## Advance notice of further survey works wb 13 May 2024: field at Wheatridge East

We are contacting you to let you know about some further investigative survey work to be carried out on the field at Wheatridge East, which is linked to the county council's intention to build a special school on the site.

The survey work is due to commence on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> May and last for three or four days that week.

We are contacting you on this occasion because the work involves digging a number of trenches around the site, which will be fenced off for safety reasons. The trenches will be filled in when the work finishes towards the end of the week.

We apologise in advance for any inconvenience caused whilst these works that are undertaken which will be more intrusive in nature than some of the survey and investigative work hitherto undertaken.

The activity you will observe on site that week does not represent the commencement of construction work of the school building, which has yet to have planning approval.
