

**GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH ABA 89 AND**  
**PART OF PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY ABA 87**  
**(BADGEWORTH PARISH) and PUBLIC FOOTPATH ACY 24 (COWLEY PARISH) TEWKESBURY**  
**BOROUGH ORDER 2023**

WHEREAS the Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") being the Traffic Authority for part of the Public Footpaths and Public Bridleway as defined in the schedule below ("the Footpaths") is satisfied that use of the Footpaths should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near them.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its power under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, hereby makes the following Order:

**CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT**

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of June Two Thousand and Twenty Three and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding six months.
2. This Order may be cited as "Gloucestershire County Council Temporary Closure of Public Footpath ABA 89 and Part of Public Bridleway ABA 87 (Badgeworth Parish) and Public Footpath ACY 24 (Cowley Parish) Tewkesbury Borough Order 2023".

**GENERAL**

3. Except for emergency and pedestrian access to premises no person shall proceed on foot nor cause or permit any person to proceed along the Footpaths;
4. The Footpaths fall in the Badgeworth Parish in the Tewkesbury Borough in the County of Gloucestershire

**SCHEDULE**

Public Bridleway ABA 87 from its junction with Public Footpath ABA 89 and its junction with A417 Road in a generally southerly direction for approximately 335 metres to its junction with Public Footpath ABA 88

Public Footpath ABA 89 from its junction with Public Bridleway ABA 87 in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 110 metres to its junction with Public Footpath ACY 24

Public Footpath ACY 24 from its junction with Public Footpath ABA 89 in a generally easterly direction for approximately 235 metres to its junction with A417 Road
