




Gloucestershire Leisure and Tourism enterprises by size




Leisure and Tourism employment by local authority area (2015)






Leisure and Tourism employment by sub-sector, Gloucestershire and Great Britain

Average annual growth in Leisure and Tourism (2011-2015), Gloucestershire and Great Britain










