

A435 CYCLEWAY – CHELTENHAM TO BISHOPS CLEEVE

Montel Civil Engineering has been appointed by Gloucestershire County Council as the main contractor to complete Section 2 of the A435 Cheltenham to Bishop's Cleeve Cycleway.

Latest updates on the project as of 7TH of July 2025 are:

A435 Evesham Road/Wellington Road Junction

Northwest Corner
work on this corner has now been completed

The majority of work is now focused on final preparations and light surfacing. Work has also commenced on the South East corner, ensuring it will be ready alongside the other three corners for full surfacing during the upcoming weekend closure.

South West Corner
We are finishing kerbs and tactile paving, with final surfacing planned for the weekend road closure

The temporary mini-roundabout will remain in place until works are completed at this junction during the weekend road closure. During the weekend road closure, the mini-roundabout will be removed and the new pedestrian/cyclist and traffic signals will be installed.'

Upcoming Road Closure

11th July 20:00hrs to 14th July 06:00hrs
Wellington Road / A435 Evesham Road junction will be closed to all traffic. A diversion will be in place, of which details can be found on our website.

Works during Road Closure will include:

- Remove the existing road surface and temporary mini roundabout
- Undertake necessary infrastructure upgrades
- Resurface the road to a high standard
- Apply new road markings and safety surfacing
- Install and commission new pedestrian/cyclist and traffic signals



The Northern Cycleway

Work is progressing well. Drainage installation and the gully connections at the southern tie-in have been completed. The team is now focused on laying out the low-voltage (LV) ducting, while construction of the flow control chamber walls which will help preventing downstream flooding is also nearing completion.

A434 Evesham Road Cheltenham Racecourse Roundabout (through GWSR Bridge) to Hyde Lane Junction


A435 Road Closure:

As of 2nd June, a full road closure is in place between Cheltenham Racecourse Roundabout and the Hyde Lane / Southam Lane junction. This closure will remain until 8th of September 2025, after which the road will reopen for southbound traffic only. Northbound traffic will remain diverted until 31st of October 2025.

Please note: Access to Webbs Garden Centre and nearby properties remains open from the northern side of the A435 via Hyde Lane/Southam lane junction. Pedestrian access is also fully maintained; along the route barriers and signs are in place to control safe crossings.

Significant progress has been made over the past few weeks. In addition to site preparation, the installation of barriers, signage, and temporary fencing has been completed. Following the successful erection of scaffolding, work has now begun on the bridge with the careful removal of brickwork. This stage is particularly delicate, as the bridge is an antique structure requiring sensitive and precise refurbishment. Alongside the bridge works, we are continuing excavation in preparation for the installation of criblock walls. The removal of spoil is also ongoing as we advance through the various stages of the project. **Please note**, we have received some queries regarding the road closure. The primary reason for closure is the ongoing work on the bridge. Due to weight restrictions and to ensure the safety of both our site team and the public, it is not possible for vehicles to pass safely across the bridge at this time.

Thanks to your valuable ideas and contributions, we've identified a new way to give back to our local community.


In partnership with **Hungry No More** a dedicated food bank serving those in need across Gloucestershire, we're working to identify families who would benefit from donated bicycles and equipment.
