









1st highest % of 0-15 year olds (out of Gloucestershire's 6 districts)




1st highest % of 16-64 year olds (out of Gloucestershire's 6 districts)




6th highest % of 65+ year olds (out of Gloucestershire's 6 districts)











Religion


Sexual orientation and gender identity

0.5% of the population do not have the same gender identity as at birth














17.4% of the population are disabled under the Equality Act (2010)

7.3% not disabled but do have a long term physical or mental health condition(s)




In some LSOAs 1 in 4 people are classed as disabled






























