

**GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(30 MPH & 40MPH SPEED LIMITS)
(A417 GLOUCESTER ROAD) (PARISH OF HARTPURY)
(FOREST OF DEAN DISTRICT)
ORDER 2025**

The Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of that Schedule hereby make the following Order:-

1. (i) This Order shall come into operation on **the 2025** and may be cited as the "GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (30 MPH & 40 MPH SPEED LIMITS) (A417 GLOUCESTER ROAD) (PARISH OF HARTPURY) (FOREST OF DEAN DISTRICT) ORDER 2025".

(ii) This Order affects roads within the Parish of Hartpury in the Forest of Dean District within the County of Gloucestershire.
2. In this Order –

"Motor Vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on the roads as defined in Section 185 of the Road Traffic Act 1988.
3. No person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed along that length of road described in Schedule 1 to this Order at a speed exceeding 30 MPH.
4. No person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed along that length of road described in Schedule 2 to this Order at a speed exceeding 40 MPH.
5. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
6. In accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act, the following parts of Orders are to be revoked as specified in the sub-Articles that follow:
 - (i) GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (50, 40 and 30 MPH SPEED LIMITS) (VARIOUS ROADS ADJOINING THE A417 WITHIN THE COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER) ORDER 2006
