

Attendance and absence across year to date

Attendance and absence rates presented here are calculated across all sessions in the year to date.

- 95.42% of sessions were recorded as attending
- 4.58% of sessions were recorded as absence
- 2.39% of sessions were recorded as illness

Persistent absence across year to date

A pupil enrolment is identified as persistently absent if they have missed 10% or more of their possible sessions in the year to date.

- 0.49% of pupils were recorded as persistently absent
