A GUIDE TO MULTI-AGENCY ADULT RISK MANAGEMENT MEETINGS

WHAT IS A MARM MEETING?

It is a meeting where everyone involved comes together to discuss the best ways to help you manage the risks you are experiencing.

WILL I BE INVITED?

Yes, because your views are important!

It is also important that you are involved in any plans that aim to help you stay safe.

WHAT HAPPENS IN THE MEETING?

We will:

- Identify the risks
- Listen to your views and wishes
- Work together to see how you can be supported
- Explore if further support is needed to ensure your safety and wellbeing.

FAQ's

WHAT IF I DON'T WANT TO GO?

It is important that you attend if possible; but this is your choice.

If you don't attend the meeting may still take place without you, or you could ask someone to attend on your behalf.

WHO WILL BE THERE?

Your worker will identify which Professionals should be there.

This could be someone from Health, VIA or Police for example.

LET SOMEONE KNOW

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER THE MEETING?

You will be given a written summary of what was said and decided.

There might also be a date for another meeting.
