

Health and safety at the site questionnaire

The Inspector will visit the site and will need to know what safety equipment and protective clothing to bring. The following questions indicate the type of information the Inspector will need about the site. Please supply any additional information on a separate sheet of paper.

1. Is the site uneven or does it present any other known risks? Is special footwear or any other Personal Protection Equipment required?

Most of the site is level, but there is a slope down between points A and B on the definitive path. The surface of the field between A - B and A - D could be muddy and/or uneven if it has been grazed by cattle.

2. Is there any likelihood of exposure to pets or other animals which may present a risk to the safety of the Inspector?

The proposed path runs through a field that is sometimes grazed by cattle.

3. Is the site remote and/or can it be seen from other highways or rights of way?

Part of the definitive path can be seen from the road. The northeastern section of the definitive path and the proposed footpath are approximately 300 metres from the road but connect to other public footpaths.

4. Does the site have a good mobile phone signal or is there easy access to a public telephone should the emergency services be required?

The mobile signal is unreliable and there is no public telephone box in the vicinity. However, there are numerous properties within Kembley Green should emergency services be required.

5. Is the right of way easily accessible? Will arrangements for access by the Inspector need to be made in advance?

The definitive path leaves the road at point C on the diversion plan and follows the driveway of The Redlands; at the northeastern end of the driveway the path is obstructed by a hedge. The section of definitive path between this hedge and point B can only be accessed from the property Felania. At point B the definitive path is again obstructed by a hedge, and the section between B and A can only be accessed by following the diversion route D - A through the field.

6. Are there any dangerous pieces of equipment or substances stored at any point along the right of way?

7. If there is any other relevant information which the Inspector should be aware of that is not covered in this questionnaire?

There is generally plenty of on-street parking available in Kempley Green. Alternatively, there is a layby with several parking spaces adjacent to the bus stop at the northwestern end of the village, approximately 200 metres away from the property The Redlands.
