

**GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(30MPH & 40 MPH SPEED LIMITS)  
(CIRENCESTER ROAD, MINCHINHAMPTON) (STROUD DISTRICT)  
ORDER 2026**

The Gloucestershire County Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 81 - 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of that Schedule hereby make the following Order:-

1. (i) This Order shall come into operation on the 2026 and may be cited as the “GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (30MPH & 40 MPH SPEED LIMITS) (CIRENCESTER ROAD, MINCHINHAMPTON) (STROUD DISTRICT) ORDER 2026”.

(ii) This Order affects roads within the Parish of Minchinhampton within the Stroud District in the County of Gloucestershire.

2. In this Order –

“Motor Vehicle” means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on the roads as defined in Section 185 of the Road Traffic Act 1988.

3. No person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed along those lengths of roads described in Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 to this Order at a speed exceeding 30 MPH.

4. No person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed along that length of road described in Schedule 2 to this Order at a speed exceeding 40 MPH.

5. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those regulations.

6. In accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act, the following Order is to be revoked:

**30mph Speed Limit to be Introduced by Traffic Order**

<b>Road Name &amp; Number</b>	<b>Description</b>
Cirencester Road (C268)	From a point approximately 85m west of the centre point of its junction with Butt Street (C270) for a distance of approximately 92m in an easterly direction.
