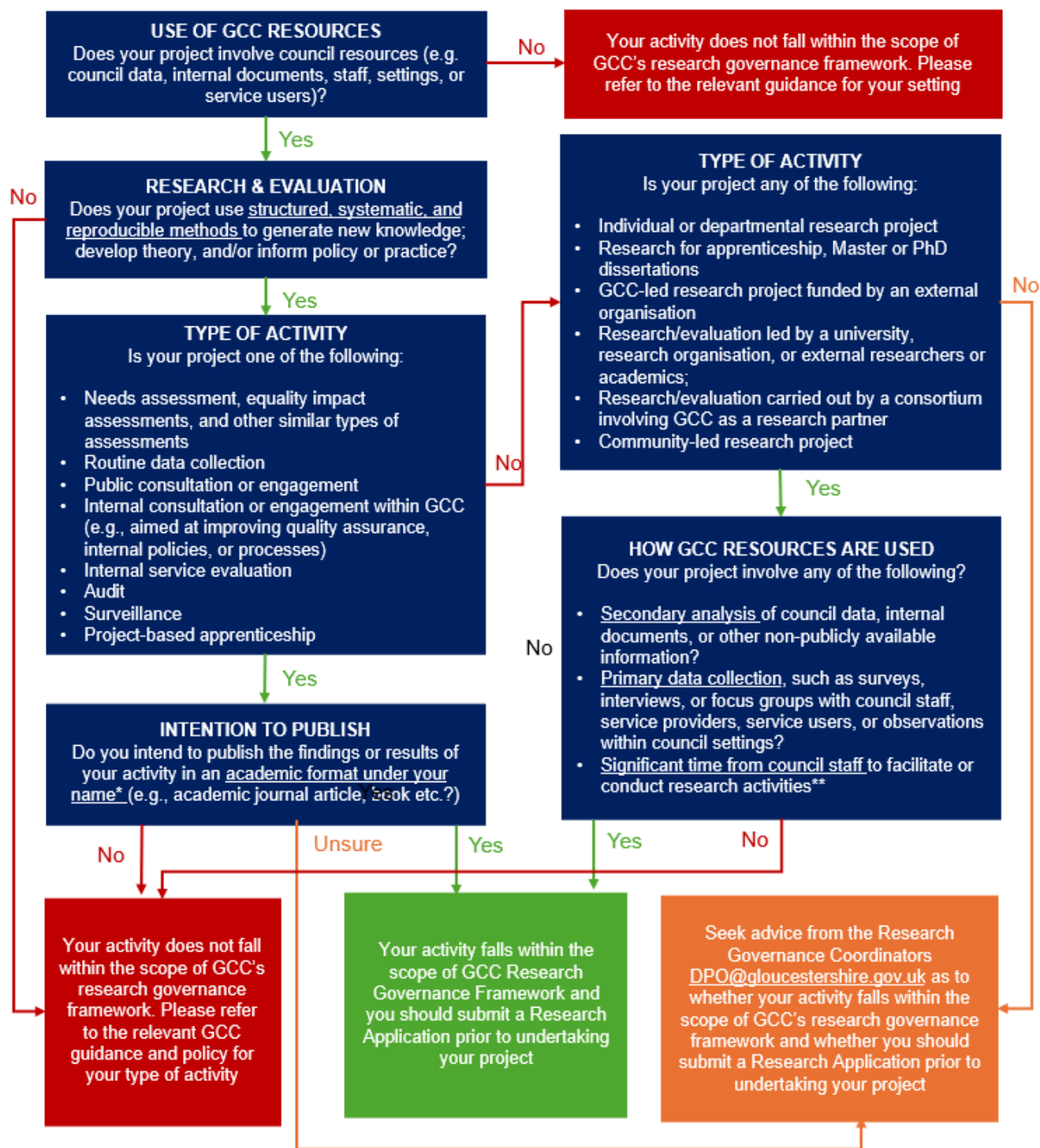


Screening tool

The screening can be used to determine whether an activity or project falls within the scope of GCC Research Governance Framework



* If you intend to publish findings and results from your research projects in an academic format under your name, you must ensure that appropriate research ethics are followed and that the council is sighted and given the opportunity to assess risks related to publication. Academic publishers require that participants are fully informed and have given consent for their data to be used for research and publication purposes. They also often expect that the study has received ethical clearance from the appropriate body. Please refer to the GCC's Research Governance Framework.
