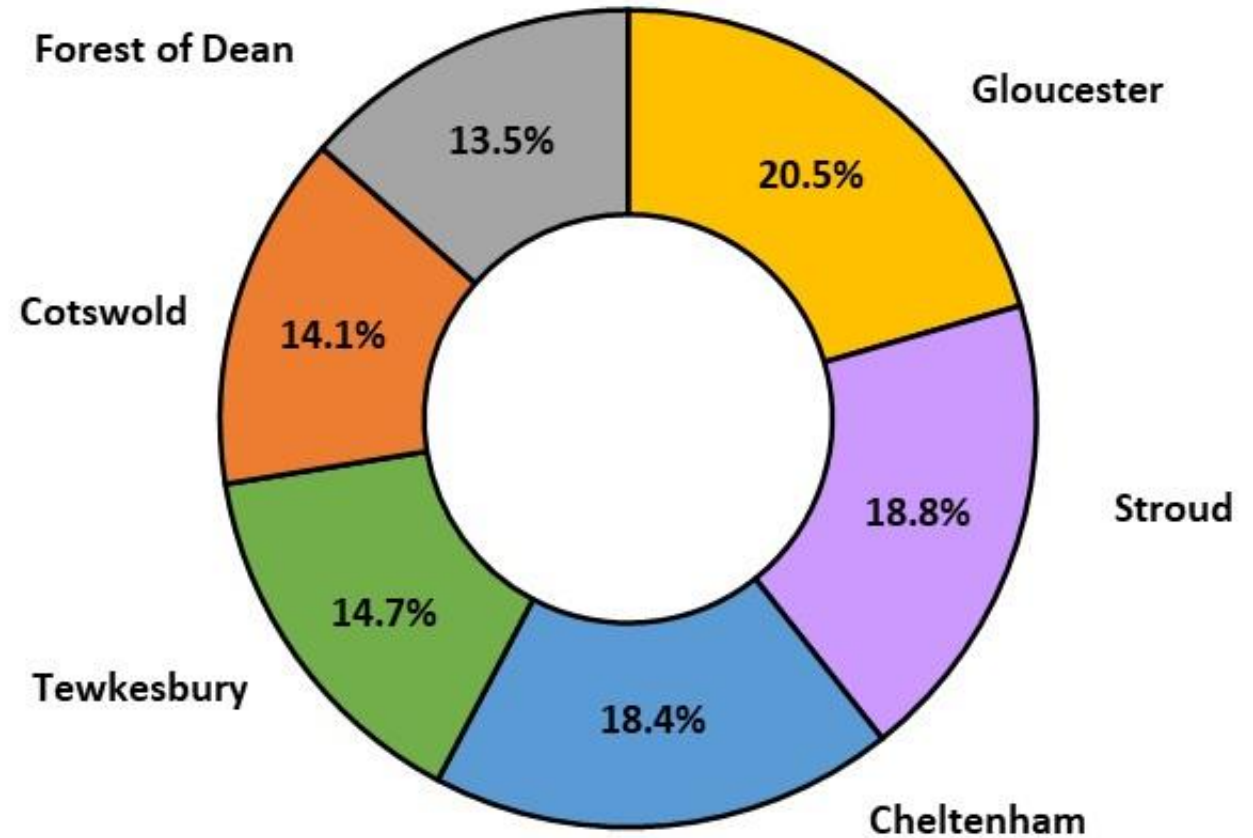

Population Distribution of Gloucestershire, 2021



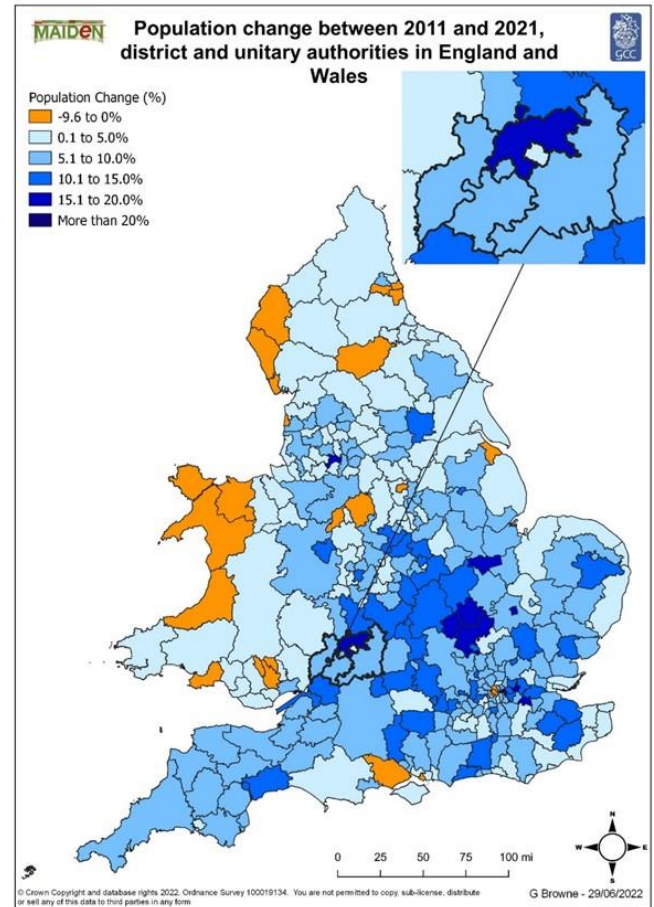

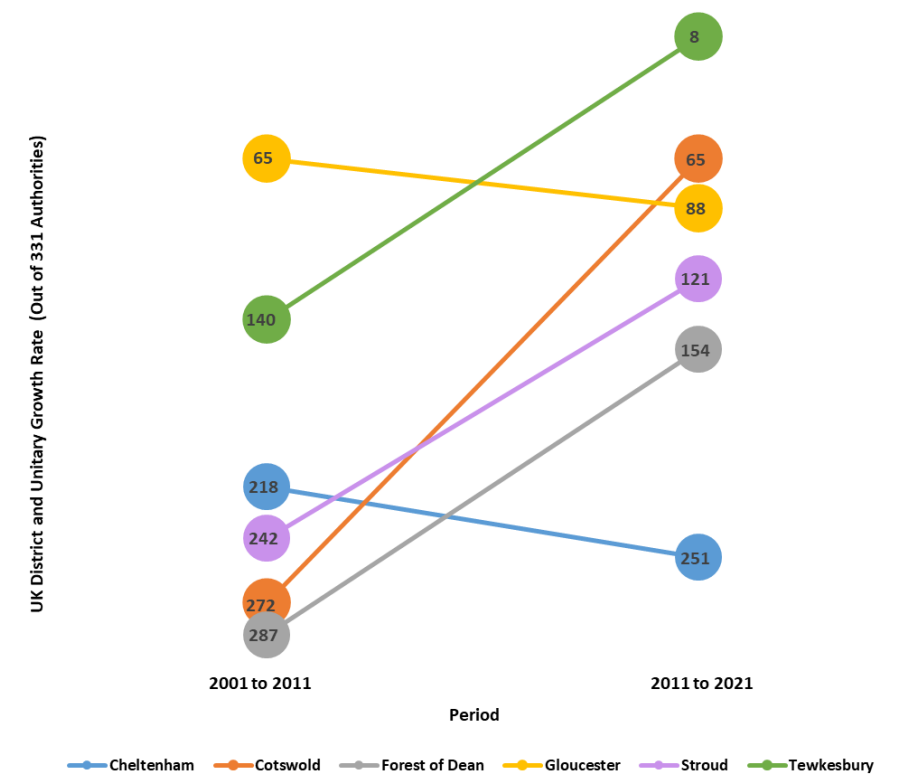

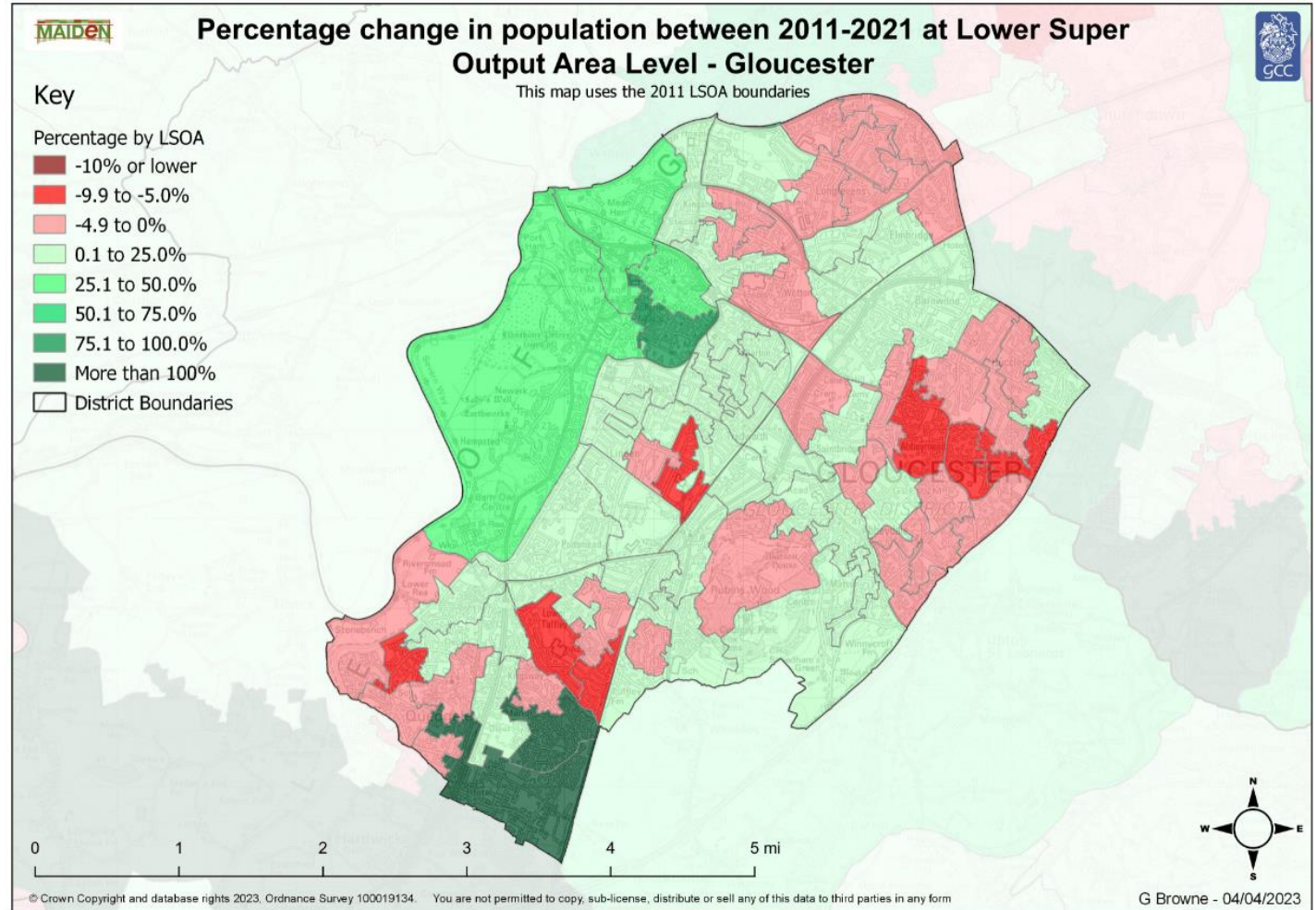

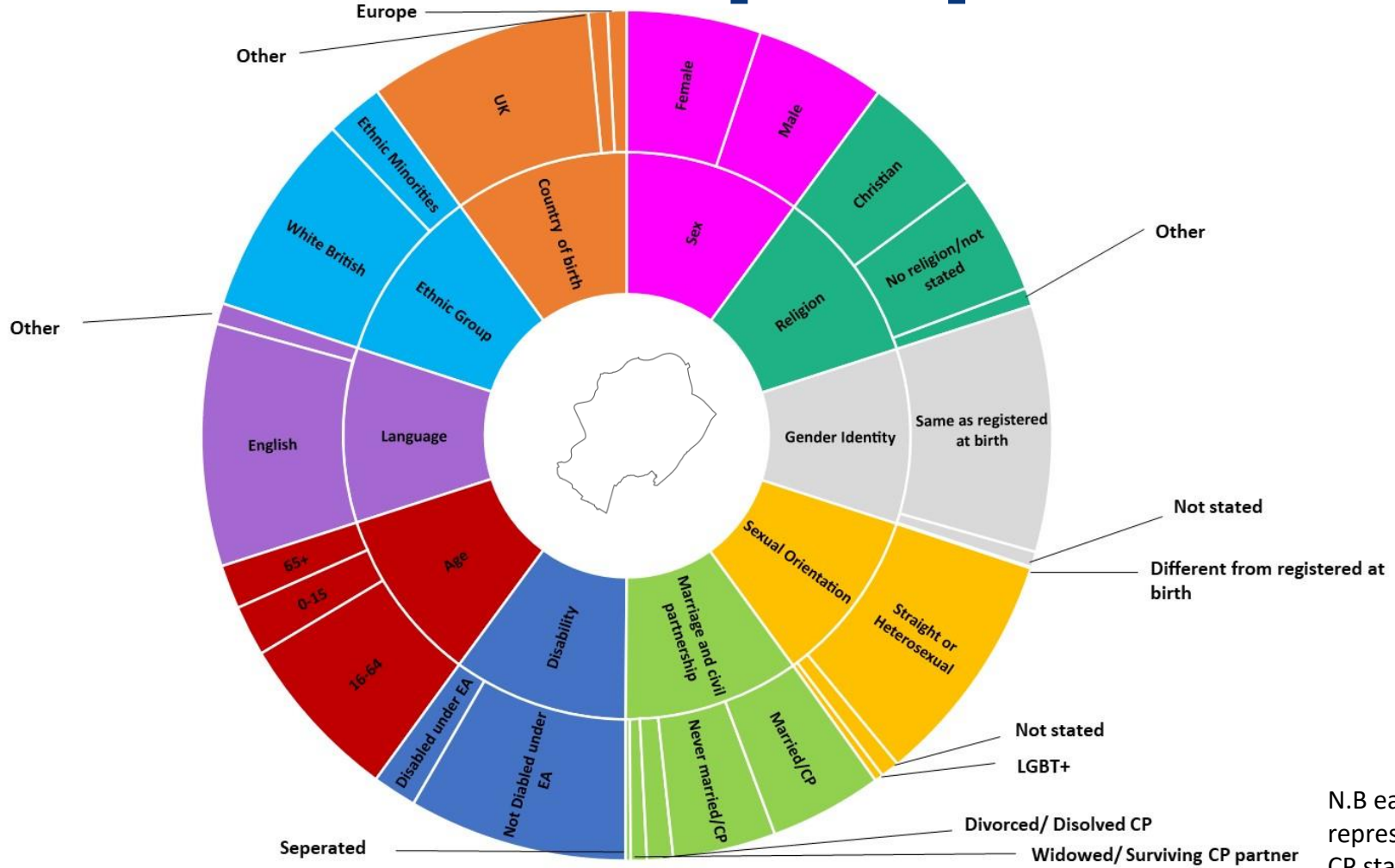

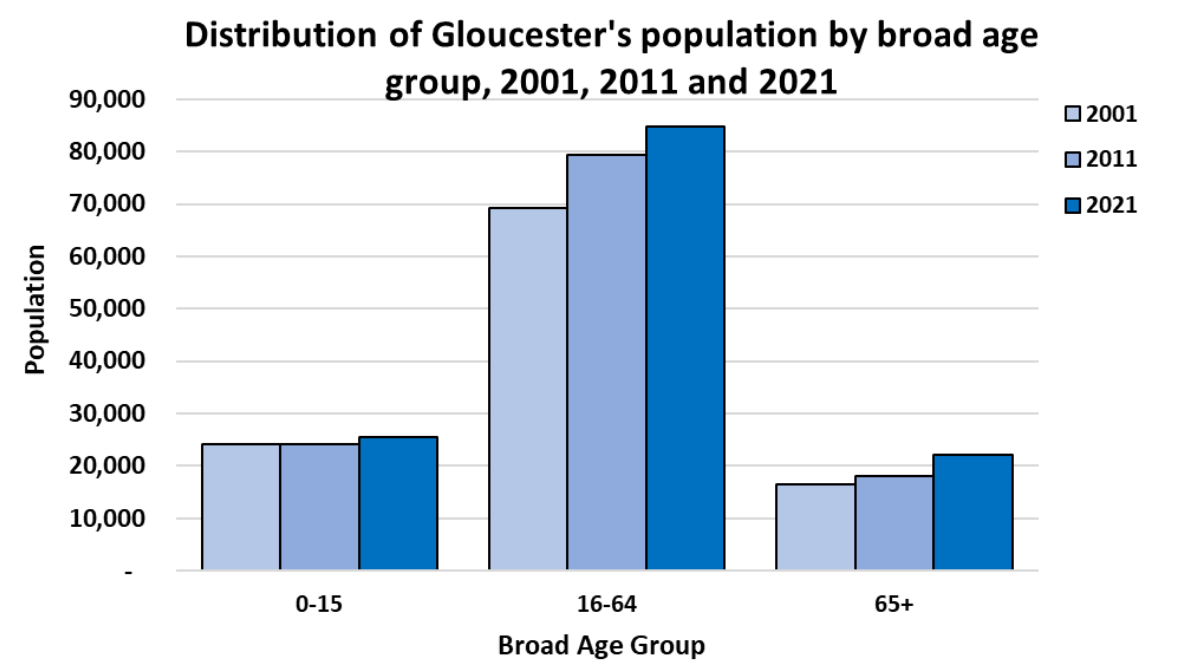
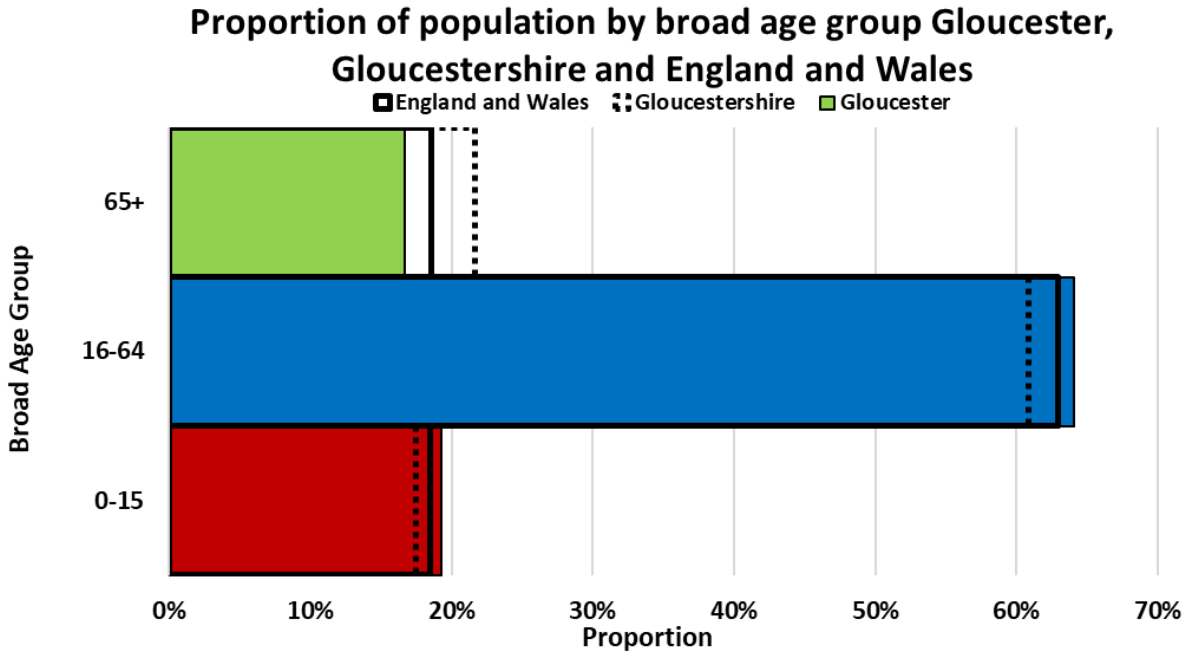
1st highest % of 0-15 year olds (out of Gloucestershire's 6 districts)

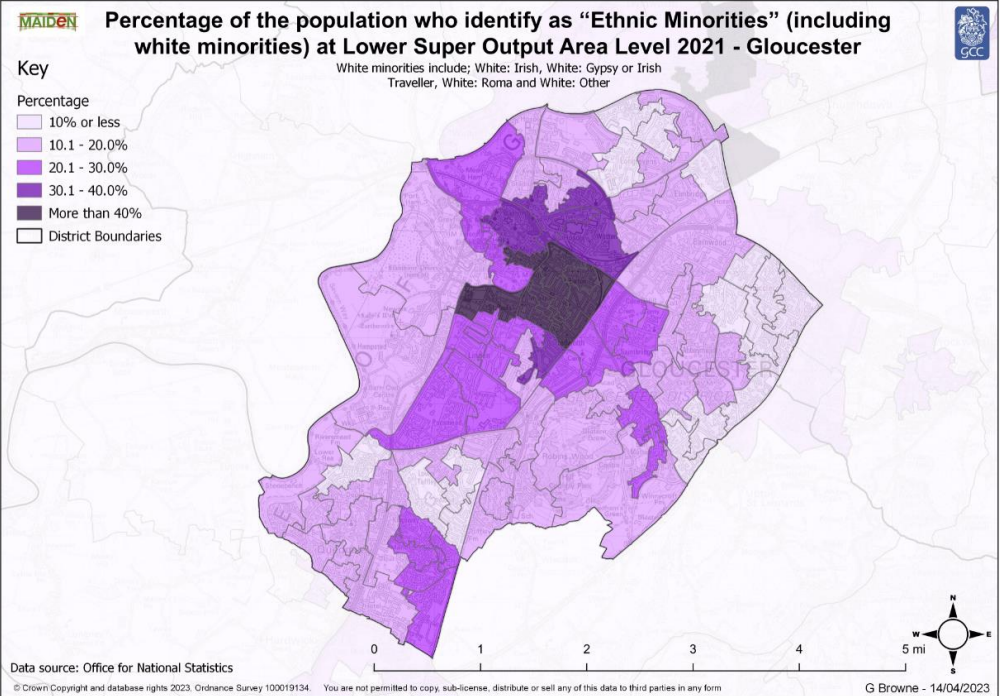
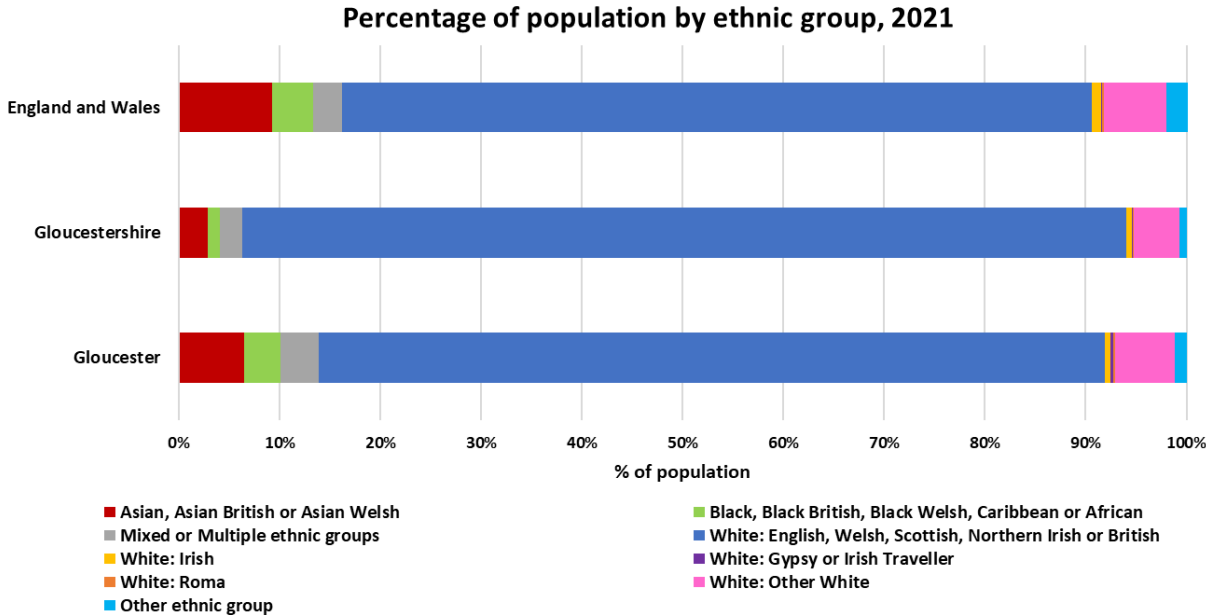

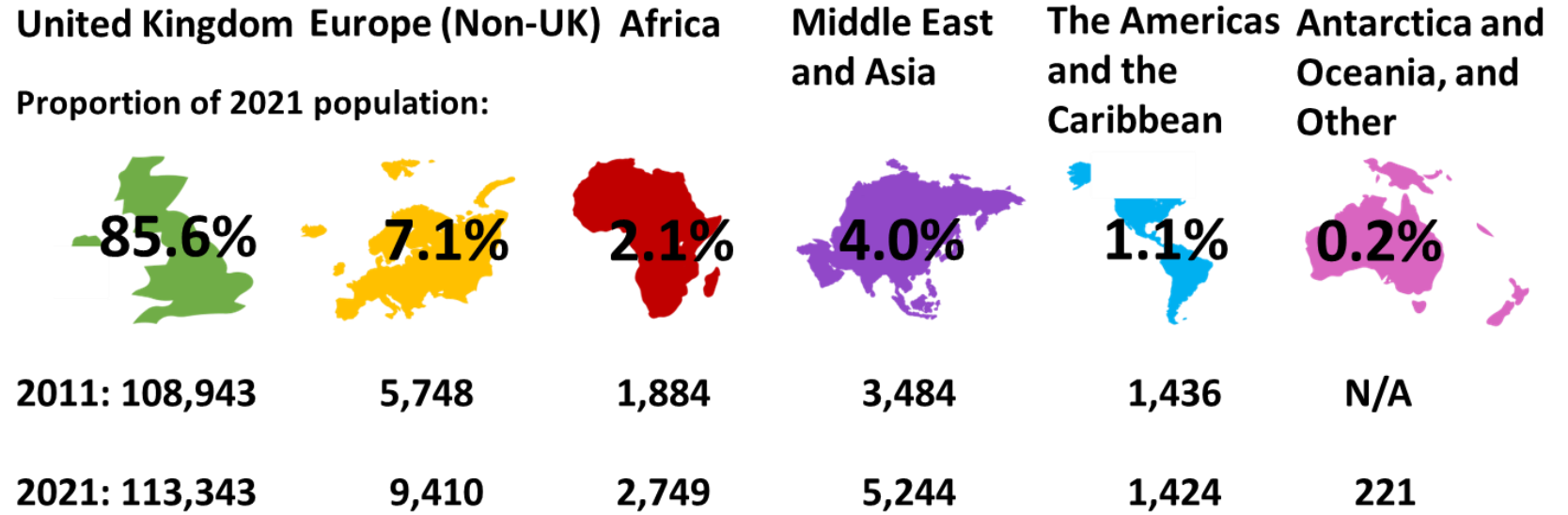


Country of birth

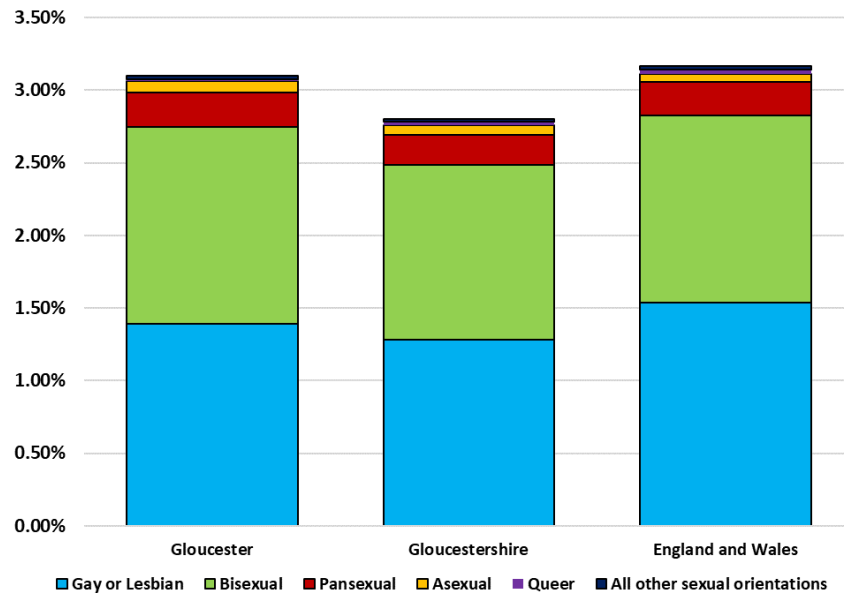
Sexual orientation and gender identity

0.5% of the population do not have the same gender identity as at birth

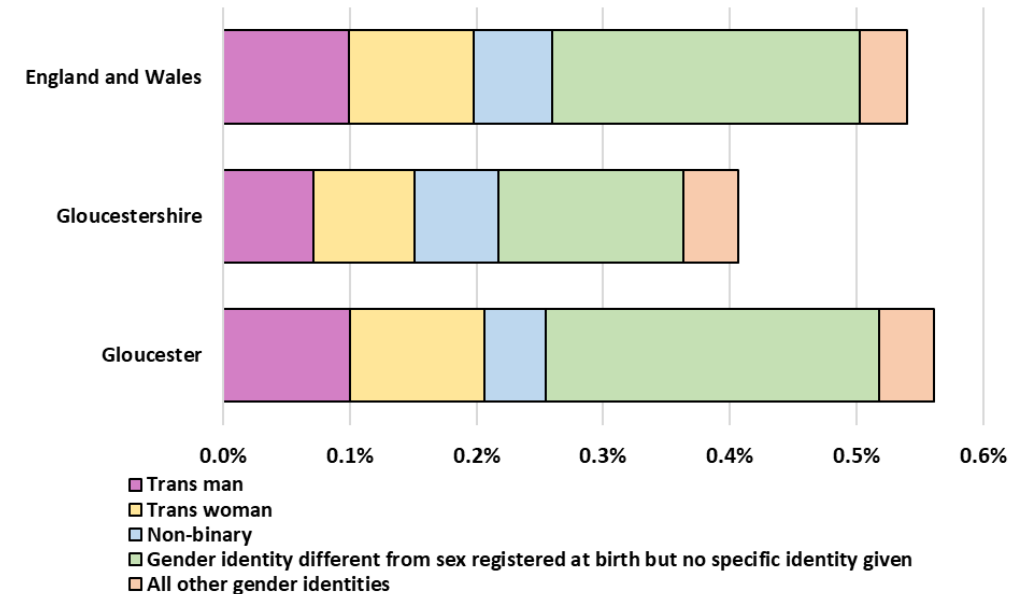

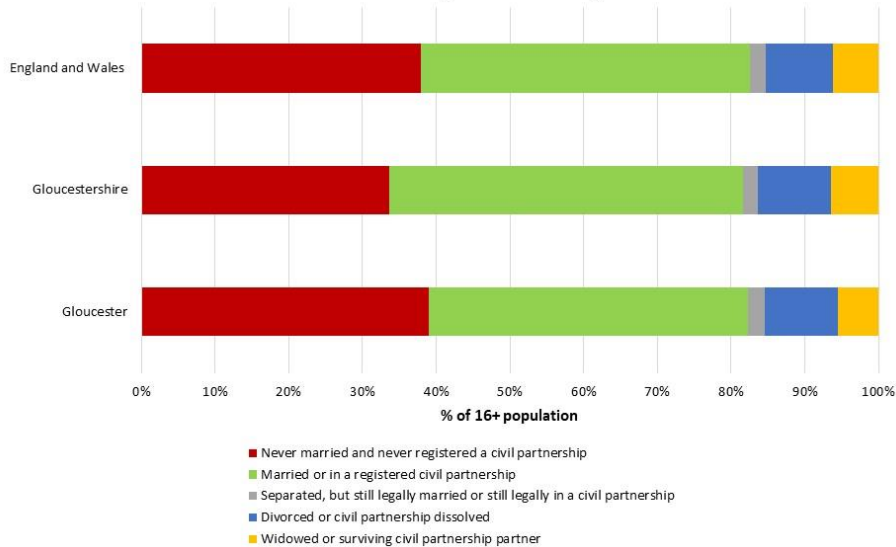

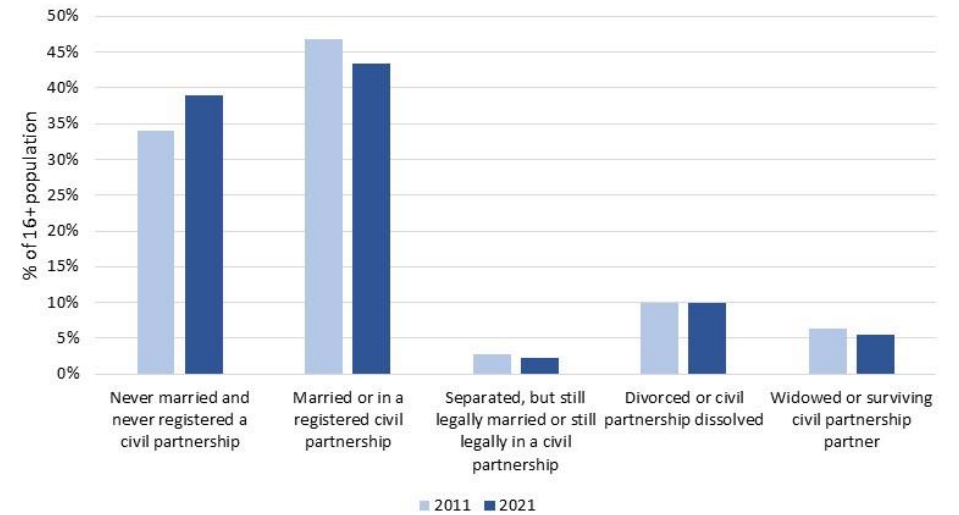

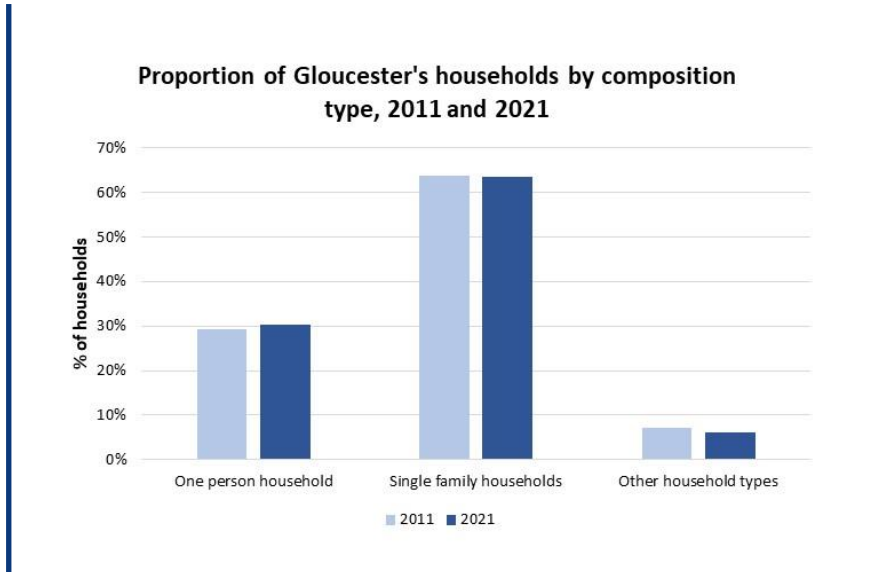
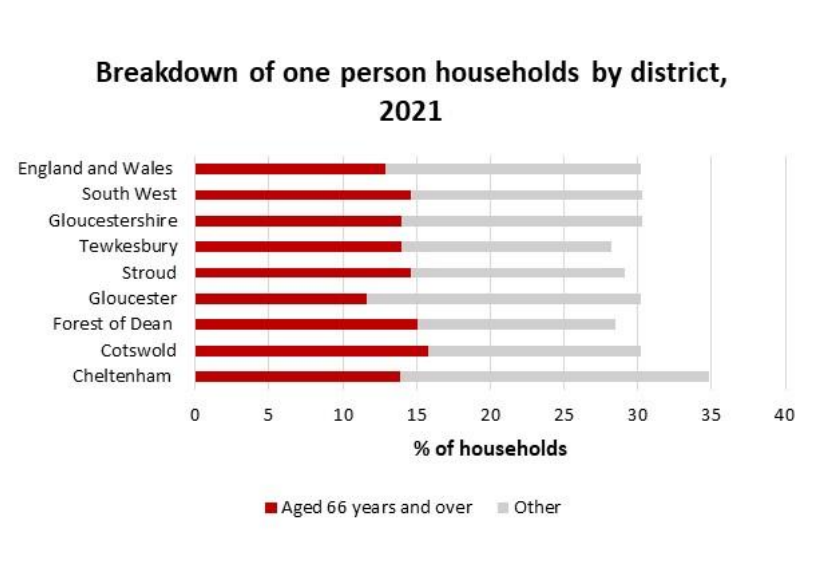

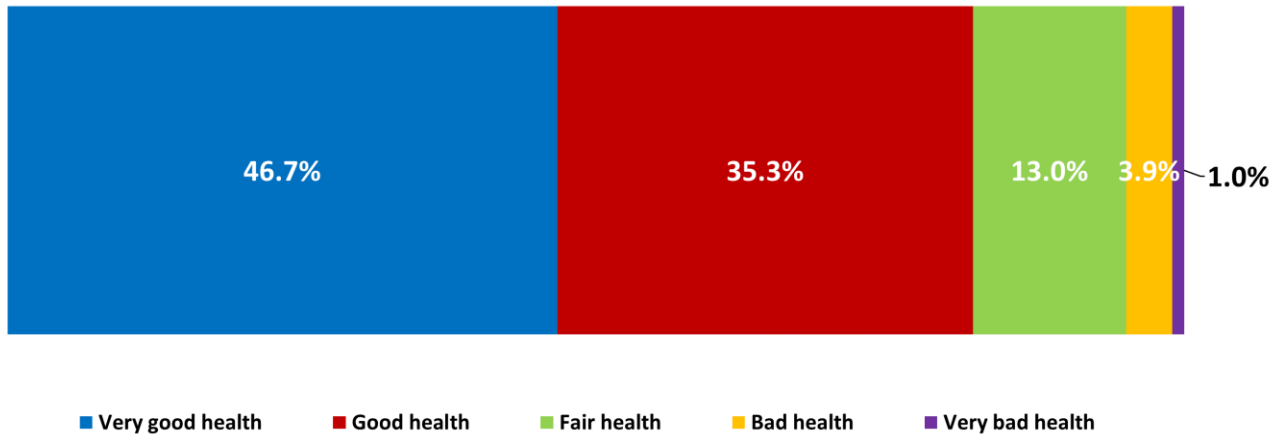

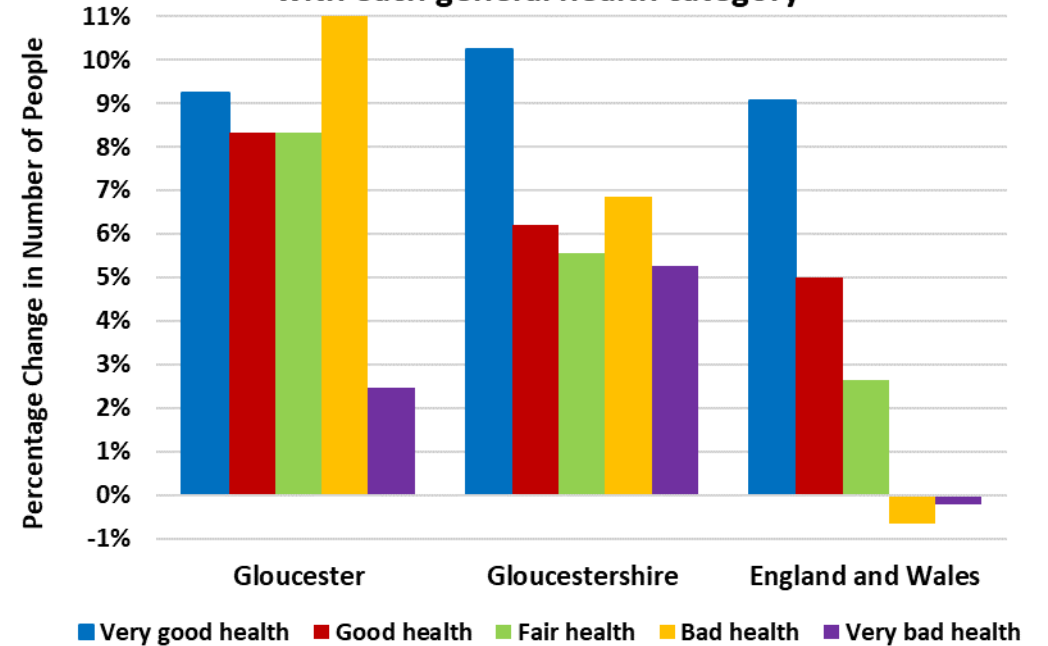

Disability

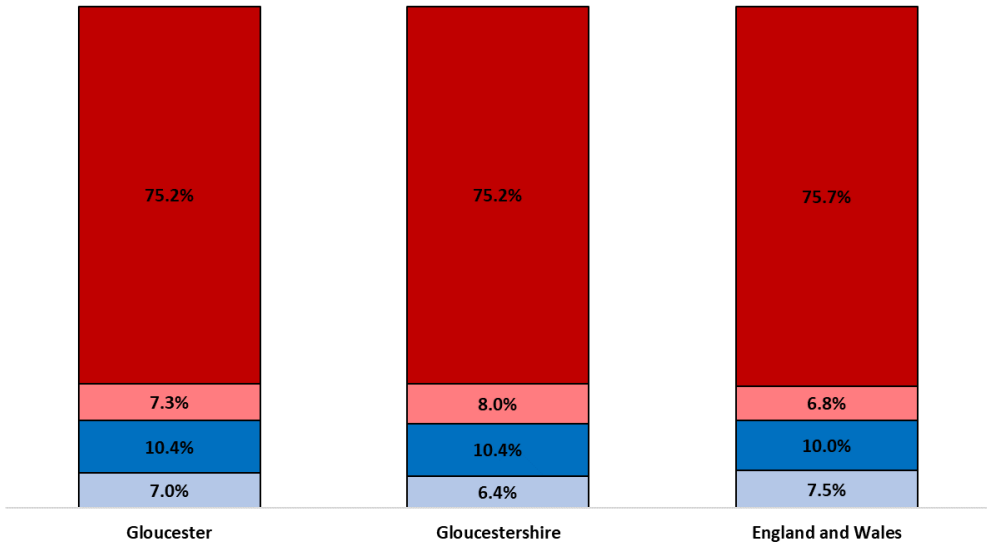
17.4% of the population are disabled under the Equality Act (2010)

7.3% not disabled but do have a long term physical or mental health condition(s)

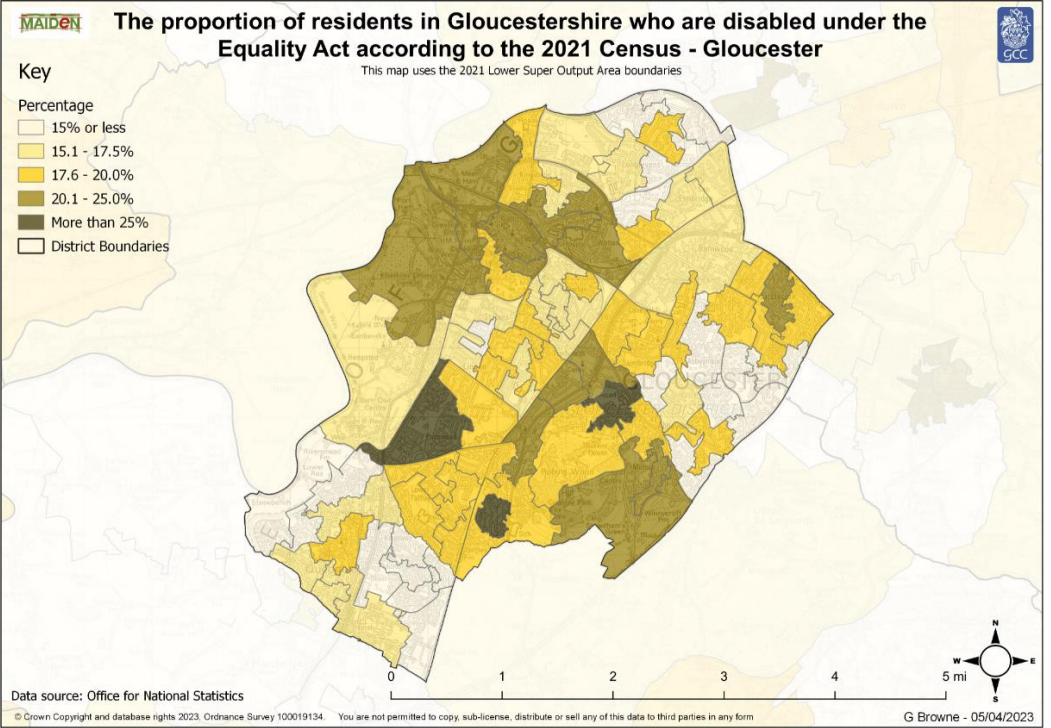
In some LSOAs **1 in 4** people are classed as disabled

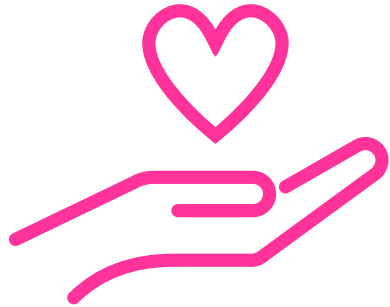

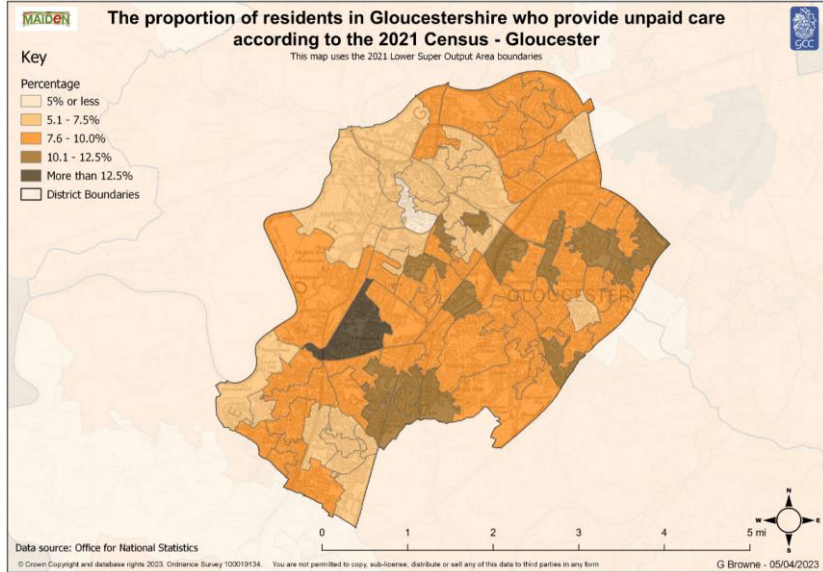
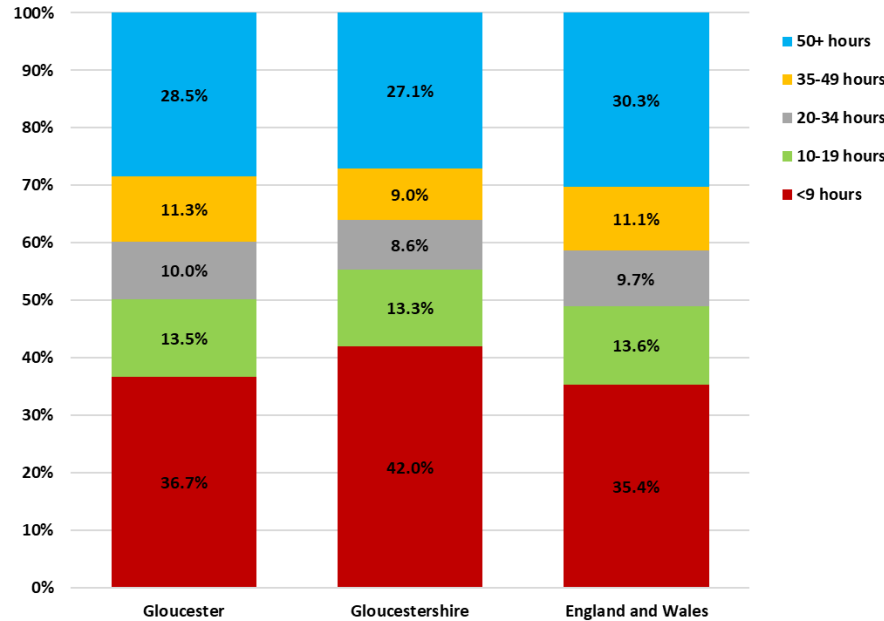

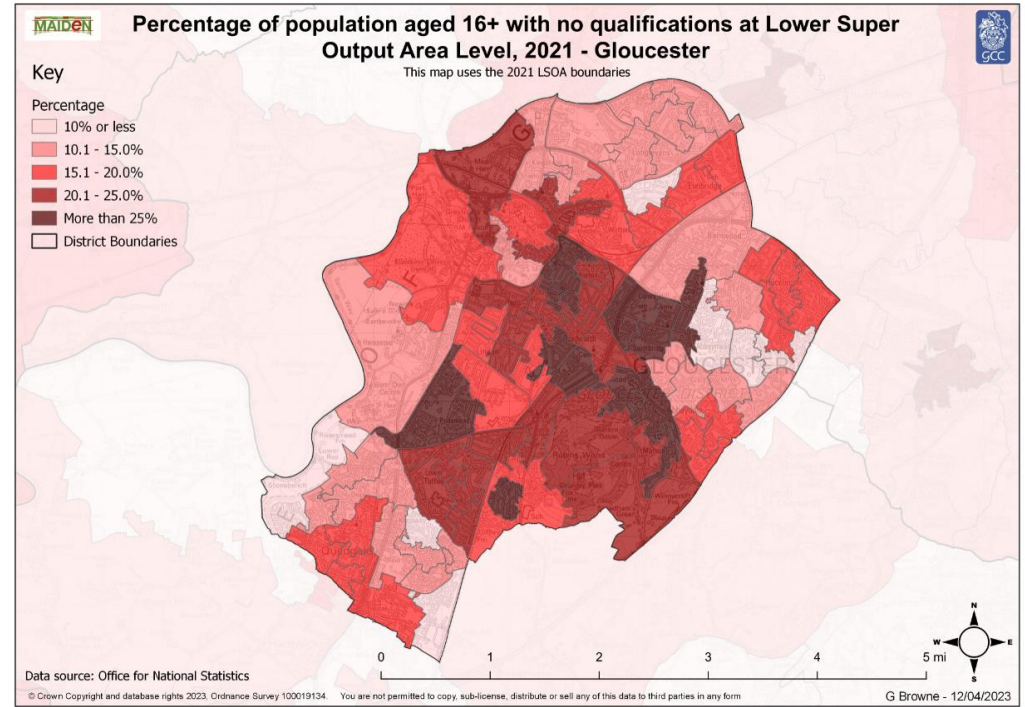

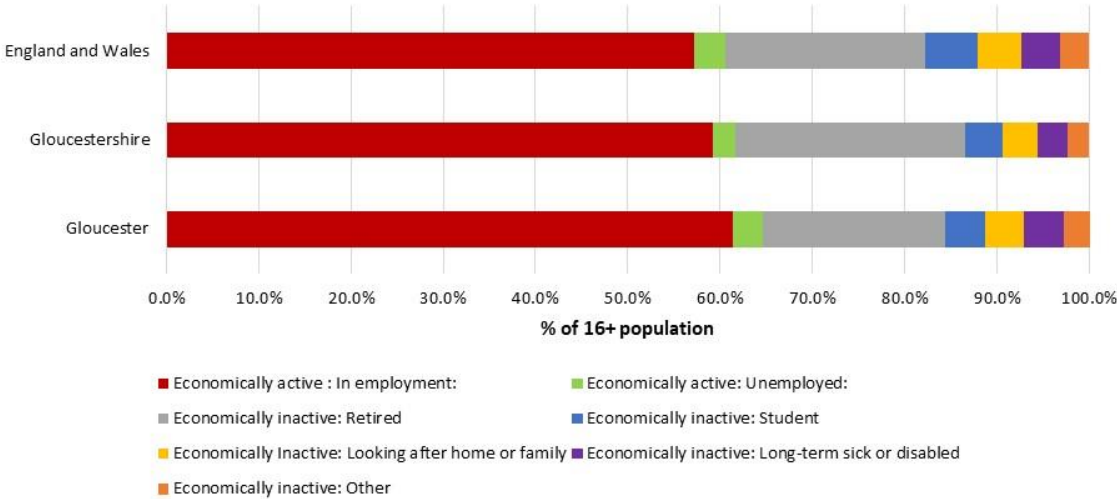

Change in the proportion of the 16+ population's economic activity status

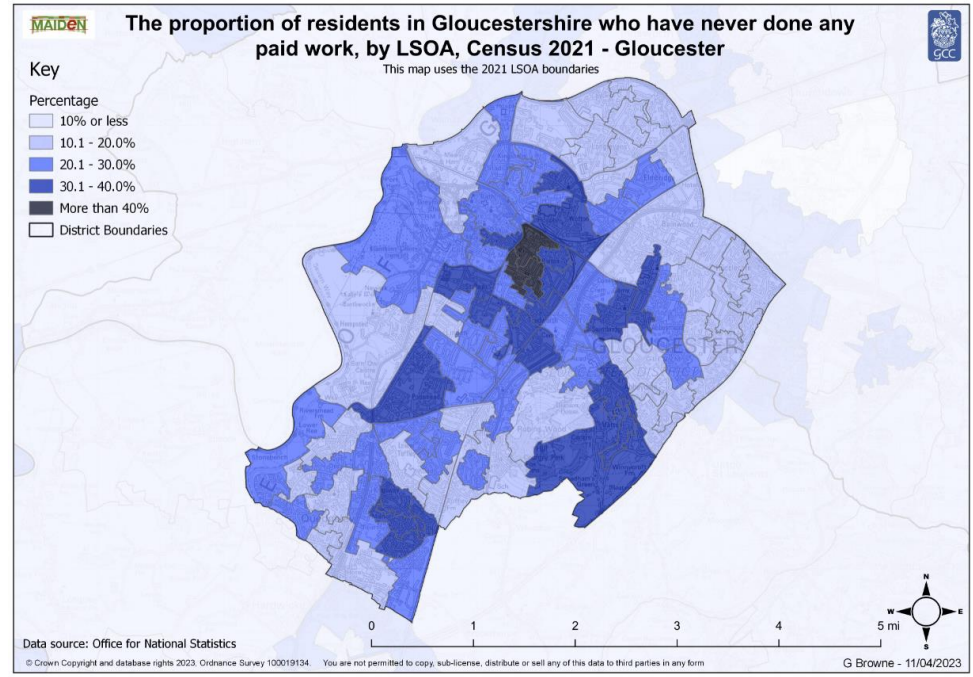
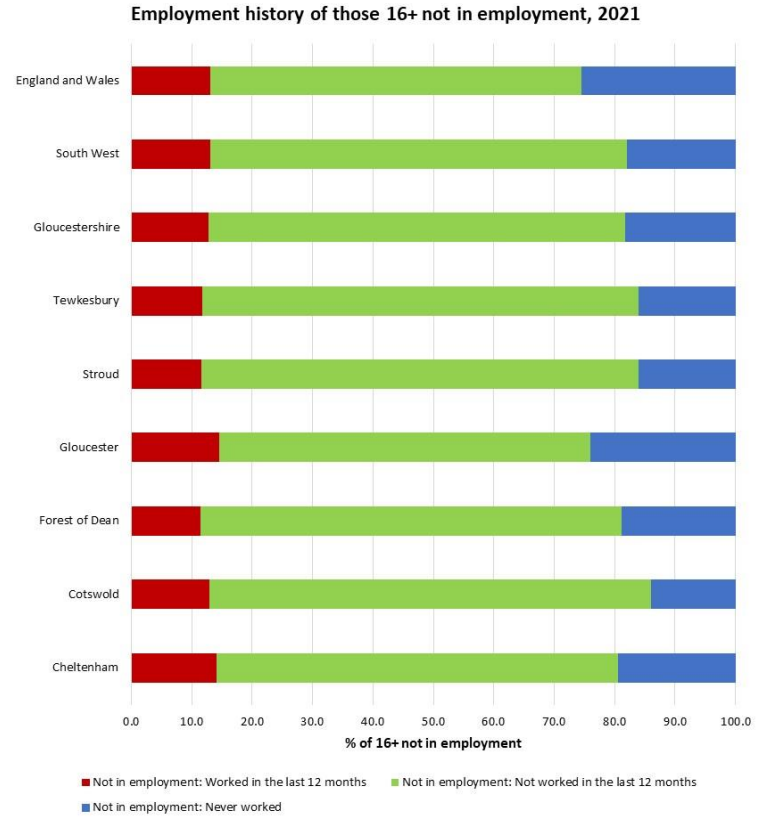

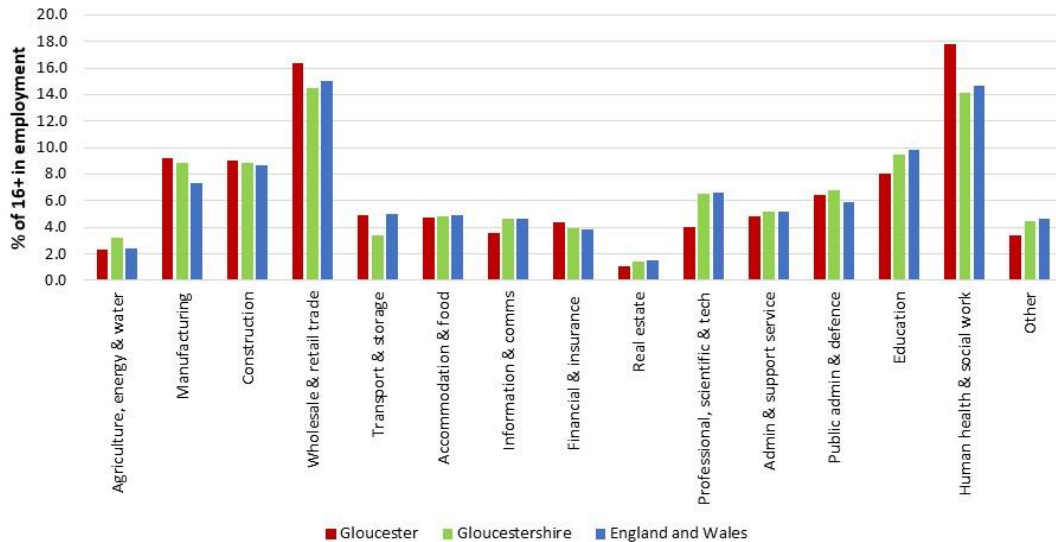

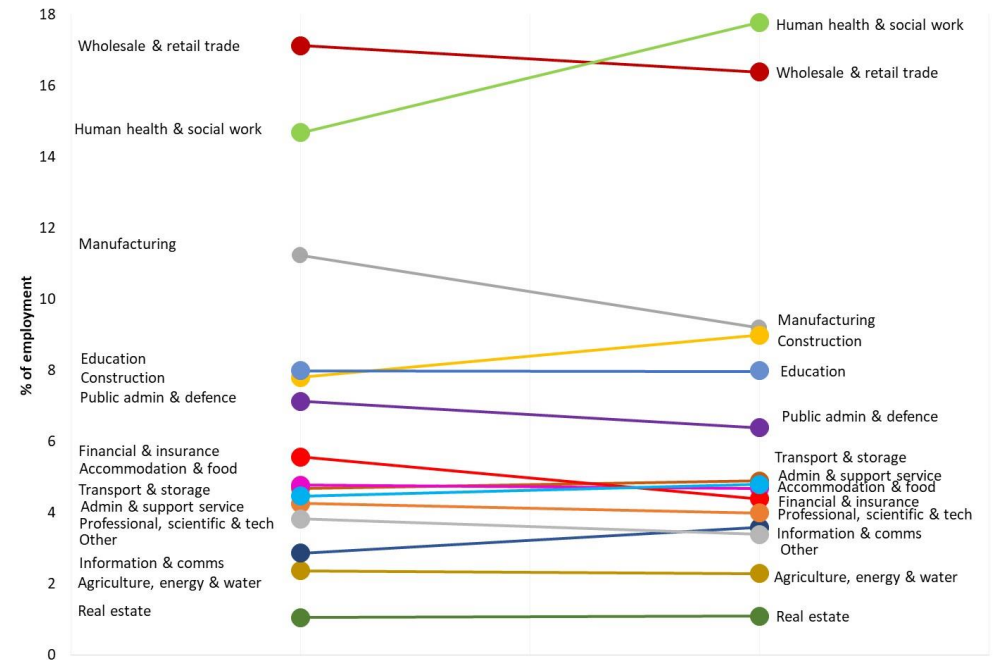

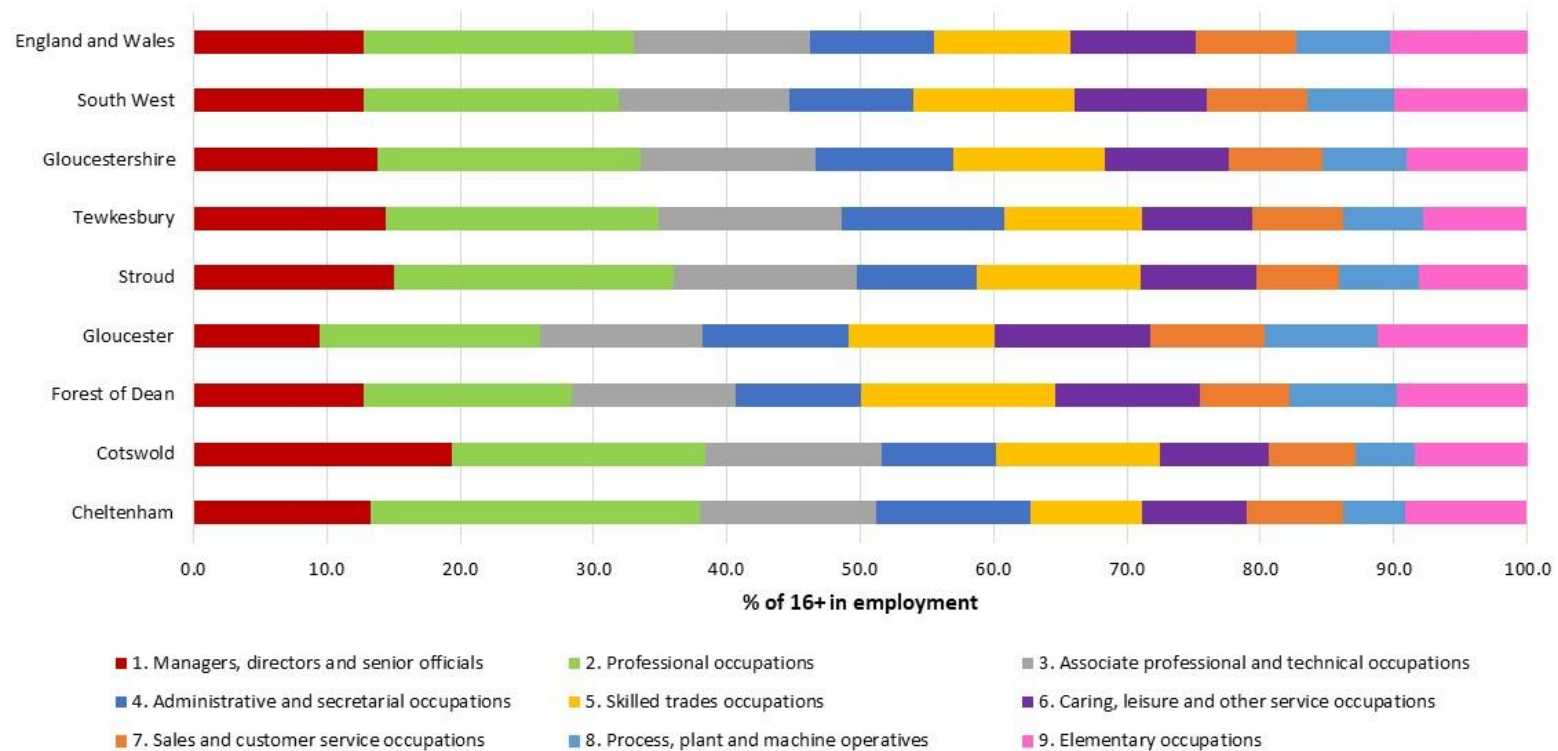

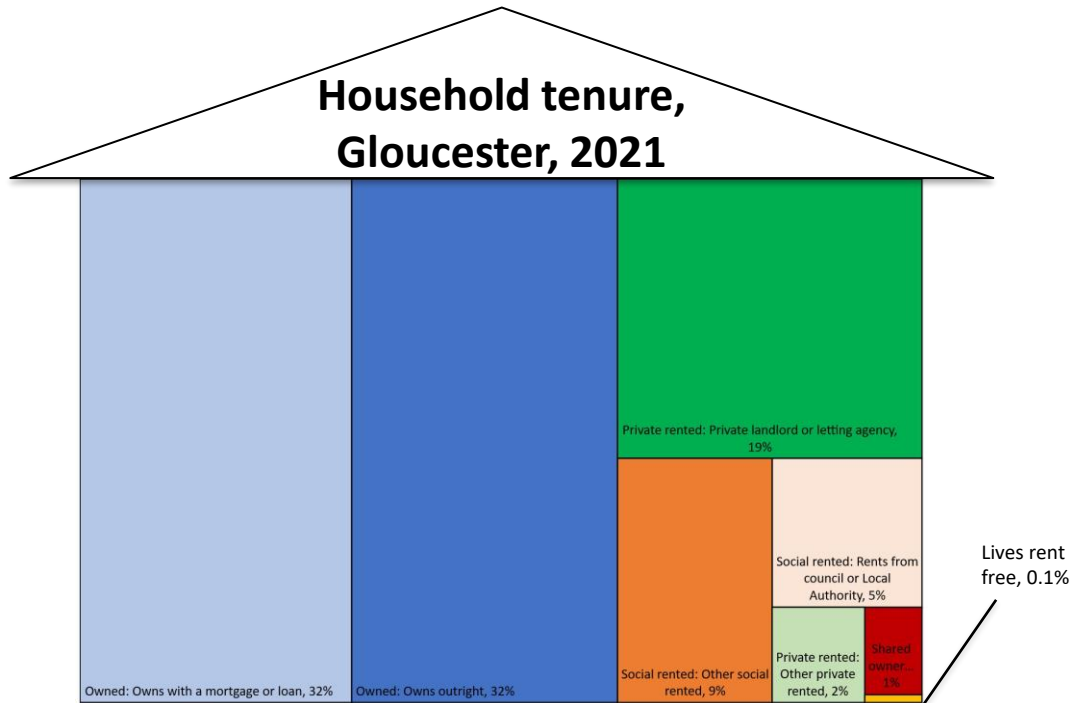

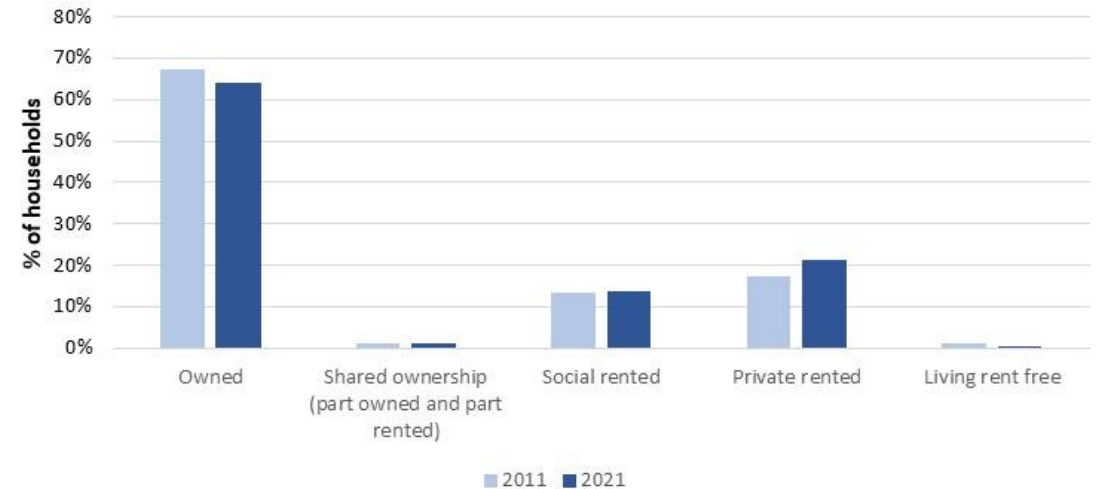

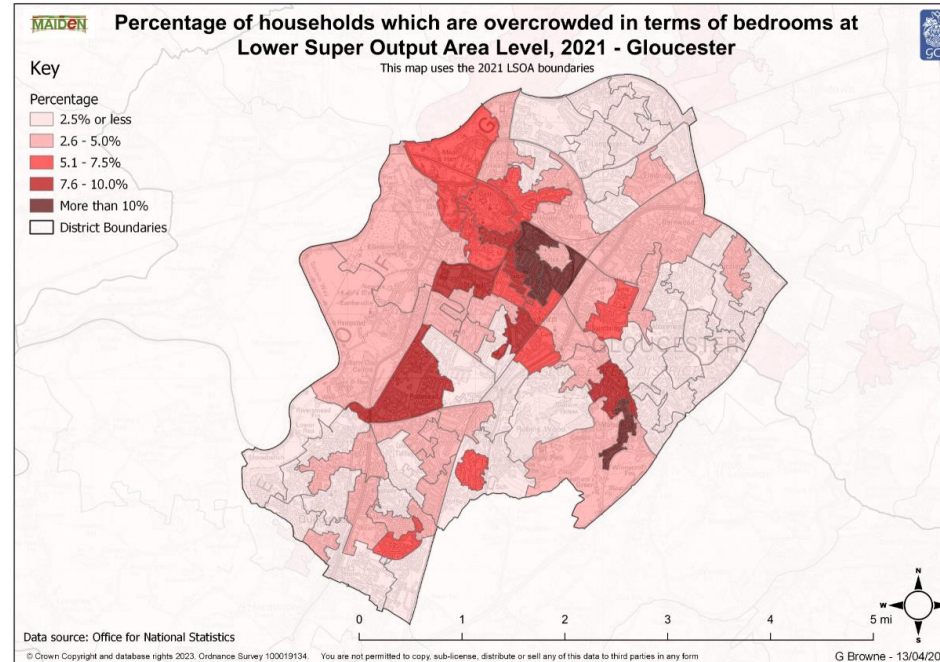

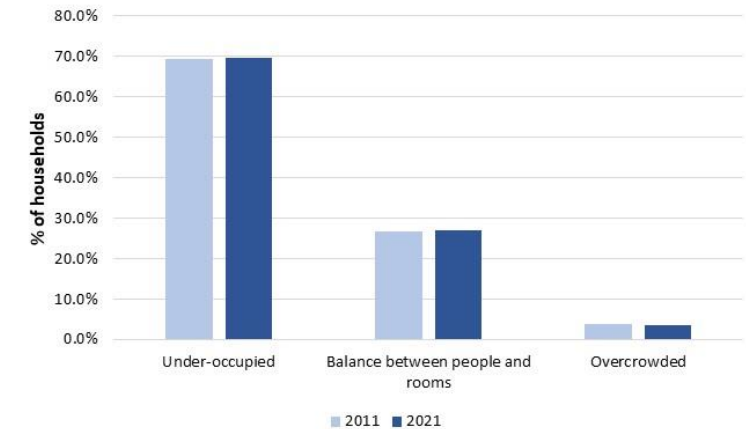

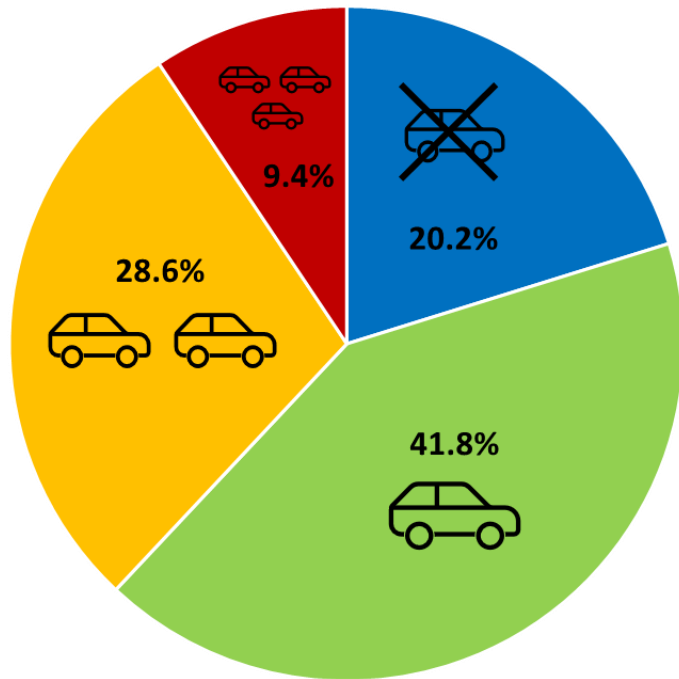

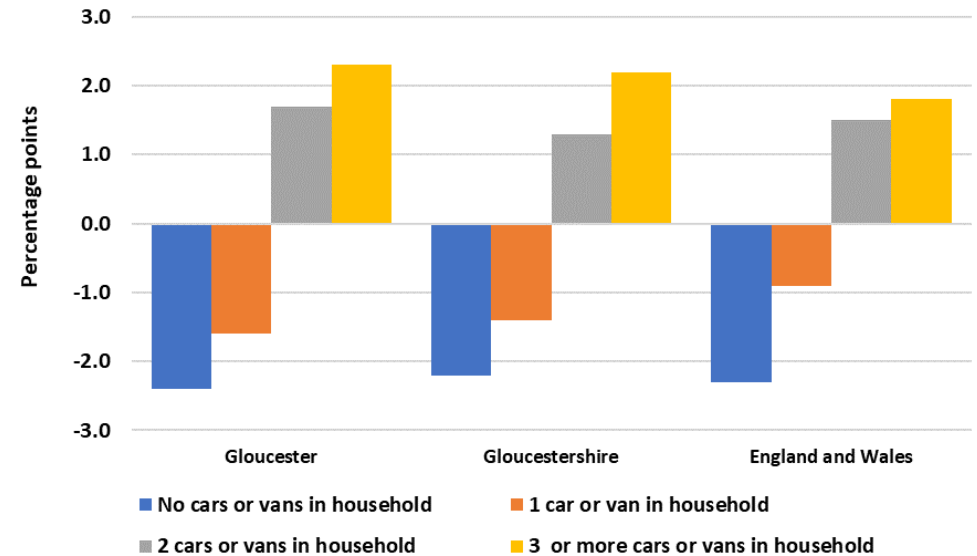

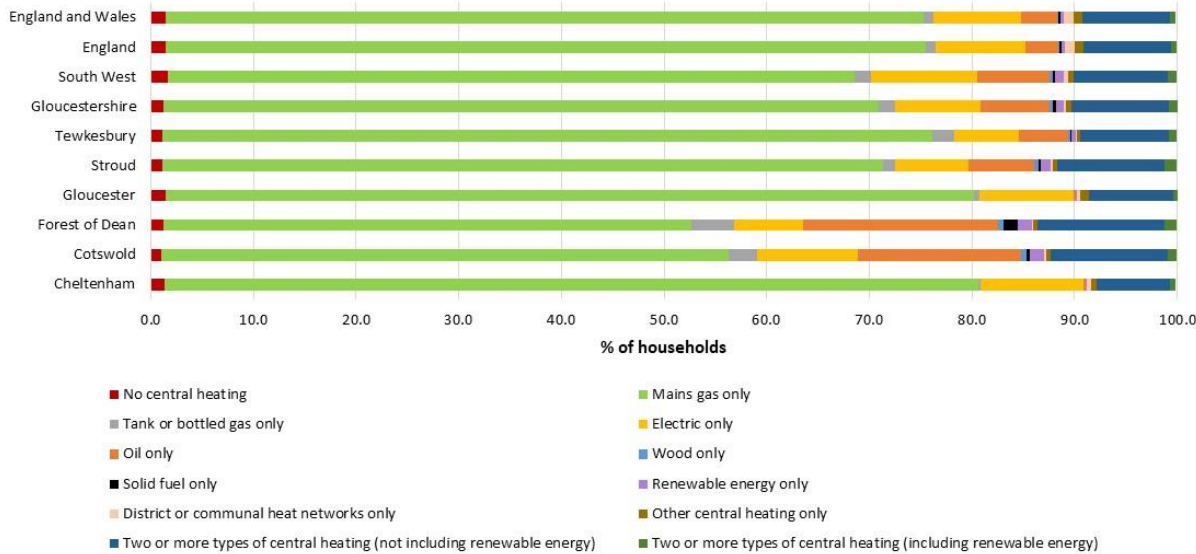

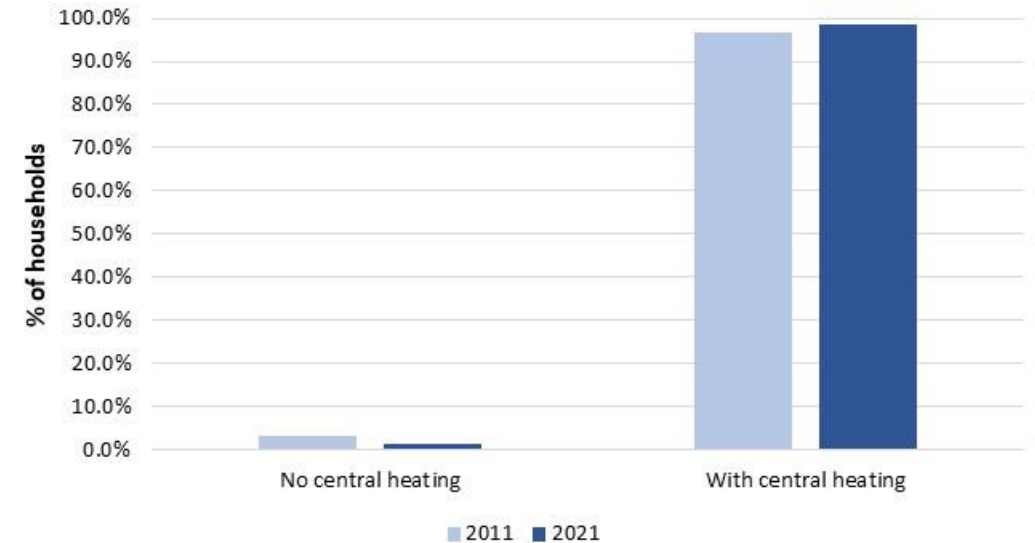

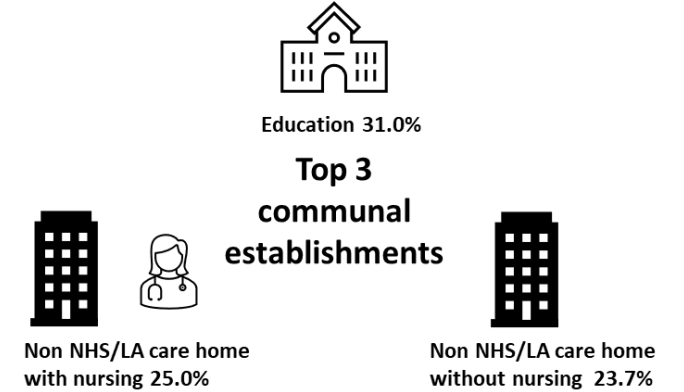
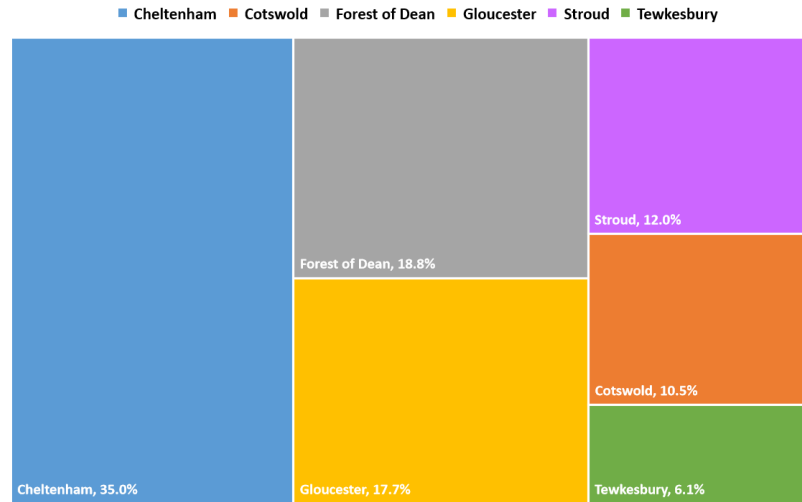
