

## Metz Way/Abbeymead Avenue Corridor Works

Progress update 12 September – 3 October

### Eastern Avenue & Metz Way Junction (Site 2)

Utilities service diversions have now been completed and works to widen the southern side of Metz Way at the junction of Eastern Avenue are underway. New street lights are being installed and power reconnected. We are taking measures to safely remove the High Mast lights soon.



### ASDA & Metz Way Junction (Site 1)

The installation of the new traffic signals is well underway and due to be commissioned week commencing 1 October. The new road markings will be applied shortly afterwards.

### Junction of Abbeymead Avenue & North Upton Lane (Site 5)

Temporary road traffic management has been set up to allow us to safely commence the widening of the Southern carriageway. One way badger gates have been installed to the badger set and we will observe them for 21 days to make sure that set is empty and it is safe to start works in that area.

### Junction of St Lawrence Road & Metz Way (Site 3)

New signal ducting is being installed ready for the installation of new traffic signals. Off peak temporary lights will be in use. A temporary pedestrian crossing is still in place as we progress the works.



### Metz Way / Coney Hill Roundabout (Site 4)

Works have started on the southern side to provide a new footway to the bus stop. Traffic management has been set up to narrow the lanes down to provide safe working zones. 2 way traffic lights will be used during off peak hours to allow safe access to the area for loading and offloading of materials.

These works are due to run until the middle of December.

Night time closures will be in place for a month
