

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(A46 SHURDINGTON ROAD, CHELTENHAM)  
(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER, 1993

The Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport given in accordance with Part II of Schedule 9 to the Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of that Schedule hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the "Gloucestershire County Council (A46 Shurdington Road, Cheltenham) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order, 1992" and shall come into operation on the *fifth* day of *April* One thousand nine hundred and ninety-three.
2. The Trunk Road (40 mph Speed Limit) (No. 1) Order, 1978 is hereby varied by the deletion of Schedule 2 to that Order.
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

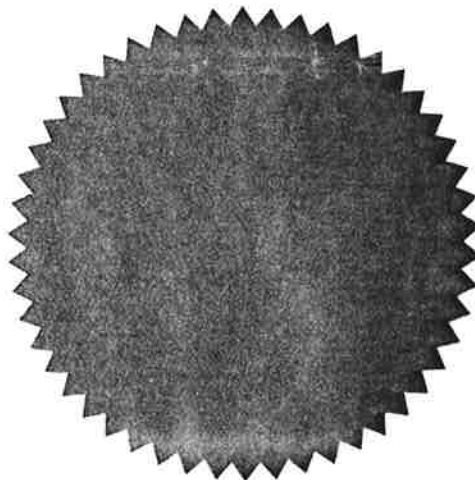
40 MPH SPEED LIMIT

The A46 (Shurdington Road) in the Borough of Cheltenham between points 33.5 metres and 725 metres south west of the junction with the kerblin~~e~~ on the west side of Painswick Road.
