As [REDACTED] of the Windcross Paths Group (WPG), I was made aware earlier today of the Proposal to divert sections of GKE38 and GDY57.

I was able to discuss this while on a walk this morning with a group of keen walkers in the Kempley Walking Group, including one of my colleagues on the Committee of the WPG and, having heard the discussion and now seen the map plan of the proposed changes, the WPG is pleased to support the proposal.

We feel it is a sensible step which satisfies both the affected landowners and walkers in that a path (GKE38) which has been effectively unusable and inaccessible for many years can be replaced with a new line (A-D) linking the existing paths GKE39 and GDY57. This will enhance privacy and security for the landowners and provide a most useful link in the network of paths around Kempley and Kempley Green, allowing for good circular walks.
