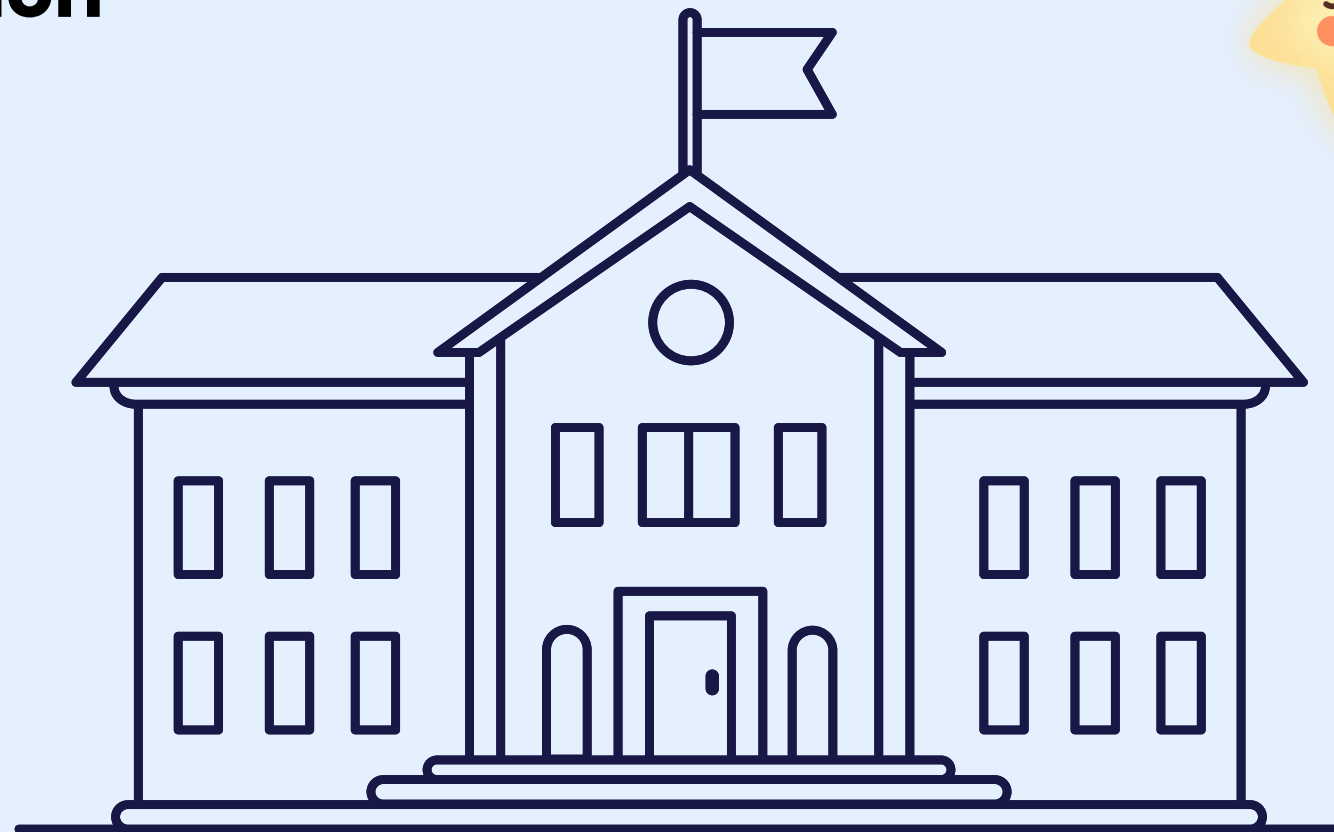
Build Trusting Relationships
