Gloucestershire operates as a [Restorative approach](#). Restorative Practice focuses on building positive relationships and resolving conflict through dialogue and mutual respect. Are you using personal tutors, carers, or therapists?

The government has just announced that [parents will be able to get Enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service \(DBS\) checks when hiring private tutors, carers and therapists](#), among others to help give parents greater peace of mind. This change will come into effect from January 2026.
