(VARIATION) ORDER 2025

NOTICE is hereby given that Gloucestershire County Council intend to make a Variation Order under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers, the effect of which would vary the Gloucestershire County Council On Street Parking Order 2017 (the 2017 Order) by introducing the proposed waiting restrictions detailed in the Schedule below in The Quarters Development, Quedgeley, Gloucestershire.

Restrictions to be introduced

No Waiting at Any Time (Double Yellow Lines)

Road Name & Number	Extent
Phipps Drive (78325)	Along sections along both sides of its carriageway in a south-westerly and then southerly direction Along a section on both sides of its carriageway at the turning head at the end of its extent
Wilding Close (78326)	Along a section on both sides of its carriageway at its junction with Phipps Drive (78325) Along a section on both sides of its carriageway at the turning head at the end of its extent
De Bohun Close (78327)	Along a section on both sides of its carriageway at its junction with Phipps Drive (78325) Along a section on both sides of its carriageway at the turning head at the end of its extent
Sandover Close (78328)	Along a section on both sides of its carriageway at its junction with Phipps Drive (78325) Along a section on both sides of its carriageway at the turning head at the end of its extent

The lengths of roads fall within the Town of Quedgeley within the Gloucester District in the County of Gloucestershire.
