The table below is an extract from the Gloucester port book of 1575. Your task is to read it and then answer the questions.

Ceres	Bude	Tewkesbury	Welch	Cloak	50 weys of lime sand, 30 weys of oats.
Harriet	Tewkesbury	Woolaston	Balaams	Keir	20 cattle, 10 pigs, 1 horse.

Green Dragon	Ross-on-Wye	Maisemore	Simpkins	Kirby	10 hogsheads of cider, 6 hogsheads of perry, 1 firkin of honey.

1. A 'tun' is a barrel that holds 982 litres. How many tuns in total is the Marie de Bayonne carrying? **(22)**
2. What nationality do you think the Marie de Bayonne is? Why do you think this? **(French)**
3. How many ships are carrying animal products? **(3)** Why might these be important?
4. What cargoes are being carried in 'weys'? **(wheat, rye, oats)** What are these and why are they important?
5. A 'pipe' is a barrel that was often used to carry dry goods. What cargoes are being carried in 'pipes'? **(sugar and malt)** What are these cargoes used to make and why was it important? **(beer - safer to drink than water)**
6. Name the ships that you think are carrying foodstuffs. **(Marie de Bayonne, New Newnham, Happy Return, Two Brothers, Harriet and Green Dragon)** Is food an important cargo on the river?
7. Who is the captain of the New Newnham? **(Jones)** Is this an important role onboard a ship?
8. Who owns the cargo of the Marie de Bayonne? **(Merritt)** Would this be a valuable cargo?
9. What sort of business does the owner of the cargo on the Marie de Bayonne run? **(pub, hotel, wine merchant)**
10. What occupation might the owner of the cargo of the Harriet have? **(Farmer)**
11. What type of cargo is 'High delf'? Why is this cargo important? **(coal, fuel, etc)**
12. What sort of cheese might the Two Brothers be carrying? **(preserved milk)** Why was cheese an important product?
