(PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) (KIDNAPPERS LANE) (PARISH OF LECKHAMPTON WITH
WARDEN HILL) (CHELTENHAM BOROUGH) ORDER 2026

NOTICE is hereby given that Gloucestershire County Council has made a Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2, & 4 and Parts II and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to introduce the Prohibition of Motor Vehicles restriction detailed in the Schedule below on Kidnappers Lane, Leckhampton Gloucestershire:

THE SCHEDULE

Restrictions to be introduced

Prohibition of Motor Vehicles

Road Name & Number	Extent
Kidnappers Lane (490628)	From its junction with Shurdington Road (A46) to its junction with Kidnappers Lane (809100)

This Order shall come into operation on 26th August 2026.

The lengths of roads fall within the Parish of Leckhampton with Warden Hill within the Cheltenham Borough in the County of Gloucestershire. The usual exemptions will apply to Statutory Undertakers and Local Authority vehicles carrying out duties in exercise of their statutory powers, and also in the case of emergency services vehicles.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the ground that any requirement to that Act or any Statutory Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks of the date on which the Order is made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
