

Answers to Thomas Workman's Cargo

Manifest of the cargo discharged from the Shippe the *Greene Dragon* of Gloucester, John Edwards, Master, Thomas Workman, owner. 23 June 1550.

40 tuns of wine from Gascony, 4 dickers of hides from Ireland, 1 wey of salt from Brittany, 6 kilderkins of spices from Constantinople, 8 hundredweight of iron from Spain, 12 hogsheads of port wine from Lisbon, 12 fitches of beef from Ireland, 4 pipes of figs from Turkey, 10 firkins of olive oil from Genoa, 16 dickers of leather from Spain, 12 weys of salt fish from Iceland., 15 fardles of furs. from Finland, 100 boards and 1 firkin of pitch from Sweden, 2 weys of woad from Brittany, 3 firkins of oranges from Spain, 12 fardles of canvas from Brittany, 1 kilderkin of apothecaries drugs from Constantinople, 4 pipes of fish sauce from Genoa and 1 tun of Sack wine from Spain.
