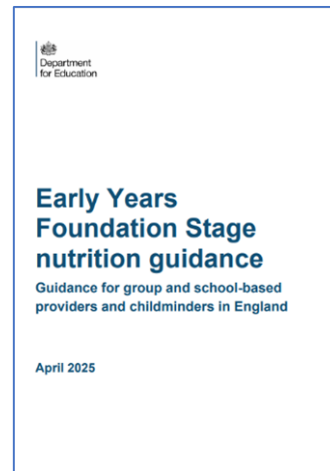
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## Nutrition guidance

From September 2025, there is a new requirement in the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) statutory framework that early years providers 'should' have regard to which is outlined in the new [Early Years Foundation Stage nutrition guidance](#).

[Help for early years providers](#) also offers additional information and resources which can help support practitioners meet the EYFS requirement that states: 'Where children are provided with meals, snacks and drinks, these must be healthy, balanced and nutritious'.

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## Reporting changes to your registration to

## Ofsted

Ofsted have made it easier for you to tell them about changes to your registration.

The 'Registered Person' is the person, company or organisation registered with Ofsted to provide childcare. The registered person can be made up of individuals known as associated people, which can include household members (those living on the domestic premises where childcare takes place).

If there's a change to people connected to your registration, you can let Ofsted know by emailing [enquiries@ofsted.gov.uk](mailto:enquiries@ofsted.gov.uk) from the email address connected to your Ofsted registration. Ofsted will aim to respond in 5 working days and let you know if they need any further information. In your email, make sure to include:

- the words 'Report association changes' in the subject line
- your organisation's unique reference number(s) (URN)
- the change to your organisation and / or associated people
- the details of any associated people including:
  - their name and date of birth
  - if they are joining or leaving your organisation
  - their role in your organisation
  - any other changes involving them
  - date the change(s) take effect

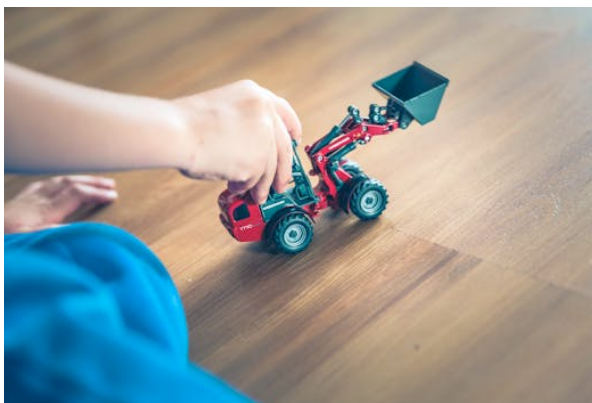
