Thank you for your email and copies of the objections.

My initial thoughts on reading the objections which I recognise come from the owner and agent of the owner of Verney Field, is on what basis can they draw an application to formalise a footpath across unregistered land into issues concerning the future of Verney Field.

My initial application mistakenly assumed that the logical termination of the path would be in Verney Field, but I was corrected and advised that the formal junction must be with MST30 which is in fact also on unregistered land.

I can only assume that my application to formalise the path is being dragged into the ongoing issues between Stonehouse residents, Stonehouse Town Council and the owner of Verney field together with his agent. In which case, I have no interest in adding anything further to my application. It was made and supported with good intent and must be judged on the facts presented.
