


A435 CYCLEWAY – CHELTENHAM TO BISHOP'S CLEEVE

Montel Civil Engineering has been appointed by Gloucestershire County Council as the main contractor to complete Section 2 of the A435 Cheltenham to Bishop's Cleeve Cycleway.

Latest updates on the project as of 10th of September 2025 are:



Work on the new cycleway is progressing well, with significant milestones achieved over the past month.

Due to unforeseen additional works involving utility diversions and essential structural repairs to the **GWSR Bridge**, the full road closure has been extended to **22nd of September**. From 6am on Monday 22nd September the road will re-open to southbound (Bishop's Cleeve to Cheltenham) traffic.

Over the last four weeks, progress has been significant. Key achievements include:

- Extensive structural repairs to the GWSR Bridge (Photo 6 page 2).
- Completion of crib and gabion walls between the Racecourse roundabout and the GWSR Bridge (photos 4&5).
- Full cycle/footway surfacing of the stretch between the GWSR Bridge and Hyde Lane Junction and installation of pedestrian crossing (photo 3).

We have also begun improvements at Bishop's Cleeve Roundabout, which will continue during the upcoming weeks.

At the Wellington Road / Evesham Road Junction, the main works and resurfacing are now complete. Only minor finishing works remain, which we expect to complete during October / November.

Looking ahead, works will continue on the GWSR bridge, and preparations will begin at the A435 / Hyde Lane Junction for an overnight closure and surfacing. Full details can be found on page 3 of this newsletter.

We'd like to thank everyone for their continued patience and support as we deliver these important improvements.

We would like to inform all residents and businesses that over the coming weeks there will be **changes to traffic management and some road closures** to enable the project to proceed safely. We have designed these measures to safeguard everyone on and around the site and to **keep disruption to a minimum**.

Full closure A435

Until 22nd of September 2025

The A435 remains fully closed between the Hyde Lane / Southam Lane junction and Cheltenham Racecourse Roundabout. The road will open to southbound traffic only from 6am on the 22nd of September.

Bishop’s Cleeve Roundabout

Temporary traffic signals (4-way, overnight)

22nd to 5th of October 2025 (19:00–06:00)

Temporary signals will be in operation to enable installation of road duct crossings.



Hyde Lane / Southam Lane Junction: Closures & Works

Temporary Mini-roundabout installation

5th of October (20:00) - 6th of October (06:00)

Full junction closure to install a temporary mini-roundabout and switch off existing signals.

Diversion routes will mirror those used for the current closure, with additional provisions for Hyde Lane and Southam Lane residents, detailed route can be found on the right and on our website.
