

PUBLIC NOTICE
GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (KENSINGTON AVENUE) (CHELTENHAM BOROUGH) PROPOSED CHANGES TO PARKING CONTROLS 2026

NOTICE is hereby given that Gloucestershire County Council intends to make the below two Traffic Regulation Orders (TROs) under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which would be to amend parking controls along Kensington Avenue in the Borough of Cheltenham, Gloucestershire:

- 1. Gloucestershire County Council On Street Parking Order 2017 (Kensington Avenue) (Cheltenham Borough) (Variation) Order 2026:**
 - To introduce additional waiting restrictions; and
 - To introduce on-street EV Charging Parking Bays; and
 - To introduce further Cheltenham Z14 Permit Holders Only Parking Bays; and
 - To introduce Pay & Display Parking Bays.
- 2. Gloucestershire County Council On-Street Parking Order 2017 (Amendment To Schedule 1 Kensington Avenue, Cheltenham Borough) Order 2026:**
 - To introduce Pay & Display Parking Bays with charges as described in the Schedule below:
