



## Standish Multi User Path (MUP)

Montel Civil Engineering has been appointed by Gloucestershire County Council as the main contractor to complete Phase 1 of the Standish Multi User Path. This phase, starting from Horsemarling Roundabout, will involve the construction of a 400 metre section of path suitable for cyclists, pedestrians and horse riders and will tie into future sections of the Gloucestershire Cycle Spine.

We are pleased to report that the construction of the new multi-user path is now nearing completion.

All remaining highway works, **including the installation of new signage** and reinstatement of the highway verges, are scheduled to be **8th June 2025**.

Surfacing works were successfully **concluded on 30th May**, along with the application of new road markings. The remaining tasks involve finalising the surrounding earthworks adjacent to the MUP.

As part of the project, the culvert running beneath the B4008 near Crowcumpill Cottages was reinforced last week using an internal lining method, carried out overnight to minimise disruption.

**Demobilisation of the site compound will begin this week, with the area expected to be fully cleared by the end of next week - 8th June 2025, Path will remain closed until that day due to high level of activities associated with site clearance.**
