An update on your project

Once complete, the upgraded transport hub will offer additional bus services and better connections to local sustainable transport such as walking and cycling routes.

It will also provide a range of new and improved facilities on site. These include:

- A covered waiting area with seating
- Real-time information screens and information desk
- An indoor waiting area with the opportunity for a refreshments facility
- Electric vehicle charging points
- Toilets including a dedicated Changing Places toilet

The scheme is being funded by UK Government's Housing Infrastructure Fund (HIF), administered by Homes England, and by Gloucestershire County Council
