


## Censorship 2c - Field Postcards

Sometimes, soldiers wrote home using pre-printed, Field Postcards.

These contained a number of pre-written phrases and soldiers could cross out those that were not suitable and convey messages in this way.

Soldiers were not allowed to write any other information on the postcards and any that had extra writing on them were destroyed.

These tended to be used when the soldiers' units were on the move, if the soldiers didn't have time to write or, if it was difficult to write due to conditions or if supplies of paper were low (note that most soldiers wrote in pencil as these were easier to look after than ink pens, cheaper and could write in the wet).
