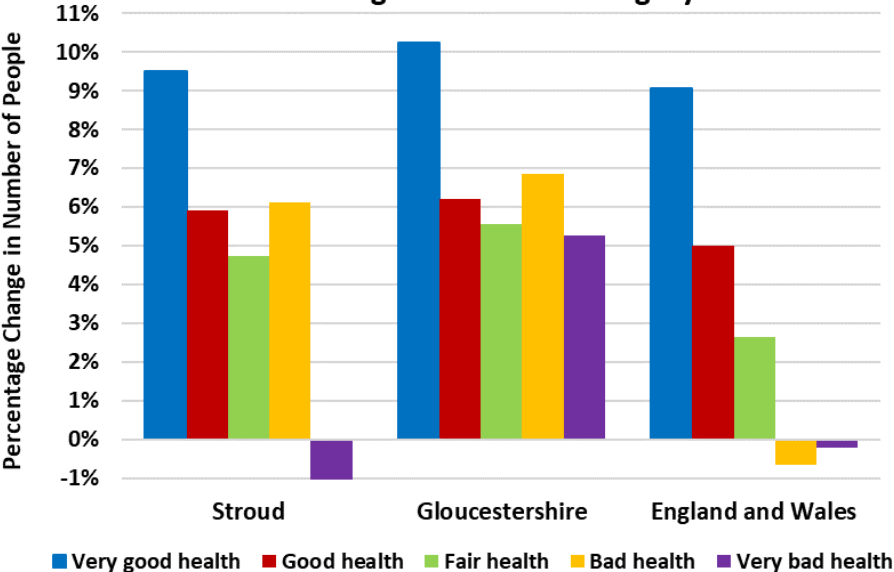

Percentage change in number of people identifying with each general health category



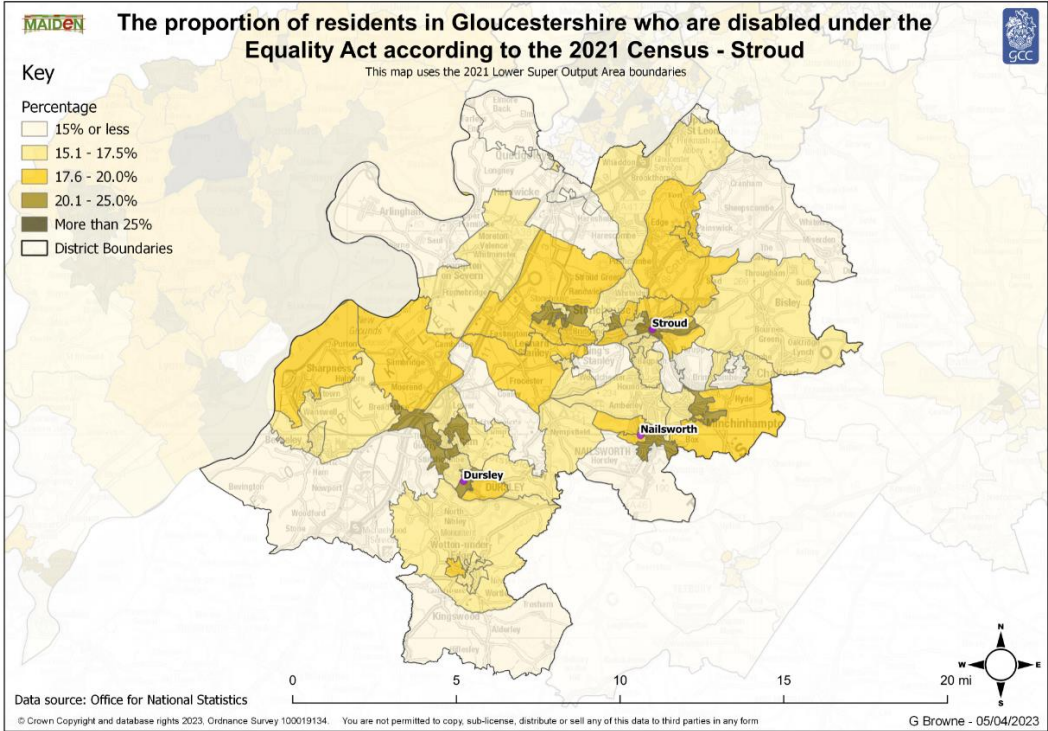
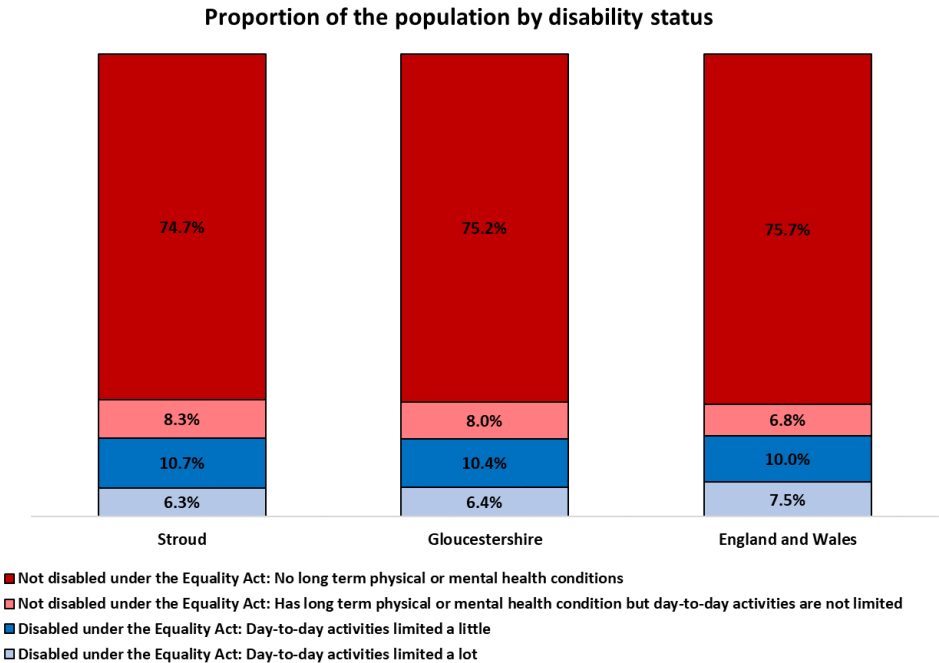
# Disability

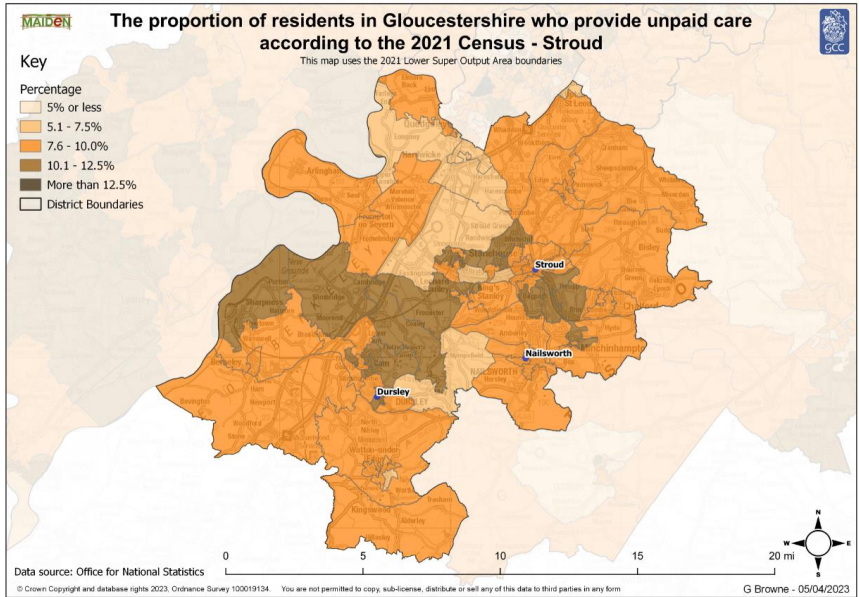
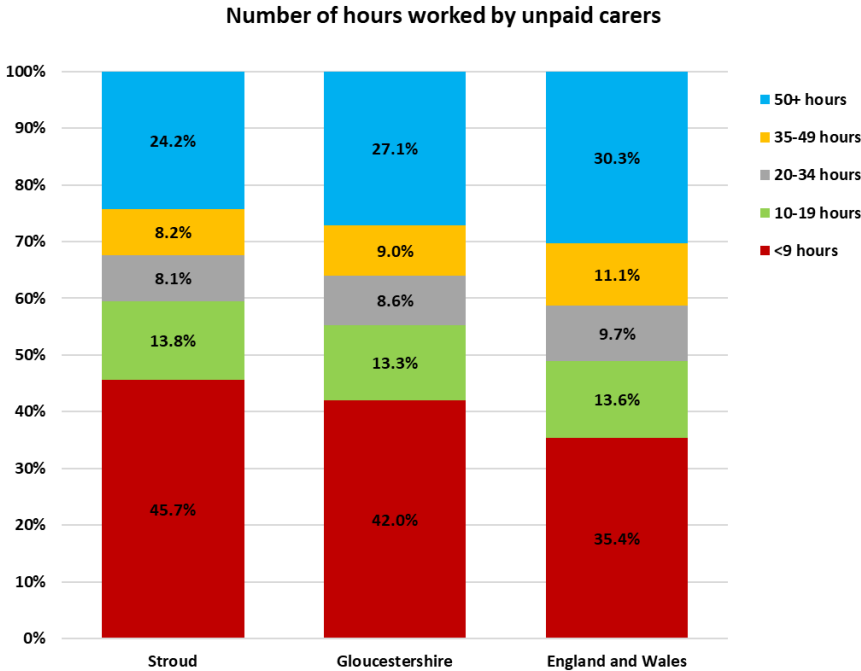


Most carers provide less than 9 hours or more than 50 hours care

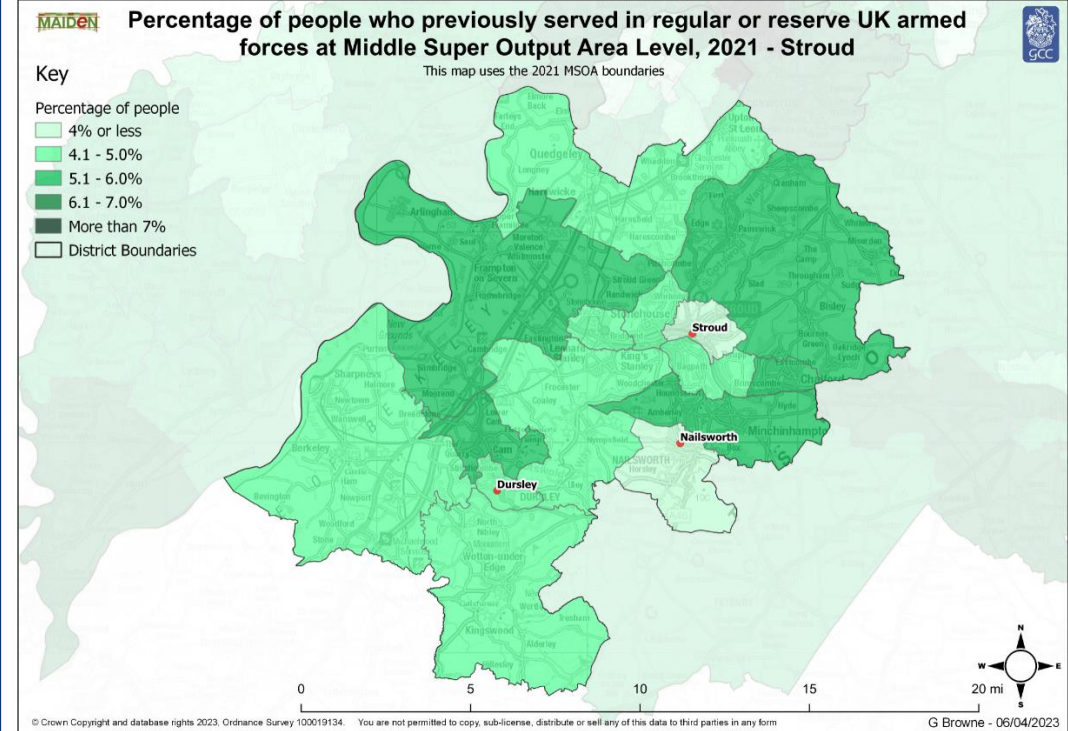

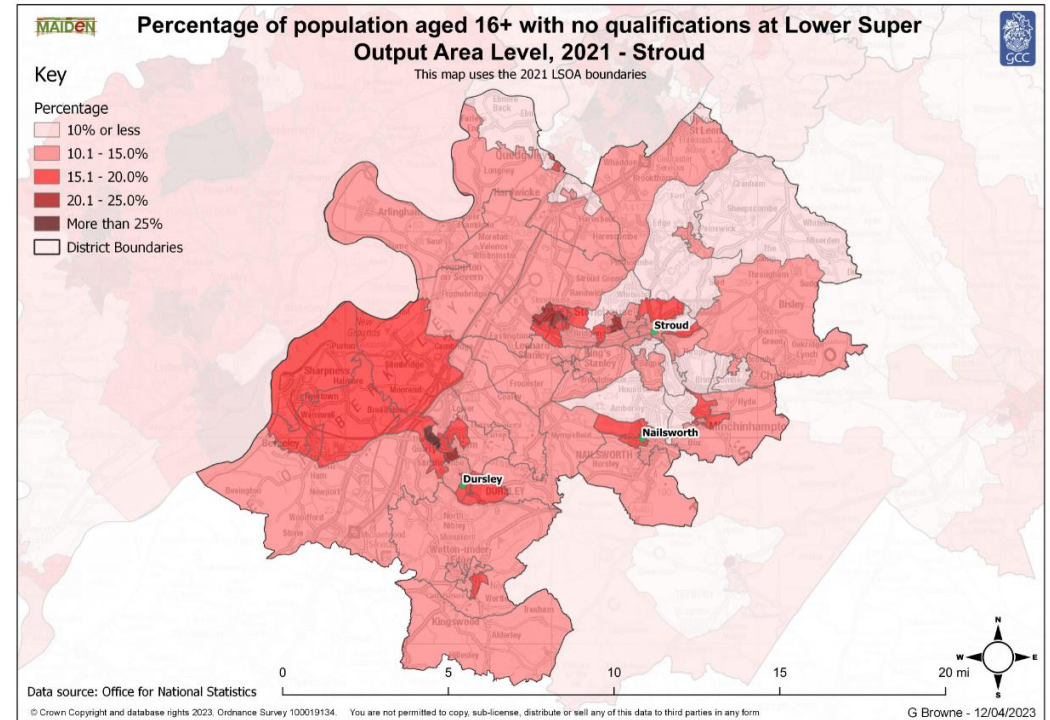
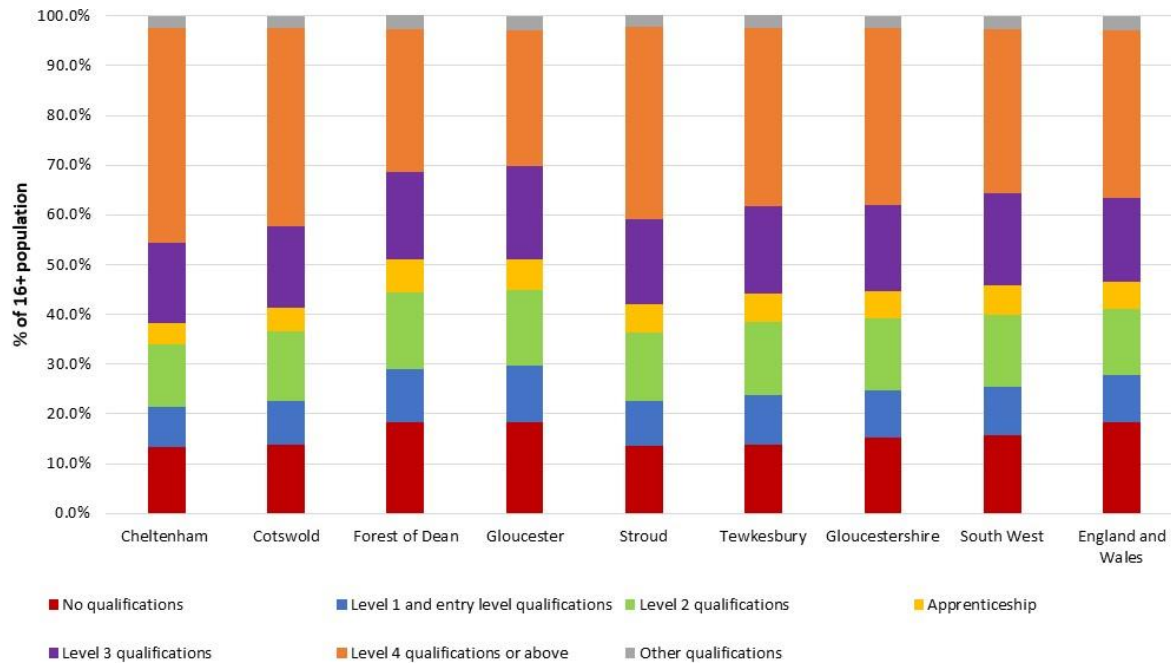

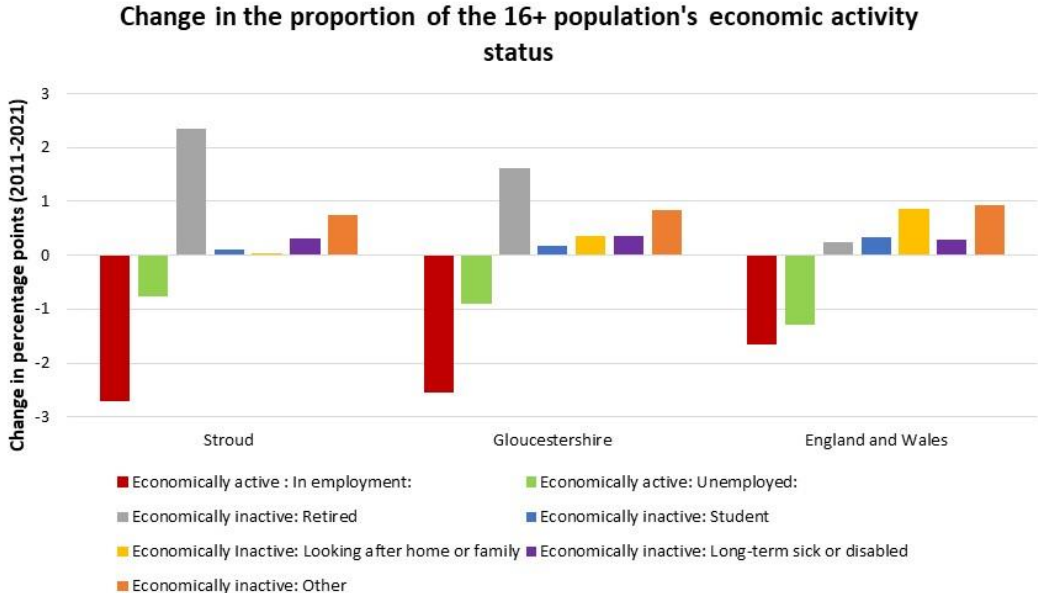

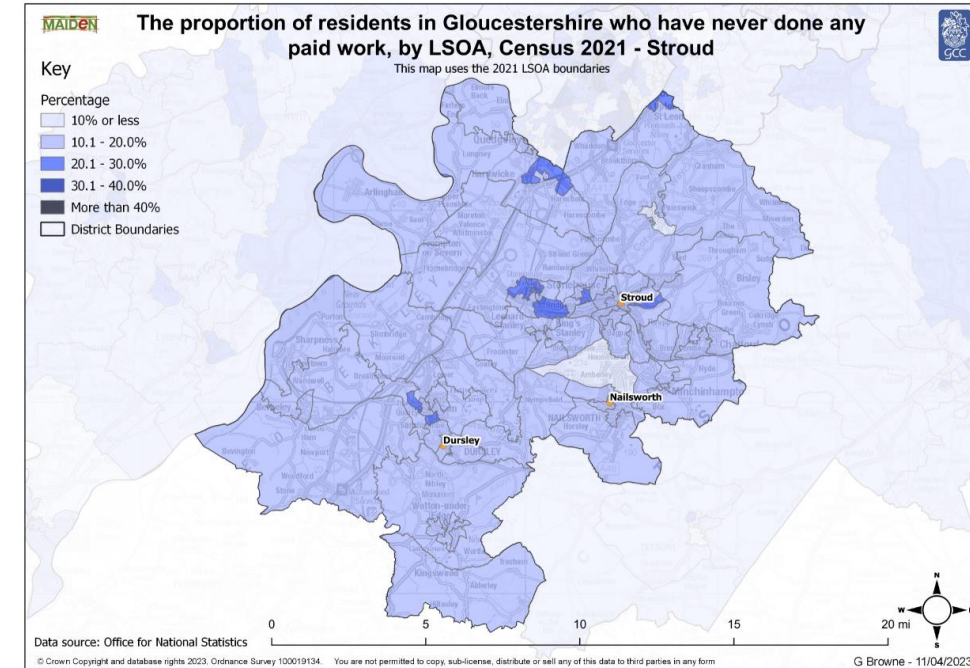

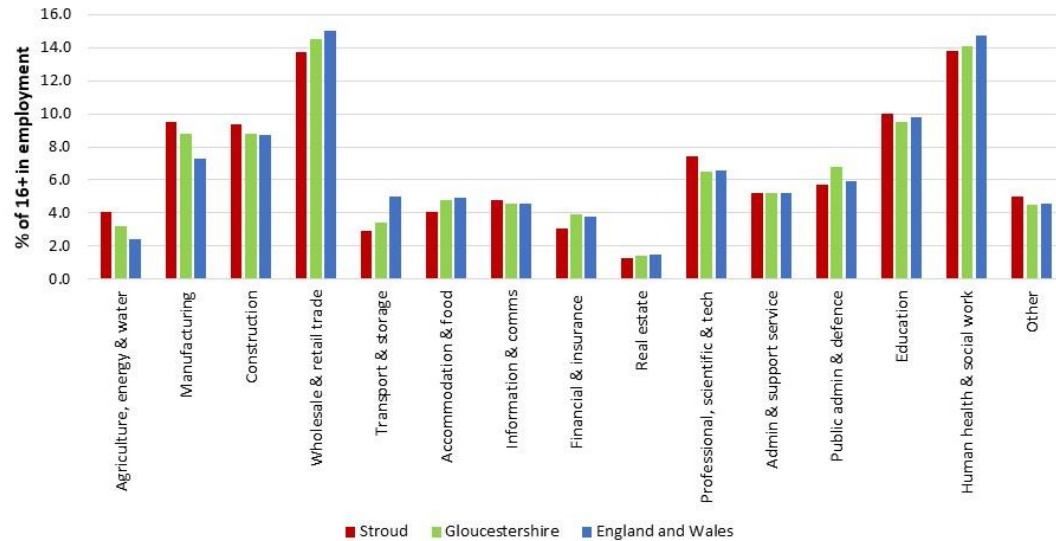

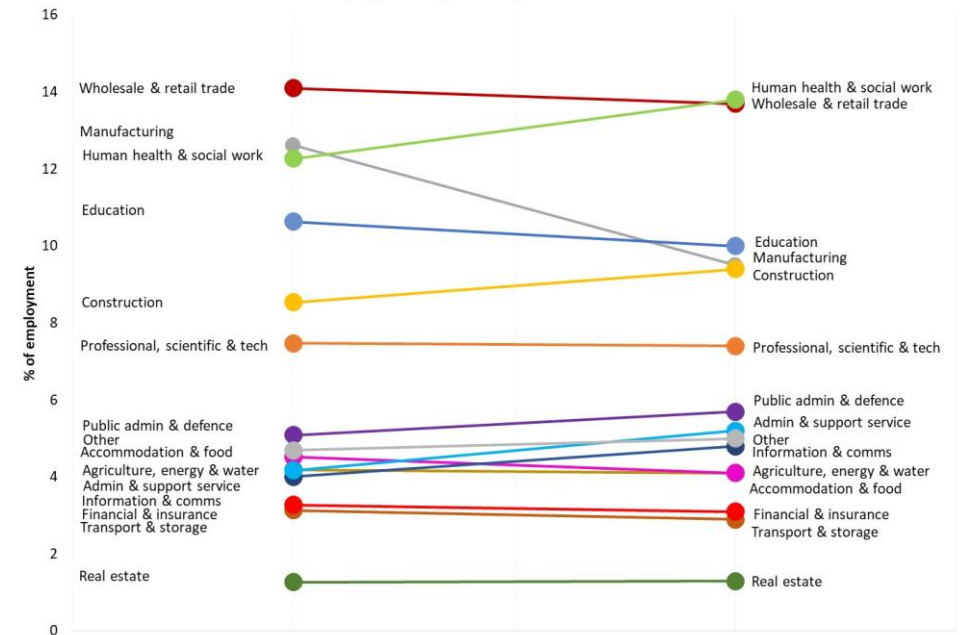

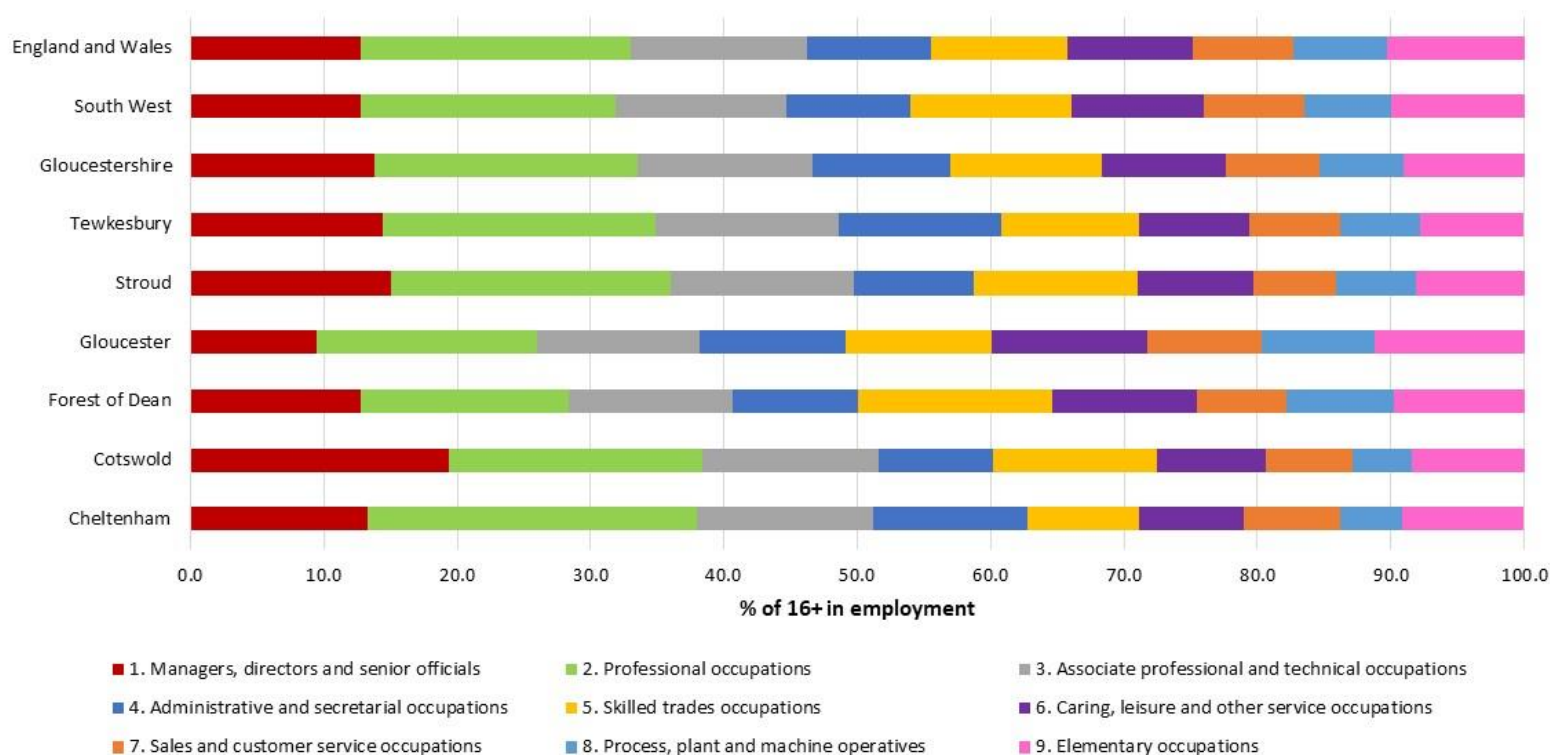

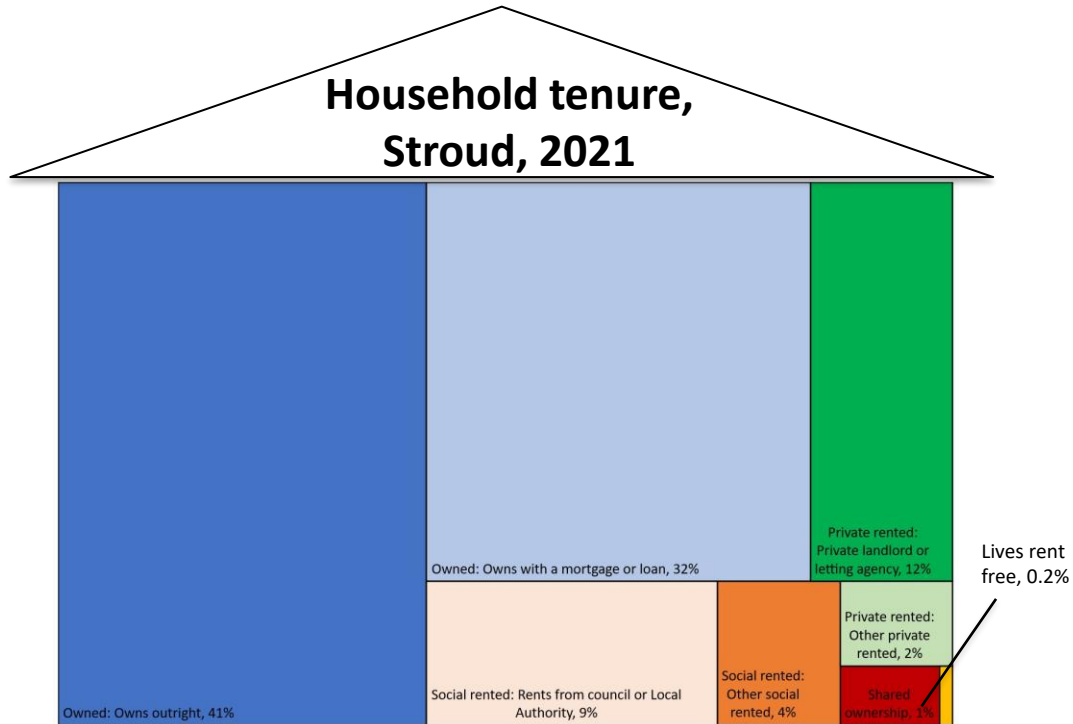

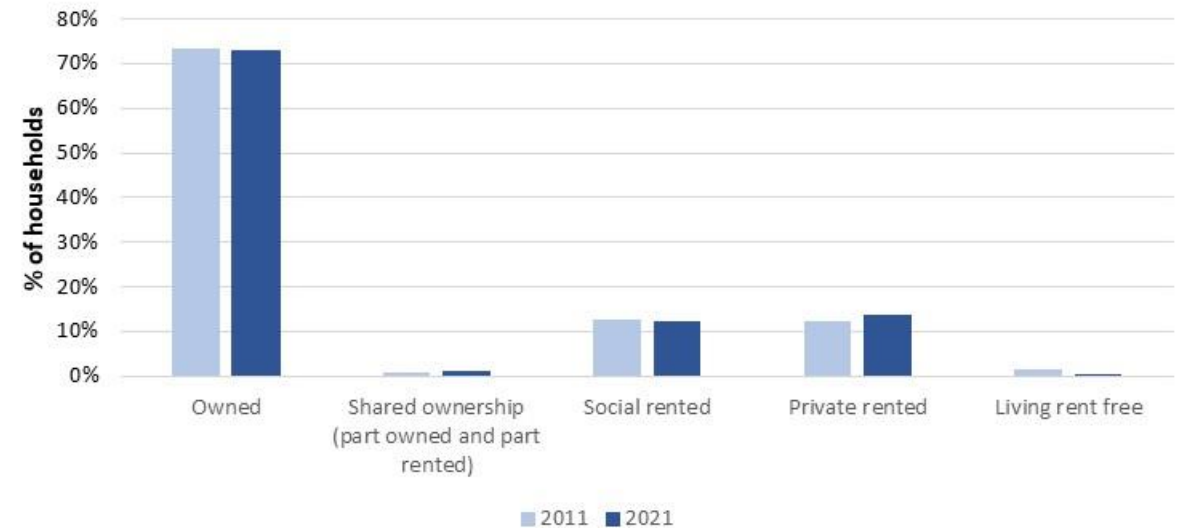

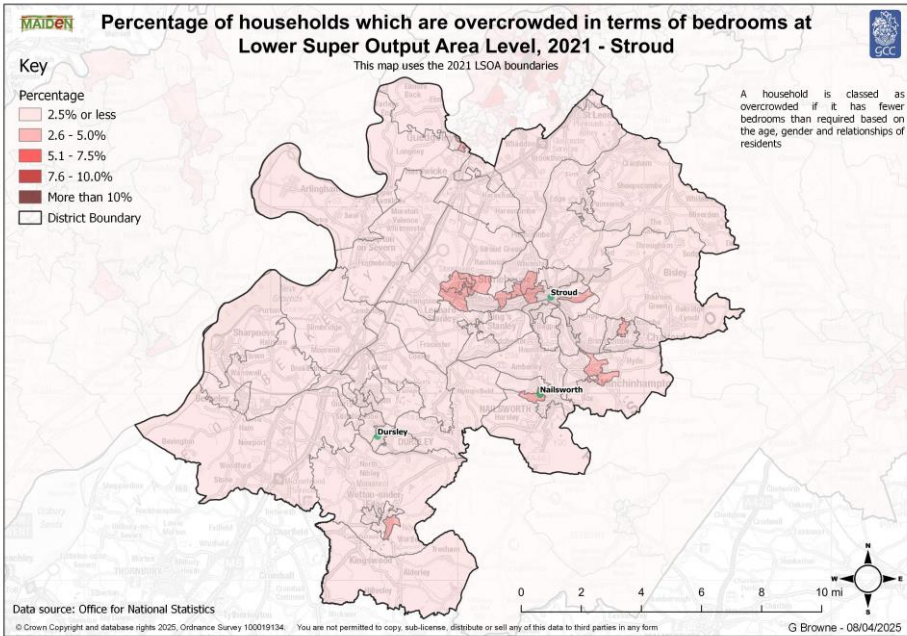
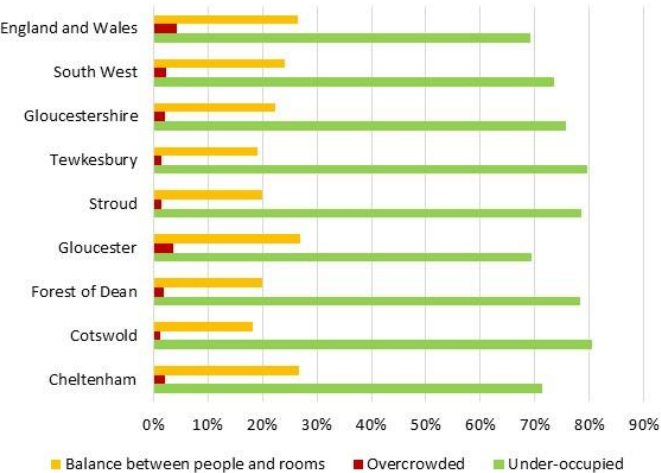

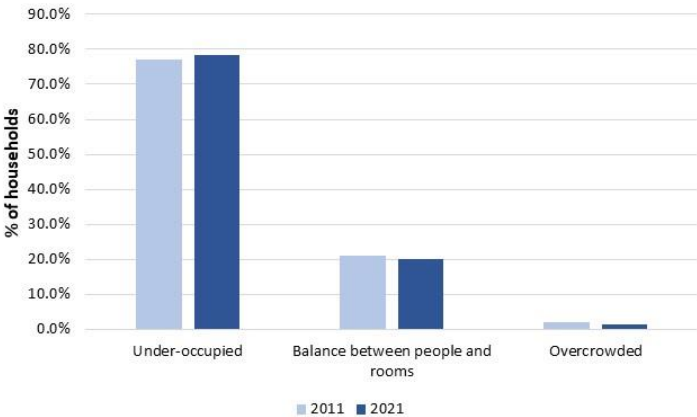

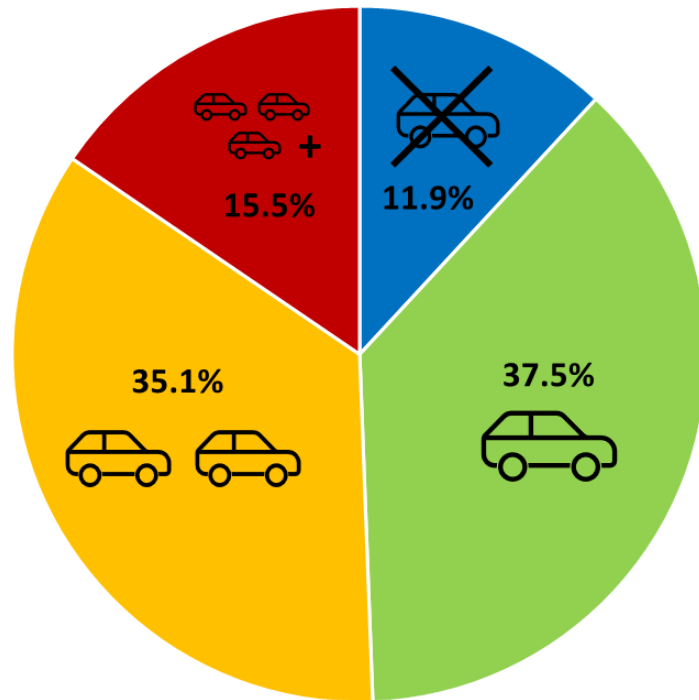

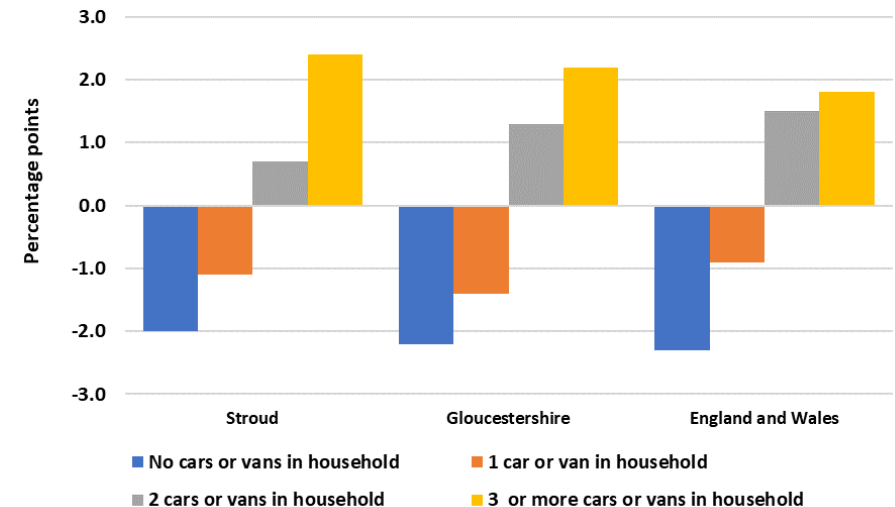

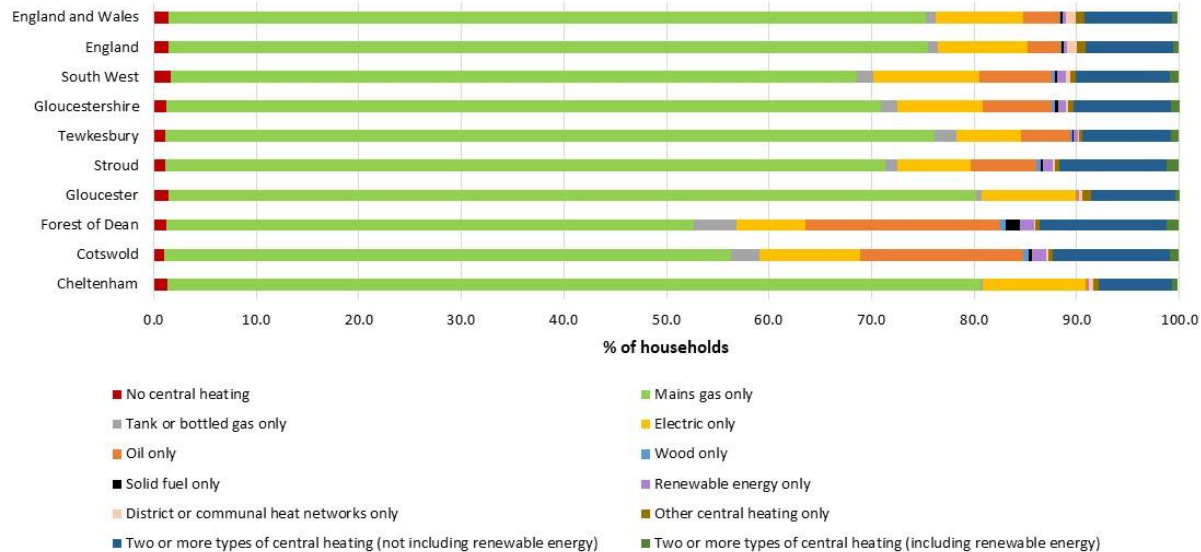

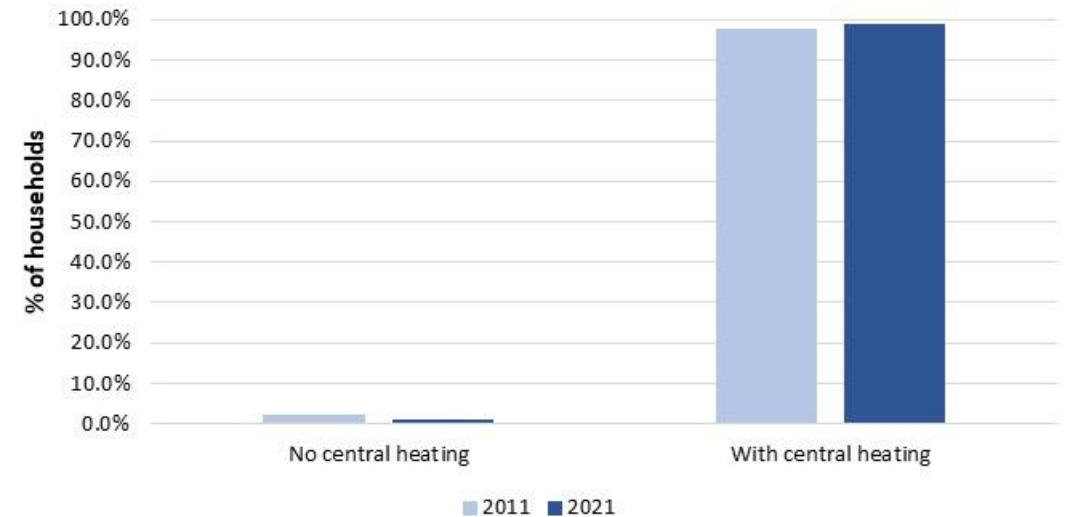

Percentage of households by types of central heating, 2021

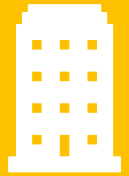


Proportion of Stroud's households by central heating, 2011 and 2021

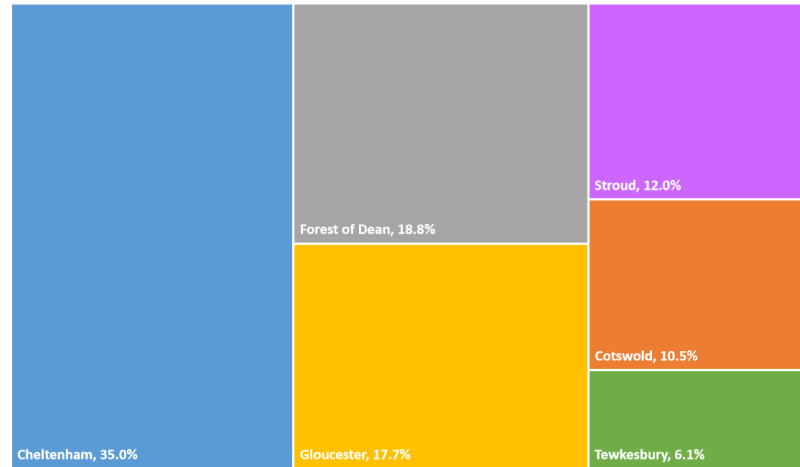

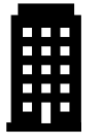

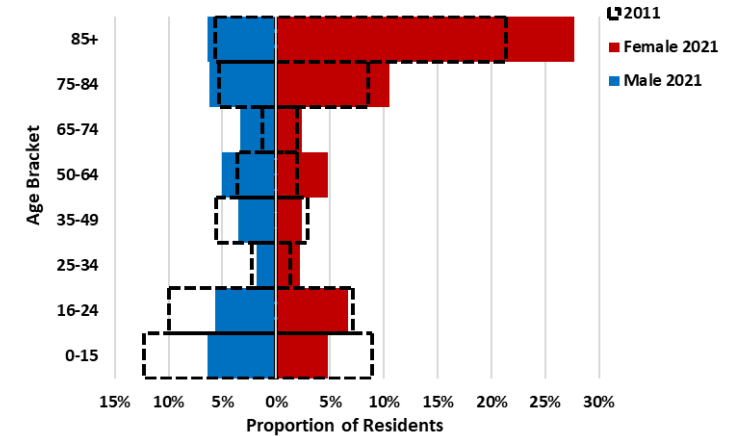


Non NHS/LA care home with nursing 33.0%
