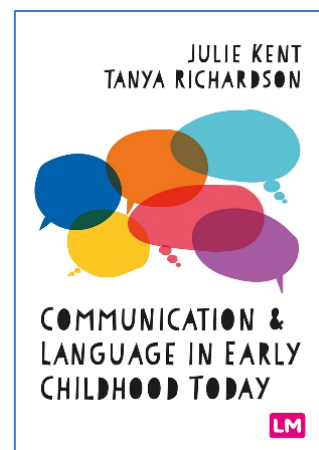
The team look forward to bringing back the updates and inspirations gained back to Gloucestershire to share with the sector.
