

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(50,40 and 30 MPH SPEED LIMITS)
(VARIOUS ROADS ADJOINING THE A417
WITHIN THE COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER)
ORDER 2006

The Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Parts II and IV of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of that Schedule hereby make the following Order:-

1. (i) This Order shall come into operation on the 16th July 2006 and may be cited as the "Gloucestershire County Council (50, 40 and 30 mph Speed Limits) (Various Roads adjoining the A417 within County of Gloucestershire) Order 2006"
(ii) This Order affects roads adjoining the A417 within various Parishes and Districts in the County of Gloucestershire.

2 In this Order -

"Motor Vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on the roads as defined in Section 185 of the Road Traffic Act 1988.

3. No person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed in those lengths of roads described in Schedule I to this Order at a speed exceeding 50 mph.
4. No person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed in those lengths of roads described in Schedule II to this Order at a speed exceeding 40 mph.
5. No person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed in those lengths of roads described in Schedule III to this Order at a speed exceeding 30 mph.
6. Those Orders or parts of Orders referred to in Schedule IV to this Order are hereby revoked

SCHEDULE I
Proposed Speed Limits on A417 and Various Adjoining Roads
(50 MPH Speed Limit)

Road Classification Number	Name/Location	Description
A417	(Over to Maisemore)	From its junction with the A40 known as the Northern Bypass, north, to a point 235m south-east of the centreline of the junction of road number 50377 known as The Rudge.
A417	(Maisemore to Hartpury)	From a point 145m north west of the centreline of the junction of road number 40344 known as Old Road, northwest, to a point 56m south of the centreline of the junction of road number 40447 known as Danford Lane.
A417	(Hartpury to Corse)	From a point 910m north of the centreline of the junction of road number 3/69 known as Corsend Road, north, to a point 316m north of the centreline of the eastern junction of road number 3/65 known as Oridge Street.
A417	(Staunton to County Boundary with Herefordshire)	From a point 524m west of the centreline of the western junction with road number 40438 known as Ledbury Road Crescent, north-west, to the County Boundary with Herefordshire.
B4211	Worcester Road	From its junction with the A417, north-east, to a point 63m north-east of the centreline of its southern junction with the A417.
40315	(Road to Hawcross)	From its junction with the A417, west, to a point 39m west of the centreline of that junction.
3/57	Beech Lane, Bromesberrow Heath	From its junction with the A417, south-west, to a point 91m south-west of the centreline of that junction.
40264	Wood End Street, Bromesberrow Heath	From its junction with the A417, south, to a point 169m south of the centreline of that junction.

(40 MPH Speed Limit)

Road Classification Number	Name/Location	Description
A417	Hartpury	From a point 173m north of the centreline of the junction with road number 3/69 known as Corsend Road, north, to a point 910m north of that junction.
A417	Corse	From a point 316m north of the centreline of the eastern junction with road number 3/65 known as Oridge Street, north, to a point 38m south of the centreline of the junction with road number 50416 known as Prince Crescent.
A417	Staunton/Corse	From a point 149m west of the centreline of its junction with road number B4028 known as Straight Lane, west, to a point 524m west of the centreline of the western junction of road number 40438 known as Ledbury Road Crescent.
B4213	Straight Lane	From a point 104m east of the centreline of its junction with the A417, east, to a point 40 metres east of the centreline of its junction with road number 40333 known as Pillows Green Road.
B4208	Malvern Road	From a point 90m north of the centreline of its junction with the B4213, north, to a point 106m north of the centreline of its junction with road number 50295 known as Moat Lane.

(30 MPH Speed Limit)

Road Classification Number	Name/Location	Description
A417	Hartpury Village	From a point 56m south of the centreline of the junction with road number 40447 known as Danford Road, north, to a point 173m north of the centreline of the junction with road number 3/69 known as Corsend Road.
A417	Corse/Staunton	From a point 38m south of the centreline of the junction with road number 50416 known as Prince Crescent, north and then west, to a point 149m west of the centreline of the junction with road number B4213 known as Straight Lane.
B4028	Malvern Road	From the centreline of its junction with the B4213, north, to a point 90m north of that junction.
B4213	Straight Lane	From the centreline of its junction with the A417, east, to a point 104m east of that junction.
40437	School Crescent	Over its entire length
3/62	Playley Green (southern road)	From the centreline of its southern junction with the A417, west, to a point 356m west of that junction.
3/62	Playley Green (northern road)	From the centreline of its northern junction with the A417, south, to the junction of road number 3/62 (southern road).
3/57	Beech Lane, Bromesberrow Heath	From a point 91m south west from the centreline of its junction with the A417, south west, to a point 120m east of the centreline of its junction with road number 40439 known as Bell Lane.
40264	Wood End Street	From a point 169m south of the centreline of its junction with the A417, south, to its junction with road number 3/57 known as Beech Lane.
